



Playable File Requirement

MP3/ WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows :


Compatible USB Devices

- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.

USB Device Requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minutes to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit is not supported when the total number of files is 1 000 or more.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices, mobile phone are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- · Some USB may not work with this unit.
- This unit can charge iPod/iPhone by connecting it to USB port in power on.



Battery Installation


1. Turn the battery compartment lid counterclockwise by using a coin. Then take the battery compartment lid out.



2. Insert and fix the battery with the plus(+) facing in the same direction as the plus(+) on the battery compartment lid.




3. Put the battery compartment lid on the remote control and turn it clockwise to close.







Control Panel

• Switch function:

Connecting the AC **Adapter**

- 1. Connect the supplied AC power cord to the AC adapter.
- 2. Connect the AC adapter cable to DC IN adapter input.
- 3. Plug the AC power cord into an AC outlet. Then the unit goes into standby mode.



Caution

Only use the AC adapter supplied with this device. Do not use a power supply from another device or manufacturer. Using any other power cable or power supply may cause damage to the device and void your warranty.

Setting the Clock



Note

If the power has been interrupted or the power plug has been disconnected, the clock setting is erased.

Setting the Clock **Automatically**



Note -

- Make sure that your iPod/iPhone/iPad or your Android device has set the clock correctly.
- In standby mode, the clock will not synchronize with your iPod/iPhone/iPad or your Android device.
- In auto clock synchronization, "LG Bluetooth Remote" app has priority over the docking
- The 24 hour format can be set only for Android OS.

Setting the Clock by Synchronizing with Your iPod/iPhone/iPad

Connect the iPod/iPhone/iPad firmly. Then the clock setting in the control panel will synchronize with your iPod/iPhone/iPad.



Note

The synchronized time may be slightly different from that of your iPod/iPhone/iPad.

Setting the Clock through "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" app on your iPod/ iPhone/iPad or your Android device. (see page 17-

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating Bluetooth connection through "LG Bluetooth Remote" app.

Setting the Clock Manually

If necessary, you can set the clock manually.

- 1. Press and hold **Clock** on the back panel for two seconds.
 - The clock digits begin to blink.
- 2. Press \ll / \gg to select the 12/24 hour format.
 - 12:00 (for a PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
- 3. Press >/II.
 - The hour digits begin to blink.
- 4. Press ≪/≫ to set the hour.
- 5. Press >/II.
 - The minutes digits begin to blink.
- 6. Press ≪/≫ to set the minute.
- 7. Press **>/II**.
 - Note

If you want to reset the clock, repeat steps 1-7.





Install the supplied stand for iPad to keep iPad stable before you place the iPad.




- An error message "ERROR" appears when :
- your iPod/iPhone/iPad is not connected firmly.
- this unit recognizes your iPod/iPhone/iPad as an unknown device.
- your iPod/iPhone/iPad is exceptionally low in power.
 - → The battery needs to be charged.
 - → If you charge the battery while iPod/ iPhone/iPad is extremely low in power, it may take longer to be charged.
- You may not control your iPod/iPhone/iPad from this unit due to malfunction of iPod/ iPhone/iPad.
- Depending on your iPod/iPhone/iPad's software version, it may not be possible to control your iPod/iPhone/iPad from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.
- If you use an application, make a call, or send and receive SMS text message, etc. on iPod touch/iPhone/iPad, disconnect it from iPod/iPhone/iPad dock of this unit and then use it.




- During playback, if you change to another function, then return to the USB function, and then press >/II, you can listen to music from last point you played.
- The playing time is displayed until 59 minutes and 59 seconds.
- USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear.
- Folders will be presented as the following order;
 ROOT → FOLDER 1 → FOLDER 3 → FOLDER 7 → FOLDER 8 → FOLDER 5 → FOLDER 6
- File will be played from ♪ file No.1 to ♪ file No.14 one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- *ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".

Listening to Music from Your **External Device**

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of external device. (Portable cable is not supplied as an accessory with this unit.)




- 1. Connect the external device to the **PORT.IN** connector of the unit.
- 2. Turn the power on by pressing \circlearrowleft .
- 3. Select the PORT (PORTABLE) function by pressing **FUNCTION** or **-**.
- 4. Turn the external device on and start playing it.

How to Affix the Ferrite Core

You must affix a core (supplied with the model you purchased) in order to reduce or eliminate electrical interference.


- 1. Pull the stopper [a] of the ferrite core to open.
- 2. Wind the portable cable around the ferrite core
- 3. Close the ferrite core until it clicks.



