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# 简介

简介

恭喜您购买此款功能先进的 KD876 3G 视频手机，它采用了最新的数字移动通信技术，专注于为您提供便利的操作。



本用户手册包含有关手机使用和操作的重要信息。请仔细阅读所有信息以获得手机的最佳性能，并防止因误用而造成的任何损坏。如果作出未在本用户手册中明确认可的更改或修改，可能导致手机的保修失效。

# 安全措施

请阅读以下简单的准则。违反这些准则可能造成危险或者触犯法律。本手册中给出了进一步的详细信息。

## 警告

- ▶ 在飞机上请务必关闭手机。
- ▶ 驾驶时请勿手持手机。
- ▶ 请勿在加油站、加油点、化工厂或爆破区附近使用手机。
- ▶ 为了您的安全，请仅使用指定的原厂电池和充电器。
- ▶ 手机充电时，请勿用湿手操作手机。这可能会导致电击或手机严重受损。
- ▶ 将手机放在儿童接触不到的安全地方，以防止它的可拆部件使儿童造成窒息危险。

## 小心

# 关于安全有效使用手机的准则

## 射频能量照射

辐射波照射和吸收比率 (SAR) 信息。该款 KD876 型移动电话的设计完全遵循了辐射波照射的相关安全要求。该要求基于科学的指导原则, 包括用于确保所有人 (无论年龄和健康状况) 安全的辐射允许限度。

- ▶ 辐射波照射指导原则采用了一种称为吸收比率 (或 SAR ) 的测量单位。进行 SAR 测试时, 手机将使用一种标准化的方法, 在所有可用的频段上以其最高测定能量级发射频率。
- ▶ 虽然 LG 各种型号手机的 SAR 级可能不尽相同, 但它们均是遵循辐射波暴露的相关规定设计制造而成。
- ▶ 国际非电离辐射保护委员会 (ICNIRP) 所规定的 SAR 界限是在十 (10) 克人体组织上平均为 2W/kg。
- ▶ 经 DASY4 测试表明, 此型号手机在手持使用时 SAR 的最大值为 0.443W/kg (10克), 戴在身体上时, 其值为 0.245W/kg (10g)。
- ▶ 各国/地区政府所采用的 SAR 数据信息是由电气和电子工程师协会 (IEEE) 评估制定, 其标准是在一 (1) 克人体组织上平均为 1.6W/Kg (例如美国加拿大澳大利亚和台湾)。

## 产品保养和维护

**警告!** 请仅使用经过认可且与特定手机型号相符的电池、充电器和配件。使用其它类型的配件将可能终止该手机的相关证明或担保, 甚至可能造成危险。

- ▶ 请勿擅自拆装手机。(如需任何维修, 请将其交给具备相关资格的服务技术人员)
- ▶ 手机应远离诸如电视机、收音机或个人计算机等电器设备。
- ▶ 切勿将手机置于散热设备或炊具附近。
- ▶ 切勿抛掷手机。

## 有效的手机操作

**要以最少的耗电量发挥手机的最佳性能，请您注意以下事项：**

- ▶ 通话时请握住手机。直接向话筒中说话，请避开天线，并且手机应位于肩部之上。
- ▶ 使用手机时请勿握住天线，因为这样不仅会影响通话质量，还将增加手机工作时的耗电量，从而缩短通话和待机时间。

## 电子设备

**所有手机都可能受到干扰，这种干扰会对性能造成影响。**

- ▶ 在未经允许的情况下，不得在医疗设备附近使用手机。不要将手机放在心脏起搏点上，即胸前的口袋内。
- ▶ 手机可能会对某些助听器造成干扰。
- ▶ 微弱的干扰可能会影响电视、收音机、个人计算机等。
- ▶ 不要折弯，刮擦或将其暴露在静电下。

## 行车安全

查阅有关在驾驶时使用手机的本地法律法规。

- ▶ 请勿在驾驶时使用手持电话。
- ▶ 驾驶时应全神贯注。
- ▶ 如有条件，可使用免提装置。
- ▶ 如驾驶条件不允许，请将车停在路边或空地旁，然后再拨打或接听电话。
- ▶ 射频能量可能影响车辆内的电子系统，例如立体声音响，安全设备等。
- ▶ 驾车时，不要将手机或免提装置放在靠近安全气囊的地方。如果无线装置安装不当，则在安全气囊弹出时，您可能会受到严重创伤。

