

## Playable File Requirement

#### MP3/WMA Music File Requirement

MP3/ WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows :

- Sampling frequency : within 32 to 48 kHz (MP3), within 32 to 48 kHz (WMA)
- Bit rate : within 32 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Maximum files : Under 999
- Maximum folders : Under 99
- File extensions : ".mp3"/".wma"

#### **Compatible USB Devices**

- MP3 Player : Flash type MP3 player.
- USB Flash Drive : Devices that support USB1.1.
- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.

#### **USB Device Requirement**

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minutes to be searched.
- · To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/ 32) file system is supported.)
- This unit is not supported when the total number of files is 1 000 or more.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices, mobile phone are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.





1. Turn the battery compartment lid counterclockwise by using a coin. Then take the battery compartment lid out.



 Insert and fix the battery with the plus(+) facing in the same direction as the plus(+) on the battery compartment lid.



3. Put the battery compartment lid on the remote control and turn it clockwise to close.









## How to Affix the Ferrite Core

You must affix a core (supplied with the model you purchased) in order to reduce or eliminate electrical interference.


- 1. Pull the stopper [a] of the ferrite core to open.
- 2. Wind the power cord around the ferrite core once.
- 3. Close the ferrite core until it clicks.

## Setting the Clock

#### Note

If the power has been interrupted or the power plug has been disconnected, the clock setting is erased.

#### Setting the Clock Automatically

#### Note

- Make sure that your iPod/iPhone/iPad or your Android device has set the clock correctly.
- In standby mode, the clock will not synchronize with your iPod/iPhone/iPad or your Android device.
- In auto clock synchronization, "LG Bluetooth Remote" app has priority over the docking system.
- The 24 hour format can be set only for Android OS.

## Setting the Clock by Synchronizing with Your iPod/iPhone/iPad

Connect the iPod/iPhone/iPad firmly. Then the clock setting in the control panel will synchronize with your iPod/iPhone/iPad.

#### Note

The synchronized time may be slightly different from that of your iPod/iPhone/iPad.

#### Setting the Clock through "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" app on your iPod/ iPhone/iPad or your Android device. (see page 26-27)

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating Bluetooth connection through "LG Bluetooth Remote" app.

#### Setting the Clock Manually

If necessary, you can set the clock manually.

- 1. Press and hold **Clock** on the back panel for two seconds.
  - The clock digits begin to blink.
- 2. Press  $\ll$  /  $\gg$  to select the 12/24 hour format.
  - 12:00 (for a PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
- 3. Press >/II.
  - The hour digits begin to blink.
- 4. Press  $\ll$  /  $\gg$  to set the hour.
- 5. Press >/II.
  - The minutes digits begin to blink.
- 6. Press  $\ll$  /  $\gg$  to set the minute.
- 7. Press >/II.



## **Basic Operations**


#### iPod/iPhone/iPad Operation

You can enjoy the sound from your iPod/iPhone/ iPad through this unit. For details about iPod/ iPhone/iPad, refer to the iPod/iPhone/iPad User Guide.

- 🚺 Note -
- You are recommended to remove the case for your iPod/iPhone/iPad before you place your iPod/iPhone/iPad into the dock.
- Install the supplied stand for iPad to keep iPad stable before you place the iPad.



1. Connect the iPod/iPhone/iPad firmly. When this unit is connected to power, your iPod/iPhone/ iPad is automatically turned on and starts recharging even in standby mode.



2. Press - FUNCTION or - to select IPOD function.

Pause	During playback, Press >/II
Skip	During playback, press $\ll \gg$ to go to the next file or to return to the beginning of the current file.
	During playback, press $\ll$ twice briefly to step back to the previous file.

- An error message "ERROR" appears when :
- your iPod/iPhone/iPad is not connected firmly.
- this unit recognizes your iPod/iPhone/iPad as an unknown device.
- your iPod/iPhone/iPad is exceptionally low in power.
  - ➡ The battery needs to be charged.
  - → If you charge the battery while iPod/ iPhone/iPad is extremely low in power, it may take longer to be charged.
- You may not control your iPod/iPhone/iPad from this unit due to malfunction of iPod/ iPhone/iPad.
- Depending on your iPod/iPhone/iPad's software version, it may not be possible to control your iPod/iPhone/iPad from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.
- If you use an application, make a call, or send and receive SMS text message, etc. on iPod touch/iPhone/iPad, disconnect it from iPod/iPhone/iPad dock of this unit and then use it.
- If you have a problem with your iPod/ iPhone/iPad, please visit www.apple.com/ support.
- iPod touch, iPhone and iPad have any difference in operation other than iPod. You may need any additional control to use them with this unit. (e.g. "slide to unlock")

#### Using AirPlay

Apple AirPlay technology enables you to play your iTunes music library, hosted on a Mac, PC, iPhone, iPod touch, or iPad on any AirPlay-enabled device (for example, your ND8520) connected to the Wi-Fi network.