Radio Operations

Antenna Connection

Connect the FM wire antenna to FM antenna connector.



Listening to the Radio

- Press FUNCTION or repeatedly until FM appears in the control panel. The last received station is tuned in.
- Auto tuning: Press ≪ / ➤ for about 2 seconds until the frequency indication starts changing, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Manual tuning : Press \ll / \gg repeatedly.

3. Adjust the volume by pressing -/+ (Volume).

Presetting the Radio Stations

You can store up to 10 FM preset stations.

Before tuning make sure that you have turned.

Before tuning, make sure that you have turned down the volume.

- 2. Select the desired frequency by using \ll / \gg .
- Press MEMORY. A preset number will blink in the control panel.
- Press FOLDER/PRESET ∧/V to select the preset number you want.
- 5. Press MEMORY. The station is stored.
- 6. Repeat the steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.

Press **FOLDER/PRESET** Λ/V to select a preset station.

Deleting All the Saved Stations

Press and hold **MEMORY** for two seconds. "CLR" will flash up. Press **MEMORY** again. Then all the saved stations are deleted.

Improving Poor FM Reception

Press >/II. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.



- If all stations have already been preset, "FULL" will appear in the control panel for a moment and then a preset number will
- Although all stations were preset, you can preset a station by overwriting the previous station.
- You can not delete the preset stations one by one.

Using a Bluetooth Wireless Technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth® is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The available range is within 10 meters.

(The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the bluetooth in the other rooms.) Connecting individual devices under Bluetooth® wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with Bluetooth® wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via Bluetooth® wireless technology. Available Devices: Mobile phone, MP3, Laptop, PDA.

Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use Bluetooth wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile. A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to Music of a **Bluetooth Device**

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is turned on in to your Bluetooth device. Refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

- 1. Select the Bluetooth function by using the **⊕ FUNCTION** or **⊕**. Appears "BT" and "BT READY" in the control panel.
- 2. Operate the Bluetooth device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the Bluetooth device, a list of the devices found may appear in the Bluetooth device display depending on the type of Bluetooth device. Your unit appears as "LG AUDIO ND5520".
- 3. Enter the PIN code. PIN code: 0000
- 4. When this unit successfully is connected with your Bluetooth device, Bluetooth LED of this unit lights up and "PAIR" appears in the control panel.



Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some device have a different pairing way.

5. Listen to music.

To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide.



Note -

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave.
- You cannot control the Bluetooth device with this unit.
- Pairing is limited one Bluetooth device per one unit and multi-pairing is not supported.
- Although the distance between your Bluetooth and the set is less than 10m, there are obstacles between both, your Bluetooth device cannot be connected.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- When not connected the Bluetooth. "BT" and "BT READY" appears on the control panel.
- The electrical malfunction due to devices using same frequency such as Medical equipment, Microwaves or wireless I AN devices, the connection will be disconnected.
- When someone stands and interrupts communication between Bluetooth device and the player, the connection will be disconnected.
- If the gotten away of the distance between Bluetooth and the unit, the sound quality is lower and lower. The connection will disconnect when the space between the Bluetooth and the unit gets out of the operating range of Bluetooth.
- The device with Bluetooth wireless technology is disconnected, if you turn off the main unit or put the device away from the main unit more than 10m.
- If the Bluetooth device is disconnected, you should connect the Bluetooth device to vour unit.

Using Bluetooth App

About "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

"LG Bluetooth Remote" app brings a suite of new features to this unit.

To enjoy more features, you are recommended to download and install free "I G Bluetooth Remote"

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" App onto Your Bluetooth Device

1. Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" app through QR code. Use the scanning software to scan the OR code

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" App by Docking Your iPod/iPhone/iPad onto This Unit

- Connect your iPod/iPhone/iPad to iPod/iPhone/ iPad Dock. The display for downloading "LG Bluetooth Remote" will be linked automatically (Apple iOS only).
- 2. Tap an icon for installation.
- 3. Tap an icon for downloading.

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" App through "Apple App Store" or "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)"

- 1. Tap the "Apple App Store" icon or "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)" icon.
- 2. In the search bar, type in the "LG Bluetooth Remote" and search it.
- 3. In the search result list, find and tap "LG Bluetooth Remote" to start downloading Bluetooth app.

- Make sure that your Bluetooth device is connected to the Internet.
- Make sure that your Bluetooth device is equipped with "Apple App Store" or "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)".

Activate Bluetooth with "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

"LG Bluetooth Remote" app helps to connect your bluetooth device to this unit.