若您在户外听音乐时请您将音量调节适当。确保您能掌握周围环境和动态。特别在您过马路时应特别注意。

## 防止损伤您的听力

长时间高分贝的音量会损伤您的听力。所以我们建议您不要贴近耳边开/关电话听筒。注意将音乐及通话音量调节适当。

## 爆破现场

切勿在引爆过程中使用手机。请遵守相关限制，并按照规定行事。

## 潜在的爆炸性环境

- ▶ 切勿在加油站使用手机。切勿将手机靠近燃料或化学物品。
- ▶ 如车辆上携带有移动电话或其配件，请勿在车厢里装载或运输可燃性气体、液体或易爆物品。

## 在飞机上

无线设备可能对飞机造成干扰。

- ▶ 请在登机前关闭手机。
- ▶ 未经机务人员允许，请勿擅自使用手机。

## 电池信息及保养

您无需在再次充电前对电池进行完全放电。与其它电池系统不同，本机电池不具有可能影响电池性能的记忆效应。

- ▶ 只能使用 LG 电池和充电器。LG 充电器设计会最大程度地延长电池使用寿命。
- ▶ 切勿拆解电池组或将其短路。

# 关于安全有效使用手机的准则

- ▶ 保持电池组的金属触点清洁。
- ▶ 当电池不再提供合乎要求的性能时，请更换电池。在需要更换之前，电池组可以反复充电数百次。
- ▶ 如果电池已经使用很长一段时间，请对电池再次进行充电以保持最佳使用状态。
- ▶ 切勿将电池充电器暴露在直射阳光下，或置于诸如浴室之类的高湿环境中。

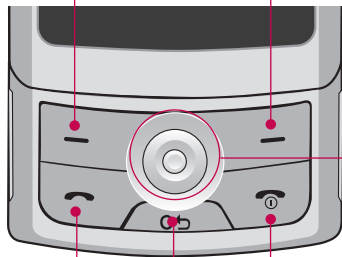

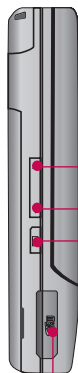

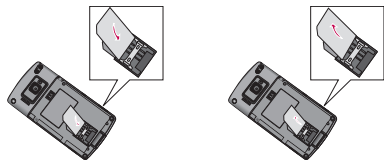

## 安装 USIM 卡和电池

### 1. 安装 USIM 卡。

将 USIM 卡滑进 USIM 卡弹夹中。确保 USIM 卡以正确方式插入并且卡上的金色接触区域面朝下。要取出 USIM 卡，轻轻将卡向下按并反向推出。

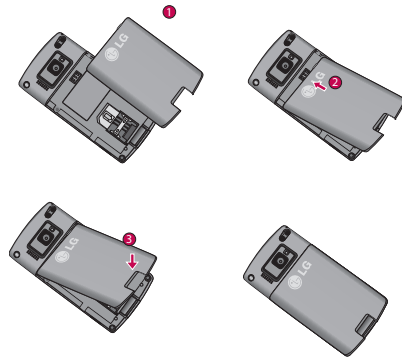
- ▶ 插入SIM卡无效。

### 2. 安装电池。

将电池顶端的卡钮与手机对齐，按下电池，使其卡入到位。

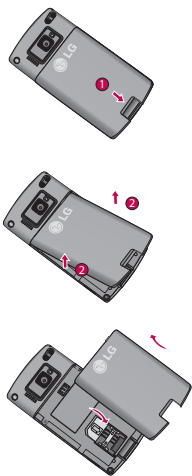


# 使用入门

## 3. 卸下电池。

在卸下电池前确保电源已关闭（如果在电源打开时从手机上卸下电池，可能导致手机出现故障）。

推动电池释放按钮，将电池拿起。



## 为电池充电

要用充电器为手机充电，您必须先安装电池。



1. 如图所示，箭头面朝上，充电器的一端插入手机右侧的插孔，直到卡入到位。
2. 将充电器的另一端连接到电源插座。

3. 充电结束后，电池图标条棒将停止闪烁。
4. 使用手机之前，请确保电池已完全充电。

### 小心

- 不要强行插拔充电接口，这可能会损坏手机和（或）充电器。
- 如果在国外使用电池组充电器，务必使用附属的适配插头进行适当的配置。
- 不要在充电过程中取出电池或 USIM 卡。

### 警告！

- 在发生雷电时，务必拔掉电线和充电器，以免遭受电击或发生火灾。
- 确保没有细尖的物体，如动物牙齿、指甲等进入手机内触碰电池。这可能引发火灾。
- 手机在充电时，不要拨打电话或接听来电，否则会使手机短路或发生电击或引发火灾。

