! Note

- Once the sound bar is shut down to standby, please wait several seconds before trying to use remote again.
- When you press any button on the remote control, the red LED on the main unit blinks twice. (Except (Power) button)
- The color LED that indicates the current function is lit up for about 3 seconds when you press the function buttons: , **OPTICAL**.
- If the volume level reached a minimum or a maximum, the red LED on the unit is lit up when you adjust the volume level of the sound bar.
- If the woofer level reached a minimum or a maximum, the red LED on the unit is lit up when you adjust the woofer level of the wireless subwoofer.

(Power) : Switches the unit ON or OFF.

VOL +/- : Adjusts speaker volume.

***** : The button is not available for any function.

(Mute) : Mutes the sound.

: Select Bluetooth function.

OPTICAL : Select Optical function.

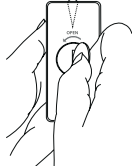

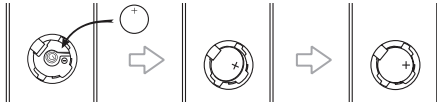
Battery Installation

1. Turn the battery cover counterclockwise by using a coin. Then take the battery cover.

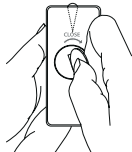


Coin

2. Insert and fix the battery with the minus (-) facing in the same direction as the minus (-) on the battery compartment.



3. Put the battery cover on the remote control and turn it clockwise to close.

If you have long nails, do not open the battery cover by using your finger. Or else, your nail would be broken.

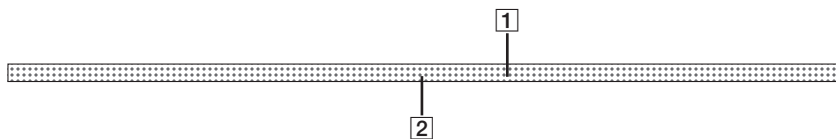

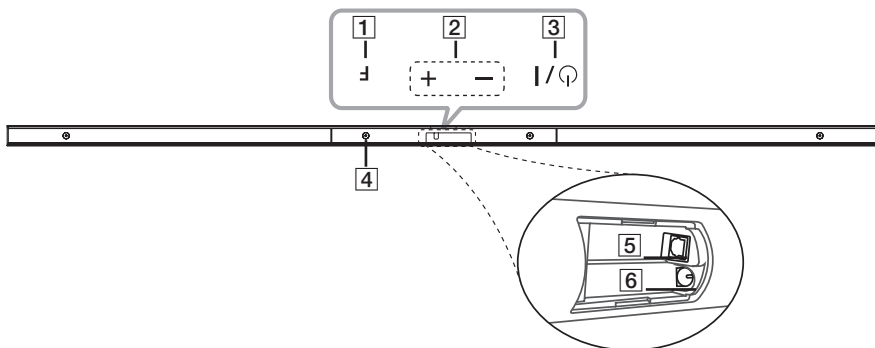

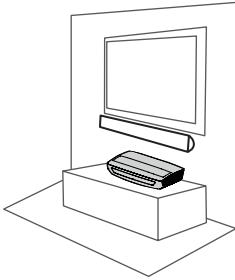

Precautions in using the touch buttons

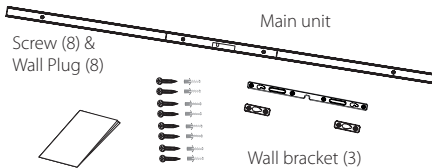
- Use the touch buttons with clean and dry hands.
- In a humid environment, wipe out any moisture on the touch buttons before using.
- Do not press the touch buttons hard to make it work.
- If you apply too much strength, it can damage the sensor of the touch buttons.
- Touch the button that you want to work in order to operate the function correctly.
- Be careful not to have any conductive material such as metallic object on the touch buttons. It can cause malfunctions.

You can mount the main unit on a wall. Prepare screws and brackets.