- Tap "LG Bluetooth Remote" app icon on the home screen to open "LG Bluetooth Remote" app, and go to the main menu.
- 2. Tap [Setting] and select the unit you want.
- 3. If you want to get more information to operate, tap [Setting] and [Help].



Note

- If you place your iPod/iPhone/iPad into the dock of this unit while your iPod/iPhone/ iPad is connected to this unit by Bluetooth connection, the Bluetooth connection is deactivated.
- If this unit is BT mode and you connect your iPod/iPhone/iPad to this unit after connecting your iPod/iPhone/iPad to this unit by Bluetooth connection, the function is automatically switched to IPOD mode. Then if you disconnect your iPod/iPhone/iPad from this unit, it is automatically connected to this unit by Bluetooth connection.
- The Bluetooth connection of iPod/iPhone/ iPad is not activated while iPod/iPhone/iPad is placed into the dock of this unit.
- This unit does not support the multi-pairing.
 If this unit is already connected with other
 Bluetooth device, disconnect that device and then try again.
- If you use "LG Bluetooth Remote" app for operation, there would be some differences between "LG Bluetooth Remote" app and the supplied remote control. Use the supplied remote control as necessary.
- Depending on the Bluetooth device, "LG Bluetooth Remote" app may not work.
- "LG Bluetooth Remote" app for Apple iOS is slightly different from that of Android OS.
- The connection you've made may be disconnected if you select other application or change the setting of the connected device via "LG Bluetooth Remote" app. In such a case, please check the connection status.

Other Operations

Using Your Unit as an Alarm Clock

- 1. Make sure that you have set the clock correctly. (See "Setting the Clock" on page 10-11.)
- 2. Press and hold **Alarm On/Off** on the back panel.
- The alarm sound sources blink. (FM (Tuner)/ USB/IPOD) While each of sound sources blinks, select the one you want by pressing >/II. If you select FM (Tuner) mode, you can select the station you preset by pressing
- "ON (Time)" setting is displayed.
 The hour setting blinks. Press ≪/≫ to select the hour and then press >/II to save.
- The minute setting blinks. Press ≪ /≫ to select the minute and then press >/II to save.
- The volume setting blinks. Press ≪ / ≫ to change the volume and then press >/II to save.



- Alarm function only works when this unit is turned off.
- You can check the setting status by pressing **Alarm On/Off** on the back panel two times.
- If you want to reset the alarm, repeat steps 2-6.

Activate and Deactivate the Alarm Timer

Press **Alarm On/Off** repeatedly on the back panel to activate or deactivate the timer.

- If the timer is activated, " . " is displayed.
- If the timer is deactivated, " \(\bigs \)" is not displayed.

Stop Alarm Ring

- When the alarm rings, press **Alarm On/Off** on the back panel or press (1).
- The alarm stops but the alarm settings remain.



Note

- If you don't set clock on your iPod/iPhone/ iPad, the unit will not be synchronized for the clock with your iPod/iPhone/iPad.
- If you unplug the cord from an outlet, the alarm setting you set is not stored.
- After setting a clock function, you can set alarm function.
- If you do not press any button for 30 minutes after the alarm goes off, the alarm will shut off automatically.
- If you set the clock and alarm, you can check the time and alarm icon " " by pressing Alarm On/Off although the unit is standby mode.
- If the time you set is up, the unit will be turned on automatically.
- You can only set 12 hour format. (for a PM display)

Snoozing

The snoozing function wakes you up every 10 minutes if you tap anywhere on the control panel while the alarm activates

Resume Playback

The unit memorizes the point where you pressed >/|| Press >/|| to resume playback.

Playing Repeatedly or Randomly

Press repeatedly. Then the current file will be played back repeatedly or randomly. (ONE/DIR/ALL/RAND(RANDOM)/OFF)

Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** once. The control panel will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until the control panel get bright.

Sleep Timer Setting

While listening to music or radio, press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After delay time, the unit will turn off. (You can see the following order, 180 -> 150 -> 120 -> 90 -> 80 -> 70 -> 60 -> 50 -> 40 -> 30 -> 20 ->

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until the control panel get bright.



Note -

- You can check the remaining time before the unit turns off by pressing SLEEP.
- Sleep function will work after dimmer function

Setting the Sound Mode

This system has a number of pre-set sound fields. You can select a desired sound mode by using SOUND EFFECT.

The displayed items for the equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

Maybe you need to reset the sound mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound file is changed.

Turning off the Sound **Temporarily**

Press to mute the sound. You can mute the sound in order, for example, to answer the telephone. And "MUTE" will appear in the control panel. To cancel mute function, press again or adjust volume level by pressing +/- (Volume).