# 使用入门

## 如何使用 microSD 存储卡



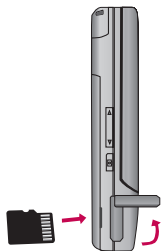
〈MicroSD 存储卡〉

### 〈如何插入 microSD 存储卡〉

1. 关闭手机电源。在手机开机时插入或取出 microSD 卡有可能会损坏保存在存储卡中的文件。
2. 掀开 microSD 插槽保护。



3. 将存储卡插入插槽。金属触点面朝正视图，从金属触点所在的那端插入存储卡插槽。不要太用力地推入 microSD。如果不能轻松地将其插入插槽，则您可能是插入方式出错或是插槽内有异物。
4. 向前推入存储卡，直到听到“咔”的一声，这意味着 microSD 卡已被正确插入。




5. 关闭插槽塑料保护。
6. 要取出存储卡，请关机后打开插槽保护，先轻微往插入卡的方向按一下，卡会自动弹出一部分，小心取出存储卡。

**注意：**

- ▶ 仅可使用经制造商认可的存储卡。某些存储卡不与手机兼容。
- ▶ 写入存储卡时，请在写入操作完成后再次取出存储卡。
- ▶ 不要折弯存储卡或强行将其插入插槽。





## 存储卡格式化

开始使用存储卡之前，您必须先对其进行格式化。插入存储卡后，请选择“菜单”>“设置”>“内存状态”>“格式化外部存储器”，然后按 。



# 常规功能

## 拨打电话和应答电话

### 拨打语音电话



1. 输入电话号码，包括区号。
  - ▶ 要删除一个数字，请按 。
  - ▶ 要删除所有数字，请长按 。
2. 按  拨打电话。
3. 按  结束呼叫。

### 使用发送键拨打电话

1. 在待机模式下，按 ，屏幕上将显示最近的已拨电话、已接来电和未接来电。
2. 通过向上/向下移动操纵键选择所需号码。
3. 按  呼叫号码。


## 拨打视频电话

您可以在 3G 覆盖的服务区域拨打视频电话。如果被呼叫者具有 3G 视频电话，且位于 3G 覆盖的服务区域内，那么你们即可建立视频通话连接。您还可以接听视频电话。要拨打/应答视频电话，请执行以下操作。

1. 使用键盘输入电话号码，或者从通话记录列表选择电话号码。
  - ▶ 要更正错误，请短按  删除输入的最后一个数字，或者长按  删除所有数字。
2. 若不想使用扬声器，请插入耳机。
3. 要启用视频功能，请按左软键 [选项]，然后选择“拨打视频电话”。
  - ▶ 要拨打视频电话，系统将通知您需要关闭某些应用程序。



