






Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template


Wall mount bracket (2)



Remote control



Battery Installation

Remove the battery cover on the rear of the Remote Control, and insert battery with \bigoplus and \bigoplus matched correctly.

(り (Power): Switches the unit ON or OFF. DRC (ON/ OFF): Sets the DRC.

■: Mutes the sound.

VOL -/+: Adjusts speaker volume.


AV SYNC -/+: Synchronizes the audio and video.



- When the volume reaches the highest/ lowest level and you push VOL+/- on the remote control again, red LED on the unit turns on for 2 seconds to signal on what the volume level is.
- When the unit turns on, volume of the unit will rise gradually to the volume level set at the unit turned off.


TV Control buttons: See page 14. **AUTO POWER (ON/OFF):** This function automatically powers the unit ON/OFF.

Installing the sound bar

You can hear the sound by using optical cable connect the unit to the other device: TV, Blu-ray disc player, DVD player, etc.

Place the unit in front of the TV and connect it to the device. (Refer to page 11)



Installing the cover foot

You can extend the height of the unit.




- 1. Turn the unit upside down.
- 2. Peel off a sticker attached to the cover foot.


 Then place it on the existing foot of the unit.
- 3. Press the cover foot with adequate force to get it firmly fixed.

Mounting the main unit on a wall


You can mount the main unit on a wall. Prepare screws and brackets.



1. Match the TV's BOTTOM EDGE of Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template with the bottom of TV and attach to the position.




2. When you mount it on a wall (concrete), use the wall plugs (Not supplied). You should drill holes. A guide sheet (Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template) is supplied to drill. Use the sheet to check the point to drill.




Note -

Screws and Wall Plugs are not supplied for mounting the unit. We recommend the Hilti (HUD-1 6 x 30) for the mounting.

- 3. Remove the Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template.
- 4. Fix the brackets with screws (not supplied) as shown in the illustration below.




Hang the main unit onto the bracket as shown below.



Caution


- Do not hang onto the installed unit and avoid any impact to the unit.
- Secure the unit firmly to the wall so that it does not fall off. If the unit falls off, it may result in an injury or damage to the product.
- When the unit is installed on a wall, please make sure that a child does not pull any of connecting cables, as it may cause it to fall.
- Do not install this unit upside down. It can damage the parts of this unit or be the cause of personal injury.



Optional Equipment Connection

OPTICAL In connection

Connect an optical output of external devices to the OPTICAL IN connector.

Operations

DRC (Dynamic Range Control)

Makes the sound clear when the volume is turned down (Dolby Digital only). Set to DRC by pressing DRC ON

To cancel DRC, press DRC OFF.

AV Sync

When receiving audio signals from TV, sound and images may not match. In that case, this function can adjust the delay time.

Use **AV SYNC -/+** to scroll up and down through the delay amount, which you can set between 0 and 300 ms.



When the AV SYNC reaches the highest/lowest level and you push AV SYNC -/+ on remote control again, red LED on the unit turns on for 2 seconds to signal what the AV SYNC level is.

AUTO POWER DOWN

This unit turns off automatically to save power consumption if no signal is transmitted to the unit for about 25 minutes.

But the unit can turn on automatically based on the [AUTO POWER] function you've set.

AUTO POWER On/Off

This function automatically turns on the unit when you turn on the external device (TV, DVD player, Blu-ray player etc.) connected to the unit by optical cable. Turn on this function by pressing AUTO POWER ON.

To cancel it, press AUTO POWER OFF.



Note

If you don't connect external device to the unit by optical cable or there is no digital input, the unit is turned off after 1 minutes when you turn on this function.

It is not available to turn on the unit by AUTO POWER function if you turn off it directly.

Turn off the sound temporarily

Press of to mute your unit.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone.

To cancel it, press MUTE **\display** again on the remote control or change the volume level.



Note

Red LED on the unit blinks at intervals of 2 seconds to signal that the unit is in mute mode.

LG Sound Sync



You can control some functions of this unit by your TV's remote control with LG Sound Sync. It is compatible with the LGTV that is supported LG Sound Sync. Make sure of the LG Sound Sync logo on your TV.

Controllable function by LG TV's remote control: Volume up/down, mute.

Refer to the TV's instruction manual for the details of LG Sound Sync.

Make one of the following connections, depending on the capabilities of your equipment.



Note

You can also use the remote control of this unit while using LG Sound Sync. If you use TV's remote control again, the unit synchronizes with the TV.

When the connections failed, make sure of the condition of the TV and power of it.



With wired connection

1. Connect your LGTV to the unit by using an optical digital cable.




- 2. Set up LG Sound Sync (Optical) on the TV. Refer to the TV's instruction manual.
- 3. Turn on the unit.
- 4. Select OPTICAL function. When you finish the connection, show a

message on your TV.

Controlling a TV with the Supplied Remote Control

You can control your TV using the buttons below. (LGTV only.)



Button	Operation
MUTE	Turn the TV's volume on or off
INPUT	Switch the TV's input source between the TV and other input sources.
(TV POWER)	Turn the TV on or off.
VOL +/-	Adjust the volume of the TV.
PR/CH ▲/▼	Scan up or down through memorized channels.



- Depending on the TV being connected, you may not be able to control your TV using some of the buttons.
- The remote control of the unit performs basic operation of your TV. Please use the TV's remote control to enjoy advanced operation of your TV.

Troubleshooting

control does	There is an obstacle in the path of the remote control and the unit.
not work properly.	Remove the obstacle.
	The battery in the remote control is exhausted.
	Replace the batteries with new one.
The AUTO POWER function does not work.	Depending on the connected device by the optical cable, this function may not operate.
When you sense that outputted sound of the unit is low.	Check the details below and adjust the unit according to them.
	Switch [ON] state of DRC function to [OFF] by using remote controller.
	With the sound bar connected with TV, change the AUDIO DIGITAL OUT setting on TV Setup Menu from [PCM] to [AUTO] or [BITSTREAM].
	• With the sound bar connected with Player, change the AUDIO DIGITAL OUT setting on Player Setup Menu from [PCM] to [PRIMARY PASS-THROUGH] or [BITSTREAM].
	Change Audio DRC setting on Player setup menu to [OFF] state.

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Maintenance

Handling the Unit

When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

- Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit.
- Wiping with strong pressure may damage the surface.
- Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time.

Cleaning the unit

To clean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the unit.