To stream audio wirelessly by AirPlay, you need :

- A Wi-Fi certified router
- A host for your iTunes music library, for example, an iPod touch/iPhone/iPad installed with iOS 4.3.3 (or later) or a Wi-Fi enabled PC/Mac installed with iTunes 10.2.2 (or later)

#### Compatible iPod/iPhone/iPad

The unit supports the models as follows ;

- iPod touch 3G, 4G
- iPhone 3GS
- iPhone 4 / iPhone 4S
- iPad / iPad 2

This unit should be connected to the same local network as your iTunes host device through the Wi-Fi router.

## Connect to your home Wi-Fi network for AirPlay

To connect this unit to your existing home Wi-Fi network, you need to apply your home Wi-Fi setting to this unit.

Once connected successfully, this unit will remember your home Wi-Fi settings. Then you can enjoy AirPlay whenever this unit is powered on and connected to your home Wi-Fi network automatically.

Before connection of this unit to your home Wi-Fi network, check the points below.

- 1. Make sure that your Wi-Fi router is powered on and working properly.
- 2. Make sure that this unit has been powered on and booted up successfully.

## Connecting to your home Wi-Fi router

To connect this unit to a Wi-Fi router, you need access to this unit's built-in configuration web page for change of its internal Wi-Fi settings. To do so, you need a Wi-Fi enabled device with an Internet browser for temporary Wi-Fi connection to this unit. The Wi-Fi enabled device can be an iPod touch/ iPhone/iPad or a Wi-Fi enabled PC/Mac.

## Follow the sequence below for connection of this unit to your home Wi-Fi router

- Collect settings of your home Wi-Fi router and write down on paper for use during this unit Wi-Fi setup (see "Collect settings of your home Wi-Fi router" on page 13).
- 2. Switch this unit to Assisted Wi-Fi Setup mode (see "Switch this unit to Assisted Wi-Fi Setup mode" on page 13).
  - A new Wi-Fi network created by this unit will appear, with the network name (SSID) of "LG AUDIO Setup XXXXXX".
- Connect your Wi-Fi enabled device to the created new Wi-Fi network temporarily (see "Connect your Wi-Fi enabled device to the newly created Wi-Fi network" on page 14).
- 4. Open the built-in web page of this unit with the Internet Browser of your Wi-Fi enabled device (see "Open the built-in web page of this unit" on page 16).
- Connect your unit (ND8520) to the available Wi-Fi network based on the settings you wrote on paper at step 1 (see "Connect your unit (ND8520) to the available Wi-Fi network" on page 17).
- Restore your Wi-Fi enabled device back to your existing home Wi-Fi settings (see "Restore your Wi-Fi enabled device back to your existing home Wi-Fi setting" on page 19).

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## Collect settings of your home Wi-Fi router

#### Note -

Always consult the user guide of your home Wi-Fi router for detailed instructions.

- 1. Connect your Wi-Fi enabled device to your existing home Wi-Fi network.
- 2. Launch the Internet browser (for example, Apple Safari or Microsoft Internet Explorer) on your Wi-Fi enabled device.
- 3. Open the configuration page of your home Wi-Fi router.
- 4. Find the Wi-Fi settings tab and write down the following information on paper :
  - Network name (SSID)
  - Wi-Fi security mode (usually WEP, WPA or WPA2 if enabled)
  - If the security mode of your home Wi-Fi router is "WEP", this unit supports only "OPEN".
  - Wi-Fi password (if Wi-Fi security is enabled)
  - DHCP mode (enabled or disabled)
  - Static IP address settings (if DHCP mode is disabled)

#### Switch this unit to Assisted Wi-Fi Setup mode

- Press → FUNCTION or → to select "AIR" function.
- Press and hold, and release 
   on the control panel of this unit until "STEP1" message appears.
  - Airplay icon blinks and "STEP1" message appears on the control panel of this unit.



- A new Wi-Fi network of this unit itself is created, with the network name (SSID) of "LG AUDIO Setup XXXXXX".
- It takes about 30 seconds and more for successful creation of this new Wi-Fi network.



#### Note

After you finish manual Wi-Fi setting for this unit, this new Wi-Fi network disappears.

