## Battery Installation

You have two ways to open the battery compartment.

1. Turn the battery compartment counterclockwise by using a coin or your finger.
Then take a battery compartment out.
(!) Caution
If you have long nails, do not open the battery compartment by using your finger. Or else, your nail would be broken.

2. Insert and fix the battery with the minus(-) facing in the same direction as the minus(-).

3. Put the battery compartment on the remote control and turn it clockwise to close.


## Caution

The battery used in this device may present a fire or chemical burn hazard if mistreated. ## iPod/iPhone/iPad Operation

You can enjoy the sound with your iPod/iPhone/ iPad. For details about iPod/iPhone/iPad, refer to the iPod/iPhone/iPad User Guide.

1. Connect iPod/iPhone/iPad to the USB port by using the iPod/iPhone/iPad's cable.


If you turn this unit on, your iPod/iPhone/ iPad will be automatically turned on and start recharging.
2. Press $\mathbf{F U N C T I O N}$ on the remote control or $\mathbf{F}$ on the unit to select USB function. You can operate your iPod/iPhone/iPad through an iPod/iPhone/ iPad's display by using the remote control and controlling your iPod/iPhone/iPad.

You are recommended to remove the case for your Android device(Ver 4.1 or later) before you connect your Android device to USB port using a cable.

1. Connect Android device to the USB port by using the Android device's cable.

2. Press FUNCTION on the remote control or $\mathbf{F}$ on the unit to select USB function.
3. If your unit is connected firmly, 'ANDROID' will appear in the display window.

## ! Note

- If the USB connection has an error, check these problems as follows;
- Your Android device is not connected firmly.
- This unit recognizes your Android device as an unknown device.
- Your Android device is not booted.
- The charging time may vary depending on your Android device.
- Some Android devices may not be charged.
- You may not control your Android device from this unit due to malfunction of Android device.
- Depending on your Android device's software version, it may not be possible to control your Android device from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.
- If you use an application, make a call, or send and receive SMS text message, etc. on Android device, disconnect it from this unit and then use it.
- Although your device's $\mathrm{O} / \mathrm{S}$ is ver 4.1 or even the latest version, you can not charge it. Because your device is not supported by AOA 2.0.
- Disconnect your device from USB port in case of malfunction, although the device's $\mathrm{O} / \mathrm{S}$ is ver 4.1 (or later).
- While the unit recognizes your android device, you may see "USB CONNECT" in your device.
- If you connect your Android device to USB port while your Android device is extremely low in the volume, the audio may not output from this unit. In this case, you should adjust the volume of your Android device.


## USB Operation

Connect the USB port of USB Memory (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB port on the unit.

(!) Note
Removing the USB Device from the unit

1. Choose a different function/mode or press $\square$ ENTER on the remote control or $\square$ on the unit twice in a row.
2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

## CD Operation

1. Insert a disc in the disc slot with the label side upward.
2. Select the CD function by pressing FUNCTION on the remote control or $\mathbf{F}$ on the unit.
3. Select a track/file you want to play by pressing l<</>>| on the remote control.


## !. Note

- Music CDs or CD-R/CD-RW in music CD format can be only played.( 12 cm disc)
- The DTS is not supported. In case of DTS audio format, audio is not output.

## Listening to music from your portable device

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable device. (Portable cable is not supplied as an accessory with this unit.)

1. Connect the portable device to the PORT. IN connector of the unit.
2. Turn the power on by pressing $\downarrow / \mathbf{l}$.
3. Select the PORTABLE function by pressing FUNCTION on the remote control.
4. Turn the portable device on and start playing it.

## Listening to music with your headphones

Connect a pair of stereo headphones $(\phi 3.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ phone plug) to PHONES jack on the unit for private listening.(Headphones are not supplied as an accessory with this unit.)


## (! Note

You can't hear any sound from speakers, while the headphones plug is inserted in the PHONES jack.

## Other Operation

## Programmed Playback

The program function enables you to store your favourite tracks/files from any disc or USB device.
A program can contain 20 tracks/files.