### 备注

- ▶ 视频电话可能需要一定时间进行连接。请耐心等待。连接时间也取决于对方应答呼叫的速度。在对方应答后，屏幕将显示对方和自己的图像。



4. 请根据需要调整相机位置。
5. 按  结束呼叫。

### 从电话本拨打语音/视频电话


拨打在电话本中存有号码的联系人的电话非常方便。

1. 向下移动操纵键以访问电话本列表。
2. 滚动到所需联系人。
3. 按  拨打电话。按左软键选择“拨打视频电话”。
4. 按  结束呼叫。

### 拨打国际电话

1. 按住  以输入国际电话前缀。“+”字符可作为国际通话接入码。
2. 输入国家代码、地区代码和电话号码。
3. 按  拨打电话。

### 调节音量

通话过程中，如果要调节听筒音量，请使用手机左侧  键。



### 接听电话

当接收到电话时，手机响铃并且屏幕有所显示。如果可以识别致电者，则会显示该致电者的电话号码（或保存在电话本中的姓名）。

# 常规功能

1. 按发送键应答来电。

## 备注

- ▶ 要拒绝来电，请按  或右软键两次。
- ▶ 如果接听模式设置为“按任意键”，除了  键、两次右软键、音量侧键和相机热键外，按任何键都将接听来电。

2. 按  拒绝来电。


## 备注

- ▶ 在使用电话本或其它菜单功能时，您也可以接听来电。
- ▶ 在手机连接到兼容耳机时，您也可以使用耳机接听键来接听来电。


## 激活振动模式的快捷方式

在待机模式下，长按右导航键可激活振动模式。

## 信号强度

您可以通过手机 LCD 屏幕上的信号指示符 () 检查信号强度。信号强度会有所差别，尤其是在建筑物内。移到窗口附近可以改进接收质量。

以下图标显示您正在使用的网络服务：

- ▶  : 2G 网络
- ▶  : 3G 网络
- ▶  : GPRS 网络

## 输入文本

您可以使用键盘输入字母数字字符。

例如，在电话本中存储姓名、写文本信息、创建个人问候语或者在日历中安排事件等，都需要输入文本。本手机提供以下文本输入方法。

## 更改文本输入模式

1. 当处于允许输入字符的区域中时，在 LCD 屏幕的右上角可以看到文本输入模式指示符。
2. 通过按 **#0** 更改文本输入模式。

## 使用 T9 模式

T9 预测性文本输入模式允许您以最少的按键次数输入单词。当您按每个按键时，手机开始显示它根据内置词典认为正确的字符。当添加新单词时，手机将从词典中选择可能性最大的单词。

1. 当处于 T9 预测性文本输入模式时，通过按 **2.1** 到 **9.9** 开始输入单词。每个字母按一次键。
  - ▶ 在输入字母时，单词不断更改。请忽略屏幕上显示的单词，直至整个单词输入完毕。
  - ▶ 如果在完成输入之后单词仍不正确，请按 **\*+** 一次或多次以循环选择其它单词。

## 示例

按 **4.3** **6.2** **6.2** **3.1** 键入 Good。

按 **\*+** 则输入 Home。

- ▶ 如果单词选择列表中没有所需的单词，请使用 ABC 模式添加该单词。
2. 按 **0=** 以空格结束每个单词。

要删除字母，按 **←**。按住 **←** 删除所有的显示内容。


## 拼音模式





“拼音”输入是通过中文字符的汉语拼音来查找中文字符。当输入发音的第一个字母时，您便可以直接查找字符。输入过程中，可以用 **\*+** 键输入各种符号，可以长按数字键输入数字，之后可以继续输入中文。

例如) 要输入“国民”请依次按数字键 **4.2**，**8.9**，**6.2**，此时在子编辑屏幕上会显示‘Guo’，‘Huo’等拼音。通过 **1.∞** 键或者 **⊙** 键选择‘Guo’则所有与之发音相同的字符均将列出供您选择。然后您便可以从中选择字符。（利用数字键或导航键来选择相应的字符。）现在选择完后，屏幕上将再次显示多个字符。您可以按相同的方法输入“民”。也可以使用简拼功能输入词组。

## 笔划模式

如何使用笔划来选择中文字符。在您依次输入中文笔划时，屏幕上将显示相关的中文字符。按  后利用左右导航键来选择字符。

例如) 要输入“你”请依次输入键 , , , 之后您便可以看到相应的字符显示“你”。请按  后按数字键来选定“你”。

## 使用 abc 模式

使用  至  输入文本。

- 按标示为所需字母的按键：
  - ▶ 按一次输入第一个字母。
  - ▶ 按两次输入第二个字母。
  - ▶ 依次类推。
- 要插入空格，按  一次。要删除字母，按 。按住  清空显示屏。