## Connect your Wi-Fi enabled device to the newly created Wi-Fi network

The new Wi-Fi network created by this unit only allows access of one Wi-Fi enabled device. To avoid interference from any other Wi-Fi devices, you are recommended to temporarily disable the Wi-Fi function on your other Wi-Fi devices.

- 🚺 Note –
- "LG AUDIO Setup XXXXXX" is the temporary and assistant Wi-Fi network for connection of this unit to your home Wi-Fi router.
- While your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad or your Wi-Fi enabled PC/Mac is connecting to "LG AUDIO Setup XXXXX" network, you can not be able to use the Internet on them.

Option 1 : Use your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad

 Select "Settings" -> "Wi-Fi" on your iPod touch/ iPhone/iPad.



2. Select "LG AUDIO Setup XXXXXX" from the list of available networks.

- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- \*ROOT : The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".

#### Listening to Music from Your External Device

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of external device. (Portable cable is not supplied as an accessory with this unit.)




- 1. Connect the external device to the **PORT.IN** connector of the unit.
- 2. Turn the power on by pressing  $\bigcirc$ .
- 3. Select the PORT (PORTABLE) function by pressing ⊕ FUNCTION or ⊕.
- 4. Turn the external device on and start playing it.

## **Radio Operations**

#### **Antenna Connection**

Connect the FM wire antenna to FM antenna connector.



#### Listening to the Radio

- 1. Press  **FUNCTION** or **•** repeatedly until FM appears in the control panel. The last received station is tuned in.
- Auto tuning : Press ≪ / ≫ for about 2 seconds until the frequency indication starts changing, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Manual tuning : Press  $\ll$  /  $\gg$  repeatedly.

3. Adjust the volume by pressing -/+ (Volume).

#### Presetting the Radio Stations

You can store up to 10 FM preset stations.

Before tuning, make sure that you have turned down the volume.

- 1. Press **FUNCTION** or **T** repeatedly until FM appears in the control panel.
- 2. Select the desired frequency by using  $\ll / \gg$ .
- 3. Press **MEMORY**. A preset number will blink in the control panel.
- Press FOLDER/PRESET A/V to select the preset number you want.
- 5. Press **MEMORY**. The station is stored.
- 6. Repeat the steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.

Press FOLDER/PRESET  $\Lambda/V$  to select a preset station.

## Deleting All the Saved Stations

Press and hold **MEMORY** for two seconds. "CLR" will flash up. Press **MEMORY** again. Then all the saved stations are deleted.

#### - 🚺 Note

- If all stations have already been preset, "FULL" will appear in the control panel for a moment and then a preset number will blink.
- Although all stations were preset, you can preset a station by overwriting the previous station.
- You can not delete the preset stations one by one.

#### Improving Poor FM Reception

Press >/II. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

## Using a Bluetooth Wireless Technology

#### **Bluetooth Profiles**

In order to use Bluetooth wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

#### Listening to Music of a Bluetooth Device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is turned on in to your Bluetooth device. Refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

- Select the Bluetooth function by using the • FUNCTION or • . Appears "BT" and "BT READY" in the control panel.
- Operate the Bluetooth device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the Bluetooth device, a list of the devices found may appear in the Bluetooth device display depending on the type of Bluetooth device. Your unit appears as "LG AUDIO ND8520".
- 3. Enter the PIN code. PIN code : 0000
- 4. When this unit successfully is connected with your Bluetooth device, Bluetooth LED of this unit lights up and "PAIR" appears in the control panel.



Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some device have a different pairing way.

5. Listen to music.

To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide.

#### Note

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave.
- You cannot control the Bluetooth device with this unit.
- Pairing is limited one Bluetooth device per one unit and multi-pairing is not supported.
- Although the distance between your Bluetooth and the set is less than 10m, there are obstacles between both, your Bluetooth device cannot be connected.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- When not connected the Bluetooth, "BT" and "BT READY" appears on the control panel.
- The electrical malfunction due to devices using same frequency such as Medical equipment, Microwaves or wireless LAN devices, the connection will be disconnected.
- When someone stands and interrupts communication between Bluetooth device and the player, the connection will be disconnected.
- If the gotten away of the distance between Bluetooth and the unit, the sound quality is lower and lower. The connection will disconnect when the space between the Bluetooth and the unit gets out of the operating range of Bluetooth.
- The device with Bluetooth wireless technology is disconnected, if you turn off the main unit or put the device away from the main unit more than 10m.
- If the Bluetooth device is disconnected, you should connect the Bluetooth device to your unit.

