

If voltage is inputted to gas in glass panels, ultraviolet rays is outputted and fused with a fluorescent substance. At this moment, light is emitted. A Plasma Monitor is a next generation flat Display using this phenomenon.

160° - Wide angle range of vision

A Plasma Monitor provides more than 160° angle range of vision so that you can get a picture without distortion from any direction.

Easy installation

A Plasma Monitor is much lighter and smaller than other same class products so that you can install the Plasma Monitor at the desired place.

Big screen

The screen of a Plasma Monitor is 42" so that you can get vivid experience as if you are in a theatre.

Multimedia Plasma Monitor

A Plasma Monitor can be connected with a computer so that you can use it as a screen for conference, game, internet and so on.

The explanation about coloured dots may be present on PDP screen

The PDP which is the display device of this product is composed of 0.9 to 2.2 million cells and a few cell defects can occur in the manufacture of the PDP. Several coloured dots visible on the screen would be acceptable, in line with other PDP manufacturers and would not mean that the PDP is faulty. We hope you will understand that the product which corresponds to this standard is regarded as acceptable. It means that it could not be changed or refunded.




Outdoor Installation

Controls of the remote control

- Some buttons on this remote control does function only when the Monitor is connected with RT/RZ-BA10 (the PDP tuner).
- When using the remote control aim it at the remote control sensor of the Monitor.







Installation of the Monitor

- The Monitor can be installed in various ways such as wall mounting type, desktop type, etc..



To install as wall mounting type



• The monitor can be installed on the wall as the picture above. (For further information, refer to '(Tilt) wall mounting bracket owner's manual'.)



• Install this monitor only in a location where adequate ventilation is available.

(Wall mount minimum allowable clearances for adequate ventilation)



O To install as desktop type




• The monitor can be installed on the desk as the picture above. (For further information, refer to 'Desktop stand owner's manual'.)

Watching VCR

- When connecting the Monitor with external equipments, match the colours of connecting ports (Video
- yellow, Audio(L) white, Audio(R) red).
 If you have a mono VCR, connect the audio cable from the VCR to the AUDIO(L/MONO) input of the Monitor.
- Avoid having a fixed image remain on the screen for a long period of time. Typically a frozen still picture from a VCR, 4:3 picture format or if a CH label is present; the fixed image may remain visible on the screen.



To watch VCR (When the Interface board is installed.)

► The Interface board (AP-42EA20) is not equipped on MT/Z-42PZ10/14/24 series model.

Press TV/AV button on the remote control to select AV. (Select AV if AV INPUT is connected.)

- Connect DVD video inputs to Y, PB, PR of COMPONENT (480i/480p) (DVD INPUT) and audio inputs to Audio sockets of AV INPUT.






How to use


Component Input ports

You can get better picture quality if you connect DVD player with component input ports as below.



Connecting PC

- You can enjoy vivid picture and sound with connecting a PC with the Monitor.
- Set the video mode of PC to VGA/SVGA/XGA to obtain the best picture quality for the Monitor.
- If the resolution of PC is over XGA, there will be no picture on the Monitor.
- Connect the signal cable from the monitor output port of the PC to the RGB INPUT(VGA/SVGA/XGA) port of the Monitor.
- · Connect the audio cable from the PC to the Audio ports of the Monitor. (Audio cables not included with the Monitor)
- In case of using a sound card adjust PC sound properly.





- Press POWER button on the PC and press ON/OFF button on the Monitor. After this press 6/1 button on the Monitor or press POWER button on the remote control.
- Press MULTIMEDIA or TV/AV button on the remote control to select RGB-PC
- Set the resolution of PC under XGA (1024x768). (Refer to page 21.)

Tips

- If still picture is on the screen for a long period time, Screen Burn!
 If the resolution of PC is over XGA, connect to the RGB INPUT(VGA/SVGA/XGA) port of the Monitor after changing the resolution of PC under XGA.
- If picture isn't be displayed properly by conneting a non-standard PC, contact your dealer for more information.



Function checking in PC mode

- Make sure to select **RGB-PC** before operating.



- Only when Equalizer is set to User, Treble and Bass are displayed and can be adjusted.
- Language is displayed only in PC mode (special menu) when the Interface board is not installed and you can select your desired Language.
- ► The Interface board (AP-42EA20) is not equipped on MT/Z-42PZ10/14/24 series model.

Adjusting in PC mode

- Only adjust auto configure, horizontal / vertical position and clock phase in 16:9 picture format



Auto configure

- This function is for the automatic adjustment of the screen position and clock phase.



Repeatedly press the **MENU** button to select the special menu.







Press the ▲ / ▼ button to select **Auto-configure** and then press the ◀ / ▶ button.







Press the **OK** button.





Using the remote control



 Open the battery compartment cover on the back side and insert the batteries with correct polarity.

Notes for using the remote control

Make sure there are no objects between the remote control and its sensor.



Don't place the remote control near a heater or damp place. Strong impact on the remote control may cause operation failure.



Signal from the remote control may be disturbed by sun light or other strong light. In this case, turn the set to other direction.





- When using the remote control, aim it at its sensor on the Monitor.



Connect power cord correctly.



Press the **ON/OFF** button on the Monitor. At this moment, the Monitor is switched to standby mode. Press the 6/1, **INPUT SELECT** button on the Monitor or press the **TV/AV**, **MULTIMEDIA** button on the remote control and then the Monitor will be switched on.



If the Monitor is turned off with the 6/1 button on the Monitor

 Press the 6/I, INPUT SELECT button on the Monitor or press the TV/AV, MULTIMEDIA button on the remote control to turn on the Monitor.



If the Monitor is turned off with the ON/OFF button on the Monitor

• Press the **ON/OFF** button on the Monitor to turn on the Monitor.



If the Monitor is turned off with the remote control and also the ON/OFF button on the Monitor





16:9

You can enjoy the cinema (the picture format of 16:9) or general Plasma Display programme through the 16:9 mode.

The screen 16:9 is viewed just like that but the screen 4:3 is magnified to the left and right so that the screen 16:9 is full.

4:3

This picture format is 4 to 3 of general Plasma Display.

You can enjoy the cinema in a vast screen through the Zoom mode. The screen 4:3 is magnified to the upper/lower sides so that the screen 16:9 is full. The bottom and top of the picture may be lost.

You can move the screen up/down with ▲ / ▼ button.

You can enjoy a larger magnified screen in this mode. The screen Zoom 2 is viewed just like that but the screen 16:9 is magnified more and more to the left and right so that the screen Zoom 2 is full.

Only when receiving over SVGA (800X600), you can select Zoom.

You can move the screen up/down or left/right with $\blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown \text{ or } \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright \text{ button.}$
