





Wiring: This unit is supplied with a BS 1363 approved main plug. When replacing the fuse, always use of the same rating approved to BS 1362. Never use this plug with the fuse cover omitted. To obtain a replacement fuse cover contact your dealer. If the type of plug supplied is not suitable for the mains sockets in your home. then the plug should be removed and a suitable type fitted. Please refer to the wiring instructions below

Warning: A mains plug removed from the mains lead of this unit must be destroyed. A mains plug with bared wires is hazardous if inserted in a mains socket. The wire which is coloured brown must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter L or coloured red.





- 3 MIC (Microphone) VOL +/-

4 VOICE CANCELLER

VOICE CANCELLER can reduce the Vocals of Singer in certain source/content allowing you to enjoy the music. Press to switch this Mode On or Off.

5 SCRATCH / SEARCH & LEVEL CONTROL

- Turns clockwise or counterclockwise to make Scratch sound.


- Do Not look directly at the light emitting path when lighting function is operational.