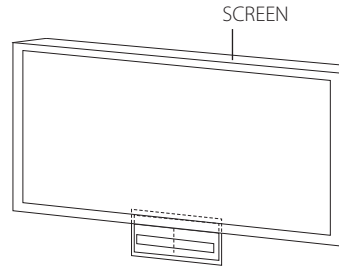

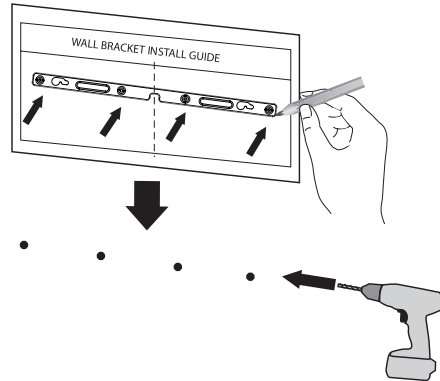

1. Fitted with Bracket Center Guide according to Screen Center and Bottom Line.



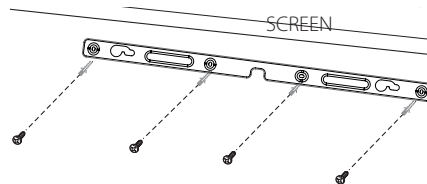
2. When you mount it on a wall (concrete), use the wall plugs. You should drill some holes. A guide sheet (WALL BRACKET INSTALL GUIDE) is supplied to drill. Use the sheet to check the point to drill.



Note

Make sure that the triangle mark on the wall bracket should be facing upwards.

3. Remove the Wall bracket install guide.
4. Fix it with screws (not supplied) as shown in the illustration below.

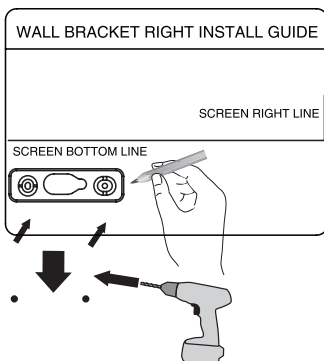
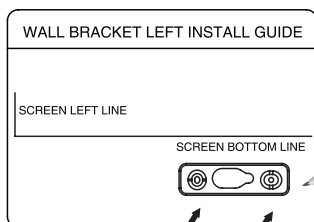

The order of installation wall mount bracket center screw



1. After inserting the [3] screw adjust the left and right center.
2. After ensuring the flatness insert [2] screw.
3. [1], [4] screw fixation after inserting [2], [3] screw.

5. Prefixed with bracket left / right guide according to screen side and bottom line.
6. Remove the wall bracket install guide.
7. Fix it with screws as shown in the illustration below.

The order of installation wall mount bracket side screw

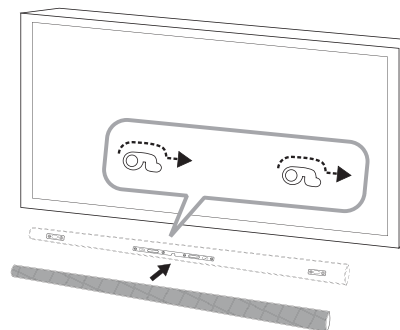


1. Tightening the [2] screw.
2. Then, aligning the flatness tighten the [1] screw.
3. Confirmed the position of the screws after [1], [2] screw loose while checking flatness.

Caution

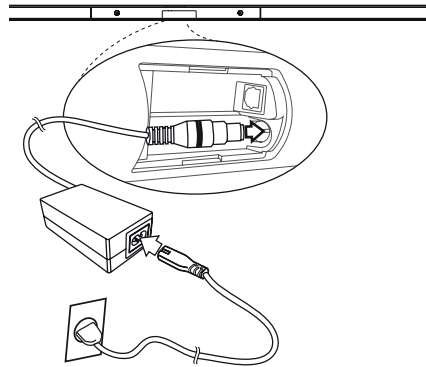

Connecting the AC adapter

Prior to installing the wall mount, first connect the cable.