- Tap "LG Bluetooth Remote" app icon on the home screen to open "LG Bluetooth Remote" app, and go to the main menu.
- 2. Tap [Setting] and select the unit you want.
- If you want to get more information to operate, tap [Setting] and [Help].

#### Note

- If you place your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad into the dock of this unit while your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad is connected to this unit by Bluetooth connection, the Bluetooth connection is deactivated.
- If this unit is BT mode and you connect your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad to this unit after connecting your iPod touch/iPhone/ iPad to this unit by Bluetooth connection, the function is automatically switched to IPOD mode. Then if you disconnect your iPod touch/iPhone/iPad from this unit, it is automatically connected to this unit by Bluetooth connection.
- The Bluetooth connection of iPod touch/ iPhone/iPad is not activated while iPod/ iPhone/iPad is placed into the dock of this unit.
- This unit does not support the multi-pairing. If this unit is already connected with other Bluetooth device, disconnect that device and then try again.

## **Other Operations**

#### Using Your Unit as an Alarm Clock

- 1. Make sure that you have set the clock correctly. (See "Setting the Clock" on page 10.)
- 2. Press and hold **Alarm On/Off** on the back panel.
- The alarm sound sources blink. (FM (Tuner)/ USB/IPOD). While each of sound sources blinks, select the one you want by pressing >/II. If you select FM (Tuner) mode, you can select the station you preset by pressing 
   > and then press >/II to save.
- "ON (Time)" setting is displayed. The hour setting blinks. Press ≪/≫ to select the hour and then press >/II to save.
- The minute setting blinks. Press ≪ / ≫ to select the minute and then press >/II to save.
- The volume setting blinks. Press ≪ / ≫ to change the volume and then press >/II to save.
  - Note
  - Alarm function only works when this unit is turned off.
  - You can check the setting status by pressing Alarm On/Off on the back panel two times.
  - If you want to reset the alarm, repeat steps 2-6.

#### Activate and Deactivate the Alarm Timer

Press **Alarm On/Off** repeatedly on the back panel to activate or deactivate the timer.

- If the timer is activated, " 🗣 " is displayed.
- If the timer is deactivated, " 🗣 " is not displayed.

#### Stop Alarm Ring

- When the alarm rings, press **Alarm On/Off** on the back panel or press **(**).
- The alarm stops but the alarm settings remain.

#### Note

- If you don't set clock on your iPod/iPhone/ iPad, the unit will not be synchronized for the clock with your iPod/iPhone/iPad.
- If you unplug the cord from an outlet, the alarm setting you set is not stored.
- After setting a clock function, you can set alarm function.
- If you do not press any button for 30 minutes after the alarm goes off, the alarm will shut off automatically.
- If the time you set is up, the unit will be turned on automatically.

#### Snoozing

The snoozing function wakes you up every 10 minutes if you tap anywhere on the control panel while the alarm activates.

"ZZZ" appears and "♣" blinks. To cancel the snoozing function, press Alarm On/Off or .

#### **Resume Playback**

The unit memorizes the point where you pressed >/II. Press >/II to resume playback.

#### Playing Repeatedly or Randomly (USB only)

Press C repeatedly. Then the current file will be played back repeatedly or randomly. (ONE/DIR/ALL/ RAND(RANDOM)/OFF)

#### Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** once. The control panel will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until the control panel get bright.

#### **Sleep Timer Setting**

While listening to music or radio, press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After delay time, the unit will turn off. (You can see the following order, 180 -> 150 -> 120 -> 90 -> 80 -> 70 -> 60 -> 50 -> 40 -> 30 -> 20 -> 10)

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until the control panel get bright.



- You can check the remaining time before the unit turns off by pressing **SLEEP**.
- Sleep function will work after dimmer function.

#### Setting the Sound Mode

This system has a number of pre-set sound fields. You can select a desired sound mode by using **SOUND EFFECT**.

The displayed items for the equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

On Display	Description
POP CLASSIC JAZZ ROCK	This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual rock pop, jazz or classic concert.
BYPASS	You can enjoy the sound without equalizer effect.



Maybe you need to reset the sound mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound file is changed.

#### Turning off the Sound Temporarily

Press Det to mute the sound. You can mute the sound in order, for example, to answer the telephone. And "MUTE" will appear in the control panel. To cancel mute function, press Det again or adjust volume level by pressing +/- (Volume).

#### Auto Power Down

This unit will be off itself to save electronic consumption in the case main unit is not connected to external device and is not used for 25 minutes.

So does this unit after six hours since Main unit has been connected to other device using analog input.