## 使用123（数字）模式

使用 123 模式，您可以在信息中输入数字（例如电话号码）。

## 使用符号模式

使用符号模式，您可以输入各种符号或特殊字符。要输入符号，请选择“选项”>“插入”>“符号”。您也可以按 ，使用导航键和数字键选择所需的符号。



# 呼叫中菜单

您的手机提供许多可以在呼叫期间使用的控制功能。要在呼叫期间访问这些功能,按左软键[选项]。


## 呼叫期间

在手机屏幕上,在呼叫期间显示的菜单与在待机模式中显示的默认主菜单不同,下面对这些选项进行说明。

## 拨打第二个电话(需网络支持)

您可以在通话画面上直接输入您要拨打的第二个电话,或者您也可以按选项选择拨打电话。


## 在两通话间切换

要在两个呼叫之间切换,按  或左软键,然后选择切换。



## 接听来电

当您在通话过程中有来电,手机也会提醒您。听筒会发出提示音,显示屏会显示第二个来电正在等待中。该功能被称为呼叫等待,只有在您的网络支持它时才可用。

要获取有关如何启动和关闭呼叫等待的详细信息,请参见呼叫等待(菜单 8.7)。

如果激活了呼叫等待功能,您可以按 ,从而保持第一个呼叫并应答第二个呼叫。

## 拒接来电

只需按  键,您可以拒接来电而不作应答。在呼叫期间,您可以通过按右软键或通过按 ,拒绝接听来电。

## 使用麦克风静音

在通话中,您可以按左软键然后选择静音将话筒静音。按[取消静音]可以将手机取消静音。将手机静音后,呼叫者就无法听到您讲话,但您仍可听到对方讲话。

## 在呼叫期间打开双音多频音调



要在呼叫期间打开双音多频音调,按左软键,然后选择开启双音多频。可以使用同样方式关闭双音多频音调。双音多频音调允许您的手机使用自动电话交换机。

## 多方通话

通过多方通话服务，您能够与多个致电者同时通话（如果您的网络运营商支持此功能）。仅当您具有一个活动的呼叫及一个保持的呼叫时（已应答这两个呼叫），才可以建立多方通话。

一旦建立多方通话，则建立多方呼叫的用户可以添加、断开或分离（即从多方通话中撤出，但仍与您相连接）呼叫。所有这些选项均在“通话中”菜单中提供。在多方通话中最多可以与五位致电者通话。开始之后，您即可以控制多方通话，并且只有您能将致电者加入多方通话。

### 拨打第二个电话

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# Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of the advanced and compact KD876 3G video mobile phone, designed to operate with the latest digital mobile communication technology.



This user's guide contains important information on the use and operation of this phone. Please read all the information carefully for optimal performance and to prevent any damage to or misuse of the phone. Any changes or modifications not expressly approved in this user's guide could void your warranty for this equipment.

# For Your Safety

Please read these simple guidelines. Not following these guidelines may be dangerous or illegal. Further detailed information is given in this manual.

## Warning

- ▶ Mobile Phones must be switched off at all times in aircrafts.
- ▶ Do not hold the phone in your hand while driving.
- ▶ Do not use your phone near petrol stations, fuel depots, chemical plants or blasting operations.
- ▶ For your safety, use ONLY specified ORIGINAL batteries and chargers.
- ▶ Do not handle the phone with wet hands while it is being charged. It may cause an electric shock or seriously damage your phone.
- ▶ Keep the phone in a safe place out of small children's reach. It includes small parts which, if detached, may cause a choking hazard.

## Caution

# Guidelines for safe and efficient use

## Radio frequency energy irradiation

Information about radiation wave irradiation and absorption rate(SAR).The design of this KD876 mobile phone fully followed the radiation wave irradiation relevant safety requirements,which based on scientific guiding principle,including the allowed radiation limit for ensuring everyone's safety regardless of his age and healthy state.

- ▶ The radiation wave irradiation guiding principle employed a unit of measurement known as absorption rate, or SAR. When testing for SAR, the phone will use a standardised method to transmit frequency with its highest measure power level in all available bands.
- ▶ While there may be differences between the SAR levels of various LG phone models, they are all designed to observe the relevant provisions for exposure to radiation wave.
- ▶ The SAR limit regulated by International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection is 2W/kg averaged over ten (10) gramme of tissue.
- ▶ The highest SAR value for this model phone tested by DASY4 for hand-held use is 0.443 W/kg (10g) and when worn on the body is 0.245 W/kg (10g).

- ▶ The SAR data information employed by the governments of different countries is developed by the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineering (IEEE) through evaluating,its standard is 1.6W/kg averaged over one (1) gramme of tissue( such as America Canada Australia and Taiwan).

## Product care and maintenance

**WARNING!** Only use batteries, chargers and accessories approved for use with this particular phone model. The use of any other types may invalidate any approval or warranty applying to the phone, and may be dangerous.

- ▶ Do not disassemble this unit. Take it to a qualified service technician when repair work is required.

- ▶ Keep away from electrical appliances such as a TV's, radios or personal computers.
- ▶ Never place your phone near a heater or tableware.
- ▶ Never place your phone in a microwave oven as it will cause the battery to explode.
- ▶ Do not drop.
- ▶ Do not subject this unit to mechanical vibration or shock.
- ▶ The coating of the phone may be damaged if covered with wrap or vinyl wrapper.
- ▶ Do not use harsh chemicals (such as alcohol, benzene, thinners, etc.) or detergents to clean your phone. There is a risk of this causing a fire.

## Efficient phone operation

**To enjoy optimum performance with minimum power consumption please.**

- ▶ Hold the phone during a call. Speak to the speakerphone directly, please avoid antenna and the phone should be over your shoulder.
- ▶ Do not hold the antenna when the phone is in use. If you hold it, it can affect call quality, it may also cause the phone to operate at a higher power level than needed and shorten talk and standby times.