1. Insert a CD or connect USB and wait for it to be loaded.
2. Press PROGRAM/MEMORY on the remote control in stop state.
3. Press $\mathbf{| \ll / \gg}$ | on the remote control to select a next track/file.
4. Press PROGRAM/MEMORY again to save and select a next track/file.
5. Press $\boldsymbol{>}$ II to play the programmed music tracks/files.
6. To clear your selection, press $\square$ ENTER twice.

## ! Note

The programs are also cleared when the disc or USB device is removed, the unit is powered off or the function is switched to others.

## Selecting a folder and an MP3/WMA/FLAC file.

1. PRESET/FOLDER $\wedge / \vee$ on the remote control repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
2. Press $\boldsymbol{>}$ II to play it. The first file of folder will play.

## Resume playback

During playback, if you change to another function, then return to the USB/CD function, and then press, you can listen to music from last point you played.

## ! Note

- USB/CD Folders/Files are recognized as below

- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear
- Folders will be presented as the following order;
ROOT $\rightarrow$ FOLDER $1 \rightarrow$ FOLDER3 $\rightarrow$ FOLDER7 $\rightarrow$ FOLDER8 $\rightarrow$ FOLDER5 $\rightarrow$ FOLDER6
- File will be played from $\boldsymbol{\delta}$ file No. 1 to $\boldsymbol{\delta}$ file No. 14 one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- *ROOT : The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB/CD is "ROOT".


## Deleting an MP3/WMA/FLAC file

You can delete file, folder or format by pressing DELETE on the remote control. This function is supported only in stop state. (USB only)

1. -Select the file you want to delete by using $\mathbf{l} \ll / \gg$ | And press DELETE.
-Select the folder you want to delete by

## DELETE.

-Press and hold DELETE to format the USB device.

## Or

Press DELETE repeatedly while searching a file.
The display window will be changed in the following order.

- DEL FILE : Deletes file
- DEL DIR? : Deletes folder
- FORMAT? : Formats USB

2. To delete file/folder or format, press $>$ II .
3. If you want to exit the current mode, press $\square$ ENTER.

## (1) Caution

- Do not extract the USB device during operation. (play, delete, etc.)
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB state. (lock, etc.)


## Displaying file information

While playing an MP3/FLAC file containing file information, you can display the information by pressing INFO on the remote control.

## Turn off the sound temporarily

Press MUTE on the remote control to mute your sound.
You can mute the sound in order, for example, to answer the telephone. And "MUTE" will appear in the display window. To cancel mute function, press
MUTE again or adjust volume level by pressing VOL+/-

## Sleep Timer Setting

Press SLEEP on the remote control repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After delay time, the unit will turn off. (You can see the following order, $180->150->120->90->80->$ 70 -> 60 -> 50 -> 40 -> 30 -> 20 -> 10) To cancel the sleep function, press SLEEP repeatedly until the display window get bright.

## ! Note

- Press SLEEP. The remaining time appears in the display window.
- Sleep function will work after dimmer function.


## Dimmer

Press SLEEP once. The display window will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press SLEEP repeatedly until the display window get bright.

## Auto Power Down

This unit will be off itself to save electronic consumption in the case main unit is not connected to external device and is not used for 25 minutes. So does this unit after 6 hours since Main unit has been connected to other device using analog input.

## Sound adjustment

## Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set sound fields. You can select a desired sound mode by using
SOUND EFFECT on the remote control.
The displayed items for the Equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

## (! Note

Maybe you need to reset the sound mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound track/file is changed.

## Radio Operation

## Antenna Connection

Connect the FM Wire antenna to FM ANT. connector.


## ! Note

Be sure to fully extend the FM wire antenna.

## Listening to the radio

1. Press FUNCTION on the remote control until FM appears in the display window. The last received station is tuned in.
2. Auto tuning : Press and hold TUNING-/+ for about 2 seconds until the frequency indication starts changing, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

## Improving poor FM reception

Press $\boldsymbol{>}$ II on the remote control. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono. Then the reception will be better than before.

## Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM. Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

1. Press FUNCTION until FM appears in the display window.
2. Select the desired frequency by pressing TUNING-/+.
3. Press PROGRAM/MEMORY. A preset number will blink in the display window.
4. Press PRESET/FOLDER $\wedge / \vee$ to select the preset number you want.
5. Press PROGRAM/MEMORY. The station is stored.
6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
7. To listen a preset station, press PRESET/FOLDER $\wedge / \mathrm{V}$.

