

Music file requirement

MP3/WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows.

- Sampling frequency: within 32 to 48 kHz (MP3), within 32 to 48 kHz (WMA)
- Bit rate: within 32 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Maximum files: Data CD: 999 / USB: 2000
- Maximum folders: Data CD: 99 / USB: 200
- File extensions: ".mp3"/".wma"
- Certain MP3/WMA files may not be played depending on the type or format of the file.
- CD-ROM file format: ISO 9660/ JOLIET
- We recommend that you use Easy-CD Creator, which creates an ISO 9660 file system.

The DTS is not supported. In case of DTS audio format, audio is not output.

You have to set the disc format option to [Mastered] in order to make the discs compatible with the LG players when formatting rewritable discs. When setting the option to Live File System, you cannot use it on LG players.


Compatible USB Devices

USB device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 2000 files.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.

Remove the battery cover on the rear of the Remote Control, and insert two (size AAA) batteries with lacktriangle and lacktriangle matched correctly.

(Power): Switches the unit ON or OFF.

▲ (Open/Close): Opens and closes the disc tray.

PRESET-FOLDER Λ/V :

- Searches for a folder of MP3/WMA files. When a CD/USB containing MP3/WMA files in several folders is being played, press PRESET-FOLDER \(\Lambda/\mathbf{V}\) to select the folder you want to play.
- Chooses a preset number for a radio station.

FUNCTION: Selects the function and input source.

MUTE Mutes the sound.

VOL +/-: Adjusts speaker volume.

TUNER MEMORY:

- Stores radio stations.






How to Affix the Ferrite Core

Ferrite core may not be provided depending on each nation's regulations.

Affix the Ferrite Core for speaker cables


You must affix a ferrite core in order to reduce or eliminate electrical interference.

- 1. Pull the stopper [a] of the ferrite core to open.
- Wind R SPEAKERS cables, L SPEAKERS cables and SPEAKER LIGHITNG cables around the ferrite core once.
- 3. Close the ferrite core until it clicks.




Connecting to speakers

Connect the speaker cable plugs to the SPEAKERS connector. Make sure to connect the speaker's plug to the corresponding colored speaker connector when connecting the plug.



Attaching the speaker light cables to the unit

To connect the speaker light cable to the unit, insert the cable to **SPEAKER LIGHTING** connectors on the unit





Caution

- Make sure that the jacks and the speakers are matched correctly.
- Make sure to connect the cables to connectors tightly on the unit.

Caution

- Do not try to lift the speaker alone. It needs two persons to lift the speaker. Otherwise it may result in the speaker malfunction and cause personal injury and/or property
- When you connect the speakers to the unit, make sure to connect the speaker's cable and plug to the corresponding speaker connector.
- The speakers must be placed a minimum. of 20 cm from the unit for preventing the vibration caused by the speakers.




- Check the volume level before playing music to prevent infirm, child, and pregnant women from being shocked by the sudden and loud sound from the unit.
- Do not use the unit in a limited space. It may damage a person's hearing. It is recommended to use it in a wide space.
- Be careful to make sure children not to put their hands or any objects into the opening speaker duct hole.
- The speakers contain magnet parts, so color irregularity may occur on the TV screen or PC monitor screen. Please use the speakers far away from either TV screen or PC monitor.
- Avoid looking at the speaker lights for a long time. It may cause damage to eyesight.

Optional Equipment Connection

AUX IN Connection

Connect an output of auxiliary device (Camcorder, TV, Player, etc) to the **AUX IN 1/2** (L/R) connector. If your device has only one output for audio

(mono), connect it to the left audio jack on the unit.




DVD, Blu-ray player etc.

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AUX OUT Connection

Connect an input of auxiliary device to the **AUX OUT** (L/R) connector.

If your device has only one input for audio(mono), connect it to the left audio jack on the unit.



X-BOOM PLUS

You can connect two units to play music together.

- Connect AUX OUT connector on a unit to the AUX IN connector on the other unit using Audio cable.
- Press and hold H/P MODE (X-BOOM PLUS) on the unit connected through AUX OUT. X-BOOM PLUS is displayed.
- Rotate H/P VOL./SYNC SET clockwise or counterclockwise to adjust Delay setting.
- 4. Press **H/P MODE** (X-BOOM PLUS) to save the Delay setting.