## Electronic devices

**All mobile phones may get interference, which could affect performance.**

- ▶ Do not use your mobile phone near medical equipment without requesting permission. Avoid placing the phone over pacemakers (i.e. in your breast pocket.)
- ▶ Some hearing aids might be disturbed by mobile phones.

- ▶ Minor interference may affect TVs, radios, PCs, etc.
- ▶ Do not bend, scratch, or expose to static electricity.

## Road safety

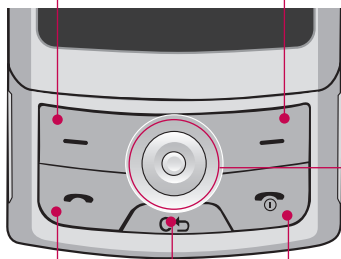

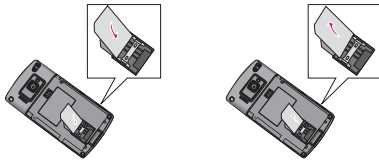


# Getting started

## Installing the USIM card and battery

### 1. Installing the USIM card.

Slide the USIM card into the USIM card holder. Make sure that the USIM card is properly inserted and the gold contact area on the card is facing downwards. To remove the USIM card, press down lightly and pull it in the reverse direction.

### Note

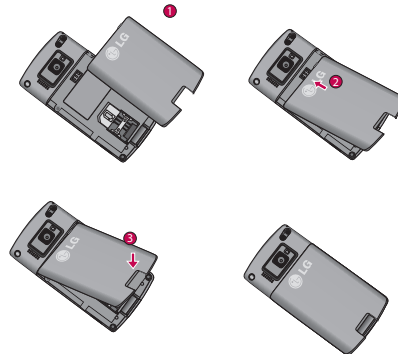
- ▶ The LG KD876 handset does not access to GSM or TD-SCDMA networks with GSM SIM card inserted.

### Note

- ▶ The metal contact of the USIM card can easily be damaged by scratches. Pay special attention to the USIM card while handling. Follow the instructions supplied with the USIM card.

### 2. Install the battery.

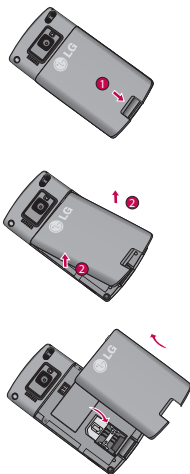
Slide the battery upwards until it snaps back into place.





### 3. To remove the battery.

Make sure the power is off before you remove the battery (Removing the battery from the phone when the power is on may cause the phone to malfunction). Press and hold down the battery release button and slide the battery down.



## Charging the battery

Before connecting the travel adapter to the phone you must first install the battery.



1. With the arrow facing you as shown in the diagram push the plug on the battery adapter into the socket on the left side of the phone until it clicks into place.
2. Connect the other end of the travel adapter to the mains socket.

3. The moving bars on the battery icon will stop after charging is complete.
4. Ensure the battery is fully charged before using the phone for the first time.

## CAUTION!

- Do not force the connector as this may damage the phone and/or the travel adapter.
- If you use the battery pack charger when abroad, use an attachment plug adaptor for the proper configuration.
- Do not remove your battery or the USIM card while charging.

## WARNING!

- *Unplug the power cord and charger during lightning storms to avoid electric shock or fire.*
- *Make sure that no sharp-edged items such as animal teeth or nails, come into contact with the battery. This may cause a fire.*
- *Do not place or answer calls while charging the phone as it may short-circuit the phone and/or cause electric shock or fire.*

## Disconnecting the charger

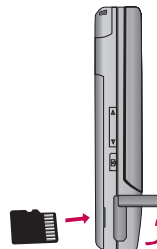

### <How to insert a microSD memory card>

1. Turn the phone off. Inserting or removing the microSD when the phone is on may damage the files stored in the memory card.
2. Lift the plastic cover which protects the microSD slot.



3. Insert the memory card into the slot. The gold contacts must be kept on the back of the microSD. Don't push the microSD too much. If it doesn't go into the slot easily, you may be trying to insert it in the wrong way or there could be a foreign object in the slot.
4. Once inserted, push the memory card until you hear a Click, meaning that the microSD has been correctly engaged.




5. Close the plastic slot protection.
6. To remove the memory card, turn the phone off, open the slot protection and push the microSD to unlock it. Carefully extract the memory card.

