You can transfer your data straight to your PC without any adapters or cables. Just push the slide USB switch to reveal a built-in USB connector and plug into the USB port on your computer.

#### Support USB 2.0 full speed

The user can download files at a fast speed with a builtin USB connector.

#### FM reception (See on the page 48 'Option by Models')

With auto frequency selection feature, the user can conveniently listen to FM radio broadcasting.

#### Firmware upgrading

You can upgrade your firmware to the newest one.

#### **DRM** feature

This player supports Portable Device DRM(PDDRM). The DRM-enabled music file is encrypted so that editing the ID3 tag and lyrics is impossible.



## Before installing the operating

#### program

Check the specifications of your PC before using LG portable Flash MP3 Player.

#### Minimum system requirements

- CD-ROM Drive
- Pentium III or higher level CPU / 128MB or larger memory
- 100MB or larger hard disk space, 800 X 600 mode
- Hi-color (16 bit) or higher level video card, Sound card

#### LG Media Center

- Windows 2000 : Windows Media Player 9 or higher / Direct X 8.1 or higher / Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher
- Windows XP : Windows Media Player 10 or higher / Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher
- Windows Media Player or Internet Explorer will be automatically installed during installation of the LG Media Center. Internet Explorer is only installed on an internet enabled PC.







- 1. Insert the installation CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Run the firmware updater.
- 3. When Install shield wizard starts shown below, click [Next].



4 . Read the License Agreement. Select the check box and click [Next].



5. Select the installation path and click [Next].



6 . Enter a name into a new folder or select one from the existing folder lists. Click [Next] to continue.



- 14. Check the updated firmware version on the display window.
- Click [Close] to finish the program. Remove the USB connector by safely removing hardware.



In case the player is not recognized automatically on Window XP or Windows 2000.

 If the MP3 player is not recognized by the PC, an "Found New Hardware Wizard" window is opened. And Click [Next].



2-a. You can select one of two check boxes. In the first case, check the "Install the software automatically" and then click [Next].

3-a. In the second case, check the "Install from a list or specific location" and then click [Next].









## **Connecting to the PC**

# Using the removable storage device

- Push the slide USB switch to expose USB connector and insert the connector to the USB port of your PC. Check whether the connector is correctly plugged in.
- 2. Check whether a new drive has been added in the Windows Explorer in the PC.
- 3. Drag the file you want to copy to the removable disk.



#### <u>Note</u>

- The drive section name may differ depending on the OS.
- Disconnecting the USB connector while the file is being copied may cause malfunction of the player.

#### **Upgrading Firmware**

- 1. Check the model number at the company web site, and download the latest version.

- Decompress the downloaded files. Then, setup file will be displayed.
- 3. Click the setup file to start the Install shield wizard.


#### **Battery Info**

#### This player does not come with an AC adapter.

- Playback time: Max 18 hrs (In the case of MP3 128Kbps/44.1KHz, EQ FLAT, Volume 15 and alkaline battery)
- When the battery is almost used up, uill appear.

#### **Inserting battery**

- 1. Open the battery cover by pulling it out.
- 2. Insert one AAA size battery with +/- aligned.
- 3. Close the battery cover.




#### <u>Note</u>

- Remove a battery when not used for long.
- When a battery leaked, clean the chamber and replace it with a new one.

#### Connecting the player to the PC

- Push the slide USB switch to expose USB connector and insert the connector to the USB port of your PC.
  - Check whether the connector is correctly plugged in.



 When the USB connector is connected, the following will be displayed on LCD.



 In case of a correct connection, the sicon will be displayed on the task bar of the PC.

#### <u>Note</u>

The icon shape on the task bar may differ depending on the system environment of the PC.

## Installation and connection

# Disconnecting the player from the PC

This feature is to safely remove the player from the PC after uploading or downloading the files.

- 1. Double-click on the Remove Hardware 🐇 icon on the task bar of the PC.
- 2. Click [Stop] when the window appears.

 After a message that the large-capacity USB storage can be safely removed is displayed, remove the player from the PC.

#### <u>Note</u>

If the USB connector is disconnected while the player is connected to the PC to store or delete a file, the data may get lost.

## **Basic operation**

#### Turning on/off the power

Press ▶II for longer than 2 second to turn on and repeat it to turn off for longer than 3 seconds.

#### <u>Note</u>

Upon rebuilding, it may take time to load.



#### Lock feature

## This feature is to lock all feature buttons to prevent a malfunction of the player.

- 1. Push the Hold switch to the arrow direction to lock the player.
  - The icon will appear on display window for 2 seconds and disappear.
- Push the Hold switch to the opposite " direction to unlock the player.
  - The Distance icon will appear on display window for 2 seconds and disappear.

#### **Volume control**

Control the volume by moving the Volume control button to the direction of  $V/\Lambda$ .

- The volume level can be adjusted by 31 steps. (Min:00 ~ Max:30)
- Pressing and holding the button will increase or decrease the volume gradually.
- The factory-default setting for volume level is 15.

#### <u>Note</u>

The volume level is automatically reset to 21 when restarted if your player's volume level has been set to higher than 21 before reset.