## Deleting all the saved stations

1. Press and hold PROGRAM/MEMORY for two seconds. "ERASEALL" will blink on the display window.
2. Press PROGRAM/MEMORY to erase all saved radio stations.

## Seeing information about a Radio station

The FM tuner is supplied with the RDS (Radio Data System) facility. This shows information about the radio station being listened to. Press RDS/SET repeatedly to cycle through the various data types. :

You can search the radio stations by programme type by pressing RDS/SET. The display will show the last PTY in use. Press PTY one or more times to select your preferred programme type. Press and hold TUNING-/+. The tuner will search automatically. When a station is found, the search will stop.

## Setting the Clock

You have three ways to set the clock.

## Setting the clock by pressing the buttons

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press and hold CLOCK
3. Choose time mode by pressing $\mathbf{I} \ll / \gg$ I.

- 12:00 (for an AM and PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)

4. Press $\square$ ENTER or RDS/SET to confirm your selection.
5. Select the hours by pressing $\mathbf{l} \ll / \gg \mid$.
6. Press $\square E N T E R$ or RDS/SET.

## Setting the clock by connecting the BT.App

Set time you desired on Bluetooth device and connect the Bluetooth device to your unit via BT app. Then the clock setting in the display window will be synchronized with the Bluetooth device automatically.

## Setting the clock by synchronizing your iPod/ iPhone/iPad

Connect iPod/iPhone/iPad to the USB port using the iPod/iPhone/iPad's cable and select USB function. Then the clock setting in the display window will be synchronized with your iPod/ iPhone/iPad.

After the unit synchronized with your iPod/iPhone/ iPad for clock setting, there will be a time difference between the iPod/iPhone/iPad and the unit. In power off state, the clock won't be synchronized with your iPod/iPhone/iPad.

## ! Note

Check the current time on iPod/iPhone/ iPad is correct or not. If not, reset it correctly depending on present time. Wrong time on the iPod/iPhone/iPad may result in the time defference between your iPod/iPhone/iPad and the unit.

## Using your player as an alarm clock

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press and hold TIMER to set the alarm function.
3. Alarm sound sources will blink. While each of sound sources blink, select the one you want by pressing $\square E N T E R$ or RDS/SET.
4. "ON TIME" will blink. This is your desired time to turns unit on. Press $\mid \ll / \gg$ | to change the hours and minutes and press $\square$ ENTER or RDS/ SET to save.
5. The "OFF TIME" will blink. This is your desired time to turn unit off. Press $\mid \ll />\boldsymbol{|}$ to change the hours and minutes and press $\square$ ENTER or RDS/SET to save.
6. The volume setting will blink. Press $\mid \ll / \gg$ | to change the volume and press $\square$ ENTER or RDS/SET to save.
7. Press TIMER to check the alarm information.
8. If you want to reset the clock, press and hold TIMER.Then repeat step 3-6.

## ! Note

- If you unplug the cord from an outlet, the clock setting you set won't be stored.
- If you synchronize the unit with your BT device for clock by using BT app, you can set 12 - Hour Time (ex - PM $11: 00$ ) or 24 Hour Time (ex-23:00).(Android O/S only)
- If you set the clock, you can check the time by pressing CLOCK although the player is turned off.
- If you set the clock and alarm, you can check setting informaiton by pressing TIMER although the unit is turned off. Then this function will work in everyday.
- Alarm function only works when the unit is turned off.
- When the alarm rings, you can deactivate the alarm by pressing TIMER.
- If the alarm rings with USB cable connected to USB port, the function switches to tuner function. (Depending on the type of device, this may not be available.)

## Notes on Discs

Handling Discs
Never stick paper or tape on the disc.

## Storing Discs

After playing, store the disc in its case. Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat and never leave it in a parked car exposed to direct sunlight.

## Cleaning Discs

Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, thinner, commercially available cleaners, or anti-static spray intended for older vinyl records.

## Handling the Unit

## When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

## Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit.
Wiping with strong pressure may damage the surface.

Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time.

## Cleaning the unit

To clean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the unit.

## Maintaining the Unit