# Getting started

## Attention:

- ▶ Only use memory cards that have been approved by the manufacturer. Some memory cards might not be compliant with the handset.
- ▶ When writing to the card, wait for the operation to complete before removing the card.
- ▶ Do not bend the card or force it into the slot.





## Memory card formatting

Before you start to use the memory card you have to format it. After you insert the memory card, select **Menu > Settings > Memory status > Format external memory**, then press . This operation should only be done when you insert the memory card for the first time. During formatting various folders will be created for different data types.



# General Functions

## Making and answering calls

### Making a voice call



1. Enter the number including the full area code.
  - ▶ To delete a digit press .
  - To delete all digits press and hold .
2. Press  to make the call.
3. Press  to finish the call.

### Making a call from the call logs

1. In standby mode, press  and the latest incoming, outgoing and missed phone numbers will be displayed.
2. Select the desired number by moving the joystick to the up/down.
3. Press  to call the number.

### Making a video call


You can make a video call in a 3G covered service area. If the called user has a 3G video phone in a 3G covered service area, the call will be established. You can also answer a video call for video incoming call. To make/answer a video call, do the following.

1. Input the phone number using the keypad, or select the phone number from the calls made/received lists.
  - ▶ To correct mistakes, press  briefly to delete the last number, or press and hold  to delete all numbers.
2. If you do not want to use the speakerphone, ensure you have the headset plugged in.
3. To start the video function, press the left soft key [Options] and select **Make video call**.
  - ▶ You will be notified that you will need to close other applications to make the video call.

## Note



- ▶ The video call may take some time to connect. Please be patient. The connection time will also depend on how quickly the other party answers the call. After the other party has answered, images of both will be displayed on the screen.

4. Adjust the camera position if necessary.
5. Press  to finish the call.



## Making a voice/video call from Contacts

It is easy to call anyone whose number you have stored in your Contacts.


1. Move the joystick to the down to access the contacts list.
2. Scroll to the contact to make a call.

3. Press  to make a voice call. Press the left soft key and select **Make video call** to make a video call.
4. Press  to finish the call.

## Making international calls

1. Press and hold  for the international prefix. The '+' character prefixes the international access code.
2. Enter the country code, area code, and the phone number.
3. Press .

## Adjusting the volume



During a call, if you want to adjust the earpiece volume, use  on the left side of the phone.

## Answering a call

When you receive a call, the phone rings and the flashing phone icon appears on the screen. If the caller can be identified, the caller's phone number (or name if stored in your Contacts) is displayed.

1. Press the send key to answer an incoming call.

### Note


- ▶ To reject an incoming call, press  or the right soft key twice.
- ▶ If the answer mode is set to Press any key, any key will answer a call except for  right soft key twice volume side key and camera hot key.

2. End the call by pressing .


### Note

- ▶ You can answer a call while using the Contacts or other menu features.
- ▶ When the compatible headset is connected, you can also answer a call using the headset key.




## Shortcut to activate vibrate mode

You can activate the vibrate only mode by pressing  and holding down after opening the phone.

### Signal strength

You can check the strength of your signal by the signal indicator () on the LCD screen of your phone. Signal strength can vary, particularly inside buildings. Moving close to a window may improve reception.

The following icons show which network service you are using.

- ▶  : 2G network
- ▶  : 3G network
- ▶  : GPRS network

# General Functions

## Entering text

You can enter alphanumeric characters using the keypad.

For example, storing names in Contacts, writing a message, creating a personal greeting or scheduling events in the calendar all require entering text. The following text input methods are available with the handset.

### Changing the text input mode

1. When you are in a field that allows characters to be entered, you will notice the text input mode indicator in the upper right corner of the LCD screen.
2. Press **#0** to change input mode.

## Using the T9 Mode

The T9 predictive text input mode allows you to enter words easily with a minimum number of key presses. As you press each key, the handset begins to display the characters that it thinks you are typing based on a built-in dictionary. As new letters are added, the word changes to reflect the most likely candidate from the dictionary.


1. When you are in the T9 predictive text input mode, start entering a word by pressing **21** to **9-**. Press one key per letter.
  - ▶ The word changes as letters are typed. Ignore what's on the screen until the word is typed completely.
  - ▶ If the word is still incorrect after typing completely, press **\*+** once or more to scroll through the other word options.



**Example**

Press     to type **Good** .




Press  to get **Home**.

- ▶ If the desired word is missing from the word choices list, add it by using the ABC mode.
2. Complete each word with a space by pressing .