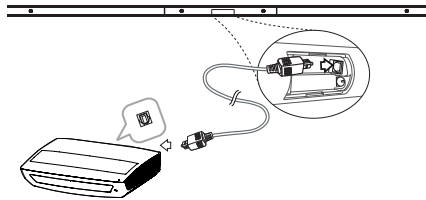
1. Connect the supplied AC power cord to the AC adapter.
2. Connect the AC adapter cable to DC. IN adapter input.
3. Plug the AC power cord into an AC outlet.

**Caution**

Only use the AC adapter supplied with this device. Do not use a power supply from another device or manufacturer. Using any other power cable or power supply may cause damage to the device and void your warranty.

OPTICAL In connection

Connect the OPT. IN jack on the back of the unit to OPTICAL OUT jack on the Cinema beam TV using an OPTICAL cable.



Pairing wireless subwoofer

Setting up the wireless subwoofer for the first time

1. Connect the power cord of the wireless subwoofer to the outlet. The Yellow-green LED on the subwoofer starts to blink.
2. Turn on the main unit. The red LED on it starts to blink and then the main unit and the subwoofer will be automatically connected.

When connection is completed, the Yellow-green LED on the subwoofer is turned on and the green LED on the main unit is lit up for about 3 seconds.

Manually pairing wireless subwoofer

When the connection has been failed between the main unit and the wireless subwoofer, the red LED on the subwoofer is turned on. To pair them, follow the steps below.

1. Press **PAIRING** on the back of the subwoofer. The Yellow-green LED on the wireless subwoofer starts to blink.
2. Press and hold **—** (Volume) on the unit and **M** (Mute) on the remote control at the same time. The green LED on the main unit starts to blink.
3. After the Yellow-green LED on the subwoofer is turned on, press the buttons on step 2 again. The connection will be completed.

! Note

- If you operate main unit then wireless subwoofer sound within a few seconds in standby mode.
- Set the distance between this unit and wireless subwoofer within 10 m.
- Optimum performance can be implemented only when the unit and the Wireless subwoofer within distance of 2 m to 10 m is used since communication failure may occur if longer distance is used.
- It takes a few seconds (and may take longer) for the unit and subwoofer to communicate with each other.

Basic operations

LG Sound Sync



You can control some functions of this unit by your TV's remote control with LG Sound Sync. It is compatible with the LG TV that is supported LG Sound Sync. Make sure of the LG Sound Sync logo on your TV.

Controllable function by LG TV's remote control : Volume up/down, mute.

Refer to the TV's instruction manual for the details of LG Sound Sync.

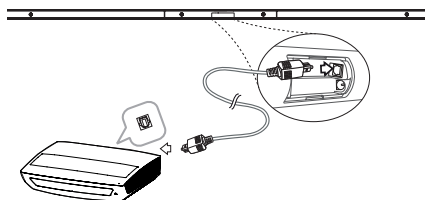
Make one of the following connections, depending on the capabilities of your equipment.

! Note

- You can also use the remote control of this unit while using LG Sound Sync. If you use TV's remote control again, the unit synchronizes with the TV.
- When the connections failed, make sure of the condition of the TV and power of it.
- Make sure of the condition of this unit and the connection in the cases below when using LG Sound Sync.
 - Turned off the unit.
 - Changing the function to the others.
 - Disconnecting the optical digital audio cable.
- The amount of time to turn off this unit is different depending on your TV when you set AUTO POWER function to ON.

With wired connection

1. Connect your LG TV to the unit by using an optical digital cable. (Refer to the page 13.)



2. Set up LG Sound Sync (Optical) on the TV. Refer to the TV's instruction manual.
3. Turn on the unit by pressing (Power) on the remote control.
4. Select OPTICAL function by using **OPTICAL** on the remote control.

Green LED on the unit is lit up for about 3 seconds and you can listen to the TV's sound.

AUTO POWER On/Off

This function automatically turns on/off the unit when you turn on/off the TV or the external device (DVD Player, Blu-ray Disc Player, etc.) connected to this unit.

It is supported only on OPTICAL functions.

Turn on or off AUTO POWER function by using **AUTO POWER ON/OFF** on the remote control.