## **Basic operation**

#### Home menu screen

1. Press and hold **MENU** to open the home menu.



- 2. Press V/A to select a mode.
- 3. Press I to display the selected mode.
  - The initial screen consists of five modes in total.
  - The Home menu appears if **MENU** is pressed for longer than 2 seconds in Play/Pause state.

- 2. Playback Time

#### Play

- 1. Press and hold **MENU** to open home menu.
- 2. Press V/A to select the Music mode.



3. Press I briefly to open the Music browser.



 Press ▶II or I to play the music files. The Play ▶ icon and the playback time appear and the information is sliding.



#### <u>Note</u>



## **Playing music files**

 To check EQ information and the total number of songs in play/pause state, press I briefly. The play mode and playback time will be displayed again after 3 seconds.



#### Pause

- 1. Press ►II once to pause while playing.
  - Even in pause state, song information can be displayed.
- 2. Press ►II again to resume playing.

#### Searching a music file

- Press < for longer than 2 seconds, and you can jump to the former part of the currently playing music file during playback.
- Press > for longer than 2 seconds, and you can jump to the latter part of the currently playing music file during playback.
- If you skip to the beginning/end of the current file with </>>, the previous or next file will be played.

# Skipping to the next or previous music file

- In play/pause state, press > briefly to skip to the next music file.
- In play/pause state, press <, the music will go back to the previous music file if the music is playing within 5 seconds; and the music will restart playing if the music is playing after 5 seconds.

# Playing the music files in a folder of the browser

## The user can easily search or play files using the browser.

1. In play/pause mode, press **MENU** briefly, and the browser screen will appear.





## **Playing music files**

#### <u>Note</u>

- Press <, it will move to the higher folder.
- When you are in the highest folder and press <, the currently playing or the previously played song file will be displayed.
- Press >, it will move to the lower folder.
- Go to the item using V/∧ in the browser and press I or ►/II. The selected music file will be playing.



3. Press MENU for longer than 2 seconds to go to the Home menu.

#### <u>Note</u>

- · Maximum number of files to play
  - You can play up to 400 files.
- Maximum number of folders to be created
  - You can create up to 50 folders.
- When the files or folders exceed the above limit, the files or folders exceeding the limit doesn't appear in the list.

#### File error

When you select a file which cannot be played, the following message will be displayed.



The images inserted in the FM radio reception section are just examples to help you understand this function more easily.

#### FM radio reception screen



- 1. Stereo/Mono icon
- 2. Channel display (only in Preset mode)
- 3. FM radio frequency display

#### Listening to the FM radio

1. Press MENU to select Radio mode.



2. Press I to display the FM radio reception screen.



#### <u>Note</u>

When you press V/A, the volume icon  $\P$  will appear on the display window instead of the Mono/Stereo icon and disappear after 3 seconds.

#### **Setting Preset Channels**

#### Automatic channel setting

- 1. Press I for longer than 2 seconds to scan and store radio channels in Non-Preset mode.
  - The conversion of the channels will be stored.

#### <u>Note</u>

- While scanning from lower to upper frequencies, the unit will store 20 channels and all of the previously preset channels will be deleted.
- In an area with weak reception, the detected channels may be less than 20.
- While scanning frequencies, the player will not be powered off and you can not hear any sound.
- 2. Press < to stop automatic search.

#### Manual channel setting

- In a Non-Preset mode, select a frequency to store as a preset channel by using </>> and press MENU briefly.
- When a browser screen appears, select a channel with V/A and press I briefly.



 When a message "Save as a CH" appears, select "Yes" and press | briefly.



**4.** Stored channels can be scanned in a browser screen.



#### **Deleting a channel**

- 1. While listening to the radio, press **MENU** briefly to delete the currently preset channel.
  - To operate this function, you must press I in Preset mode.
- When a message "Delete this CH" appears, select "Yes" by using </> and press I briefly.



- When a channel is deleted, we can still receive other preset channels. When no preset channel is
- left, the Noch icon appears and then disappears.

#### Setting Preset/Non-Preset Mode

#### Setting Preset Mode

- 1. Press | briefly while listening to the radio.
- 2. Preset mode is set and the CH icon appears.

#### <u>Tip</u>

Preset mode: When the existing radio channels are already set, it is called 'Preset mode'.

#### Setting Non-Preset Mode

- 1. Press | button briefly once again.
- 2. Non-Preset mode is set and the CH icon disappears.

#### <u>Tip</u>

Non-Preset mode: When the existing radio channels are not already set, it is called 'Non-preset mode'.

#### Scanning the FM radio stations

#### Auto Scan

- In Non-Preset mode, press </>
  </>
   for longer than 2 seconds, and you can find available radio stations automatically.
- In Preset mode, press </>> for longer than 2 seconds, and the frequency will decreases/increases swiftly.

#### Manual Scan

- 1. In Non-Preset mode, press </>>, and the frequency decreases/increases.
- In present mode, press </>> button, and you can listen to the previous/next preset station.

#### <u>Note</u>

- · Reception may be weak in some areas.
- Earphones function as an antenna. Earphones made by other manufacturers do not guarantee optimal per formance.
- While scanning frequencies, the unit will not be pow ered off and you can not hear any sound.