To delete letters, press . Press and hold down  to erase entire words.

**Using the ABC Mode**

Use  to  to enter your text.

1. Press the key labelled with the required letter:
  - ▶ Once for the first letter.
  - ▶ Twice for the second letter.
  - ▶ And so on.
2. To insert a space, press  once. To delete letters, press . Press and hold down  to clear the display.

- ▶ The characters assigned to the keys and their order of appearance depends on the language selected using the option Input method. The table above provides the characters set for English language.

## Using the 123 (Number) mode

The 123 mode enables you to enter numbers in a message(a telephone number, for example).

## Using the symbol mode

The symbol mode enables you to enter various symbols or special characters. To enter a symbol, select **Options > Insert > Symbol**. Use the navigation and numeric keys to select the desired symbol and press .

# In-call menu

Your phone provides a number of control functions that you can use during a call. To access these functions during a call, press the left soft key [Options].


## During a call

The menu displayed on the handset screen during a call is different to the default main menu displayed when in standby mode, and the options are described below.

## Making a second call (Network dependent)


You can enter a second call you want to dial on the call display, or choose to make a call by pressing Options.

## Switching between two calls



To switch between two calls, press  the left soft key then select Swap.

## Answering an incoming call

When there is an incoming call during a call, the phone will alert you. A tone sounds in the earpiece, and the display will show that a second call is waiting. This feature, known as Call waiting, is only available if your network supports it.

For details of how to activate and deactivate Call waiting see Call waiting [Menu 8.7]. If Call waiting is activated, you can put the first call on hold and answer the second, by pressing .

## Rejecting an incoming call

You can reject an incoming call without answering by simply pressing . During a call, you can reject an incoming call by pressing the right soft key or by pressing .

# In-call menu

## Muting the microphone

You can mute the microphone during a call by pressing the [Menu] key then selecting Mute on. The handset can be unmuted by selecting Mute off. When the handset is muted, the caller cannot hear you, but you can still hear them.

## Switching DTMF tones on during a call

To turn DTMF tones on during a call, press the left soft key, and then select DTMF on. DTMF tones can be turned off the same way. DTMF tones allow your phone to make use of an automated switchboard.

## In-call menu



Multiparty or conference calls

The multiparty or conference service provides you with the ability to have a simultaneous conversation with more than one caller, if your network operator supports this feature. A multiparty call can only be set up when you have one active call and one call on hold, both calls having been answered.

Once a multiparty call is set up, calls can be added, disconnected or separated (that is, removed from the multiparty call but still connected to you) by

the person who set up the multiparty call. These options are all available from the In-Call menu. The maximum callers in a multiparty call are five. Once started, you are in control of the multiparty call, and only you can add callers to the multiparty call.

## making a second call

You can make a second call while currently on a call. Enter the second number and press . When the second call is connected, the first call is automatically placed on hold. You can swap between calls by pressing .

## Setting up a conference call

Place one call on hold and while the active call is on, press the left soft key and then select Connect the call.

## Putting a conference call on hold

To activate the conference call on hold, press the send key. Other users on hold will stay connected. To return to conference call mode, press the left soft key [Options] followed by Conference call. You can press the send key again, you can also select resume the call by pressing the left key [Options]


## Adding calls to the conference call

To add a call to an existing conference call, press the left soft key, select make a all, then select connect the call from [Options] after connected.

## Taking a private call during a conference call

To have a private call with one caller from a conference call, select Private by pressing the left soft key, then select the number you want to have a private call from the numbers of all callers displayed on the screen. And put all the other callers on hold.

## Ending a conference call

To end a conference call, press . You can also end a conference call by selecting End call after pressing the left soft key.

## Create new message

Menu 1.1

### Text message (Menu 1.1.1)

1. Enter a number in the To field directly or search for a number from the Contacts.

#### Option menus in To field

- ▶ **Add contacts:** You can add recipients from your Contacts.
  - ▶ **Send:** Select this to send the message.
  - ▶ **Save to drafts:** Saves the message to drafts.
  - ▶ **Cancel:** Select this to cancel editing.
2. Moving the joystick to the down shows another To field in which you can enter a number. (You can enter up to 10 numbers)
  3. If you press the joystick to the down, the focus is moved to the Message field.
  4. Enter your message in the Message field.

#### Option menus in Message field

## Multimedia message (Menu 1.1.2)

You can write and edit a message containing a combination of text, image, video and audio. You can enter up to 10 number in To and Cc respectively.

### Option menus
