DVD SETUP

When connecting Component cable

1. How to connect

- 1 Connect the video outputs (Y, Pb, Pr) of the DVD to the **COMPONENT IN VIDEO1** jacks on the set.
Match the jack colors
(Y = green, Pb = blue, and Pr = red).
- 2 Connect the audio outputs of the DVD to the **COMPONENT IN AUDIO1** jacks on the set.



2. How to use

- Turn on the DVD player, insert a DVD.
- Select **Component 1** input source by using the **INPUT** button on the remote control.
- If connected to **COMPONENT IN 2** input, select **Component 2** input source.
- Refer to the DVD player's manual for operating instructions.

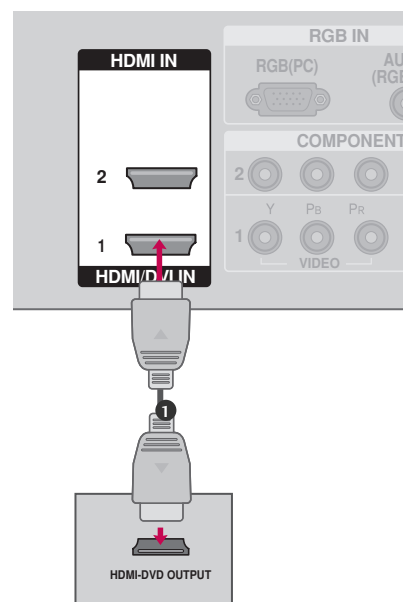

No picture & No sound

- Check your antenna direction and/or location.
- Test the wall power outlet, plug another product's power cord into the outlet where the product's power cord was plugged in.

Picture appears slowly

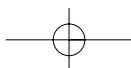
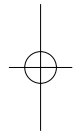
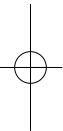