# Recording screen

- 1. Elapsed Time
- 2. Remaining Time

#### **Recording FM radio broadcasting**

1. Press ►/II briefly to start recording while listening to the radio.



#### <u>Note</u>

If the memory is not enough to record, "**Memory full not record**" will appear. In this case, delete the files and secure the memory space.



2. Press ►/II to pause recording.



- 3. By pressing ►/II again, the user can resume recording.
- Press I briefly to end recording. Files will be stored in FM folder in a format 'F001.WAV'.



#### Listening to the recorded file

- 1. Press and hold **MENU** to select the music mode.
- 2. Press | briefly in music mode.
- Choose a recorded file you want to hear by using V/∧ and press I or ►/II briefly.

## **Playlist Function**

## Playing a file in playlist

 In Home Menu, press V/A to select the Playlist mode.



2. Press I briefly to display the playlist browser.



 Select a music file you want to hear in playlist browser by using V/A and press I or ►/II briefly, and then the file is played.

- Music files in Playlist are displayed with the  $\textcircled{\ensuremath{\mathbb{D}}}$  icon.



## Adding a file to the playlist

1. In play/pause state, press **MENU** briefly to enter the Music browser.



- 2. Press V/A to select the desired file.
- Press I for longer than 2 seconds to add the file to the playlist.

-The Icon of the file added will be changed like



#### <u>Note</u>

• When you press | for longer than 2 seconds during playback, the music file is added to the playlist.



• When the files or folders exceed the limit, the "**Playlist** is **Full** !" message will be displayed.



• You can create up to 50 lists.

# **Deleting a playlist**

#### In Playlist Browser

1. Select the Playlist Browser and a file you want to delete.



2. Press I for longer than 2 seconds in Playlist mode, then the selected file is deleted.



#### In Music Browser

1. Press I for longer than 2 seconds in Music browser.



2. The file is deleted in Music browser.



### In Playback

1. Press | for longer than 2 seconds during playback.



2. The file is deleted in the playlist.



### <u>Note</u>

When no song remains in Playlist mode, playback stops and the message "**No Song**" is displayed.



# **Now Playing**

# **Using Now Playing**

With Now Playing function, you can check and play the currently playing music file in Home menu or the last played music file even after entering other modes or restarting the player.

In Home menu

 Press MENU to select Now Playing mode and press I or ►/II briefly.



2. Then, a currently playing or last played music file will be played.



In Music mode

1. Press MENU to select Music mode and press I.

#### Features of the LG Media Center

- With the Media Library, the user can efficiently manage music files and download them to the MP3 player.
- Downloaded files are stored in a folder hierarchically.
  Music + Artist + \*.MP3
- -You can create folders (50 folders maximum).
- -To disable the folder hierarchy, select No Hierarchy in the Synchronization → Enable hierarchy menu item. Music → \*.MP3

# Using the application program

### Auto Firmware updating

Connect the player to the PC where the LG Media Center is installed to download a new version of firmware.

#### <u>Note</u>

Functions only in the Internet-connected PC.

- 1. Connect the USB connector to the USB port of the PC with the LG Media Center installed.
- 2. Check whether a new drive has been added in the Windows Explorer in the PC.
- The LG Media Center will compare the firmware versions of the player and the server. If it detects a new firmware version, it asks the user whether to update the version.
- 4. Check the current firmware version, when the LGE MP3 Firmware download window appears.

- 5. If you want to format, check "Format Data Area" in the download option. (Refer to the page 43)
  - All files will be deleted from the player. Please back up your data before executing this option.
  - We recommend the "Format data area".
- 6. Click [Start] to run the firmware updater.
  - Make sure your connection is solid while updating. It may result in the data loss or damage to the player.
- When the update finishes, remove the USB connector by safely removing hardware.
- Turn on the player and check the updated version of firmware.

# Troubleshooting

### **Q** : The player is not turned on.

A : Check whether the battery is remaining.

#### **Q** : The screen blurs.

- A : Avoid direct sun rays and adjust the brightness.
- A : Check the LCD brightness.

#### **Q** : The button does not function.

A : Check whether the Hold function is active.

# Q : The noise is severe during listening to the radio and the reception is poor.

- A : As the earphones function as an antenna, make sure it has any damage.
- A : Change the directions of the player and the earphones gradually.

# Q : After the firmware is updated, the player is not normally functioning.

- A : Back up the data and format the player.
- Q : Sometimes files get downloaded but sometimes they don't.
  - A : Make sure the USB port is operational.

# Q : Downloaded files or folders does not appear.

A : The maximum number of files or folders this player can play are 400 and 50 respectively. The files or folders exceeding the limit don't appear in the list. Delete some music files or folders to see the files which are not previously listed.

### Q : An error occurs during FW download and Auto FW upgrade of LG Media Center, and MP3 player does not work after finishing the operation of FW download and Auto FW upgrade of LG Media Center.

A : Connect the player to the USB port of the PC while pressing ►II and run FW download program. And so run Recovery.

(However you should press and hold ▶/II until the initialized progressive bar of Firmware download program reaches the end.)