- This function is available in only CD, USB 1, USB 2, BLUTOOTH or PORTABLE Function.
- The initial Delay is 0 ms and the Delay becomes to 30 ms when you press and hold H/P MODE (X-BOOM PLUS). The connected device's Delay may differ. If Audio Sync is not matched, adjust Delay of X-BOOM PLUS to synchronize sound.
- It is available to adjust the Delay from 0 ms to 100 ms. Synchronizing tempo is not available depending on devices.
- Delay value is saved when the unit turns off.

PORT. IN Connection

Connect an output (earphone or line out) of portable device (MP3 or PMP etc) to the

PORT. IN connector.



Listening to music from your portable player or external device

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable player or external device.

1. Connect the portable player to the PORT. IN connector on the unit.

Connect the external device to the AUX IN connector on the unit.

- 2. Turn the power on by pressing $\bigcirc/$.
- 3. Press **FUNCTION** to select the AUX 1, AUX 2 or PORTABLE Function.



Antenna Connection

Connect the supplied FM antenna for listening to the radio.

• Be sure to fully extend the FM wire antenna.

Basic Operations

CD/USB Operations

- When you play JUKE BOX list, only REPEAT TRK and REPEAT ALL are available.
- Even after restarting the unit or switching one function to another, you can listen to music from the point where it's last been played.
- The next file name is displayed every 30 seconds. (Except RANDOM play, AUTO DJ RANDOM play, the last file of playlist, etc.)
- If you leave the disc tray open for 5 minutes, it will close automatically.

Auto Play

- AUDIO/MP3/WMA CD is played automatically after Disc tray is open and then closed.
- Automatically switches to the CD function if Disc tray is open and then closed when there is no disc in Disc tray.
- When CD or USB is inserted
 - If you press > || on the side A of the unit, the function is changed to CD or USB 1 and playback starts.
 - If you press >|| on the side B of the unit, the function is changed to USB 2 and playback starts (except MIXER ON mode).



- When CD or USB is inserted
 - Function is changed to CD or USB 1 if Y/U (Except Tuner Function), I on the side A of the unit is pressed.
 - Function is changed to USB 2 if Y/U (Except Tuner Function), I on the side B of the unit is pressed (Except MIXER ON mode).
 - In Tuner Function, function is not changed even you press Y/U.

Selecting a folder and an MP3/WMA file

On the unit

- Press FOLDER and rotate SCRATCH/SEARCH until a desired folder appears.
- Press ENTER and rotate SCRATCH/SEARCH until a desired file appears. Press ➤II to play it.


On the remote control

- Press PRESET·FOLDER ∧/V on the remote control repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
- 2. Press ►/II to play it. The first file of folder will play.

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Note

 CD / USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear.
- Folders will be presented as the following order;

ROOT \rightarrow FOLDER 1 \rightarrow FOLDER 3 \rightarrow FOLDER 7 \rightarrow FOLDER 6

- File will be played from ♪ file No.1 to ♪ file No.14 one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- *ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".

Deleting an MP3/WMA file

You can delete file, folder or format by pressing **DELETE**. This function is supported only in stop status. (USB only)

- 1. -Select the file you want to delete and press DELETE
 - -Select the folder you want to delete by pressing FOLDER and rotating SCRATCH/ **SEARCH** on the unit and press **DELETE**. Or select the folder you want to delete by pressing **PRESET**·FOLDER Λ/V on the remote control and press **DELETE**.
 - -Press and hold **DELETE** to format the USB device

Or

Press **DELETE** repeatedly during selecting the MP3/WMA file.

The display changes in the following order.

- DEL FILE? : Deletes file
- DEL FOLDER? : Deletes folder
- FORMAT? · Formats USB
- 2. To delete file/folder or format, press ►/II on the remote control or press > 11 on the unit. If you want to exit the current mode, press
 - ENTER on the remote control or press □ on the unit.



Caution

- · Do not extract the USB device during operation. (play, delete, etc.)
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB status. (lock, etc.)

Playback Effect

The unit supports various sound and playback effects: DJ EFFECT, SCRATCH, DJ PRO, AUTO DJ, TEMPO, MIX, AUTO SYNC.

DJ EFFECT

It allows you to enjoy DJ EFFECT such as Flanger/ Phaser/Chorus/Delay sound effect.