! Note

- After the unit is turned on by AUTO POWER function, it will be automatically turned off if there is no signal for a certain period of time from the TV connected by LG Sound Sync (Optical).
- After the unit is turned on by AUTO POWER function, it will be automatically turned off if there is no signal for a certain period of time from the external device connected by an optical cable.
- Depending on the connected device, this function may not operate.
- It is not available to turn on the unit by AUTO POWER function if you turn off the unit directly.
- On bluetooth function, this unit may be turned on by AUTO POWER function depending on the connected bluetooth device. But in this case, this unit will be turned off automatically.

Using Bluetooth technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when there is interference by the other electronic waves which run on same frequency or if you connect bluetooth devices in the other rooms nearby.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth®** wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth®** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth®** wireless technology.

Available Devices : Mobile phone, MP3, Laptop, PDA etc.

Bluetooth profiles


In order to use **Bluetooth®** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Pairing this unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is turned on in your Bluetooth device. Refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Select the Bluetooth function by using  on the remote control. Then the orange LED on the unit starts to blink.
2. Operate the Bluetooth device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the Bluetooth device, a list of the devices found may appear in the Bluetooth device display depending on the type of Bluetooth device. Your unit appears as "LG SOUND BAR (XX:XX)".

Note

XX:XX means the last four digits of BT address. For example, if your unit has a BT address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG SOUND BAR (F7:08)" on your Bluetooth device.

3. Enter the PIN code.
PIN code : 0000

Note

Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some device have a different pairing way.

4. The orange LED is lit up for about 3 seconds when this unit successfully paired with your Bluetooth device.
5. Listen to music.
To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide.


Note


- When using Bluetooth® technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the bluetooth device as close as possible and keep the distance. However it may not work well in the case below :
 - There is a obstacle between the unit and the bluetooth device.
 - There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth®** technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- You should connect your Bluetooth device to this unit again when you restart it.
- When you select Bluetooth function again after changing to other functions, Bluetooth connection may be disconnected. You should reconnect the bluetooth device to use this function.
- The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave.
- You cannot control the Bluetooth device with this unit.
- Pairing is limited one Bluetooth device per one unit and multi-pairing is not supported.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc..
- The more distant between the unit and the bluetooth device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the bluetooth device gets far from the unit.
- When Bluetooth connection is disconnected, connect the bluetooth device to the unit again.
- When not connected the Bluetooth, orange LED is blinking.

Other operations

Turn off the sound temporarily

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone.

Press  on the remote control. Red LED blinks and there is no sound on the unit.

To cancel it, press  again on the remote control or change the volume level.

Adjust the woofer level settings

You can adjust the sound level of the wireless subwoofer. Press **WOOFER LEVEL +/-** on the remote control.

Note

If the woofer level reached a minimum or a maximum, the red LED on the sound bar is lit up when you adjust the woofer level of the wireless subwoofer.

3D Sound effect

3D Sound features deliver sound creating a wider spot so you can enjoy more immersive and cinematic surround sound.

Turn on or off 3D Sound effect by using **3D SOUND ON/OFF** on the remote control.

DRC (Dynamic range control)


Make the sound clear when you feel the volume is too low.

Turn on or off DRC by using **DRC ON/OFF** on the remote control.

Auto power down

This unit will turn itself off to save electric consumption in the case were main unit is not connected to external device and is not used for 25 minutes.

No Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The power cord is unplugged. Plug in the power cord. Check the condition by operating other electronic devices.
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Incorrect input source is selected. Check the input source and select the correct input source. The mute function is activated. Press  or adjust the volume level to cancel the mute function.
No woofer sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The power cord of woofer is not connected. Plug the power cord into the wall outlet securely. Pairing between the unit and woofer gets disconnected. Connect the unit and woofer. (Refer to the page 14.)
The remote control does not work properly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The remote control is too far from the unit. Operate the remote control within about (7 m). 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Maintenance

Handling the unit

When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

- Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit.
- Wiping with strong pressure may damage the surface.
- Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time.

Cleaning the unit

To clean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the unit.