- 1. Press a desired DJ EFFECT (FLANGER, PHASER, CHORUS, DELAY) on the unit. To cancel it, press the DJ EFFECT (FLANGER, PHASER, CHORUS, DELAY) again.
- 2. Turn EFFECT LEVEL clockwise or counterclockwise to adjust the DJ EFFECT level between 0 to 15.



- The DJ EFFECT mode is displayed for 3 seconds when a DJ EFFECT Key is inputted.
- The gage starts at the beginning with an initial 7 level.
- The current gage level is displayed when adjusting gage.
- If the function changed or the unit is turned off and on, DJ EFFECT mode with DJ EFFECT is turned off
- If DJ EFFECT is turned off, you should turn it on again to enjoy the effect.
- You can adjust Tempo for either USB while in USB function, when DJ EFFECT mode is on.

SCRATCH Effect

You can output and mix the sound effects of the SCRATCH.

Rotating **SCRATCH/SEARCH** to mix the scratch sound.

- You can hear effect of scratch sound depending on the direction in which you rotate SCRATCH/ SEARCH.

DJ PRO

It allows you to mix CLUB or FOOTBALL sound effect. Each mode has up to 6 sounds effect.

- Press DJ PRO repeatedly to select a desired DJ PRO sound effect.
- 2. Press a DJ Pro. Pad of desired sound.

Display Window	Description
DJ PRO CLUB	You can hear CLUB sound effects when you press DJ Pro. Pad.
DJ PRO FOOTBALL	You can hear FOOTBALL sound effects when you press DJ Pro. Pad.



Note

- · Initial DJ Pro mode is CLUB sound effect.
- DJ Pro mode is displayed for 3 seconds when you press **DJ PRO**.
- The DJ PRO sound is mixed when you press a **DJ Pro. Pad**.
- The currently playing DJ PRO sound is stopped and the selected DJ PRO sound outputs if you press a different DJ Pro. Pad while DJ PRO sound is playing.
- Display does not show Input DJ Pro. Pad.

AUTO DJ

Auto DJ blends the end of one song into the beginning of another for seamless playback. It equalizes volume across tracks/files for uninterrupted playback.

Press **AUTO DJ** on the remote control repeatedly, the display changes as followings. RANDOM (AUTO DJ RANDOM) -> REPEAT ALL (AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL) -> (AUTO DJ OFF)

Mode	Display Window	Description
OFF	- (AUTO DJ OFF)	-
RANDOM	RANDOM (AUTO DJ RANDOM)	The music is played randomly on this mode.
REPEAT	REPEAT ALL (AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL)	The music is played repeatedly on this mode.



Note

- AUTO DJ mode does not support searching for a section within a track/file or to play repeatedly or randomly.
- If you move to other functions or stop the music using ☐ on the unit (or ☐ ENTER on the remote control) on AUTO DJ mode, AUTO DJ will be disable.
- AUTO DJ is not supported in the music file whose length is less than 60 seconds.
- During recording, AUTO DJ is not available.
- Only AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL is selected when played JUKE BOX list.

Adjusting TEMPO

You can adjust the Tempo for USB function 1 or 2 from 50 (MIN) to 150 (MAX).

Rotate **A TEMPO** to adjust the tempo for USB 1. Rotate **B TEMPO** to adjust the tempo for USB 2.



- The tempo is set as 100 if you turn the unit off, change the function or fully stop.
- The tempo is kept when you pause and resume play.

MIX

You can mix audio sounds

- 1. Press MIX. 'MIXER ON' is displayed. Select a desired Function for side A and play it. Mix is available in all functions except USB 2.
- 2. During playback, insert a USB device in USB port (B) and play it. Side B is fixed as USB2 function.
- 3. Move the Mix fader to adjust the sound volume of mixed sound. Move it to the left to lower the volume of side **B** and move it to the right to lower the volume of side A.



Note -

- · In MIXER ON mode,
 - You can adjust the Tempo for USB function 1 or 2.
 - If you press **I**≪/≫**I**, □ or >**II** on the unit, it works only for each side.
 - If you press ► / II or **ENTER** on the remote control, it works for both sides A and B
 - For operating, it is recommended to use $|\langle\langle\rangle\rangle$, \square or >|| on the unit instead of remote control's.
 - Numerical buttons do not work.
 - You can use H/P MODE. (Refer to page
- If you turn off the unit in the middle of mixing process, MIX mode turns to OFF.

AUTO SYNC

When using Mixing, you can synchronize the tempo of audio files being played in USB 1 and USB 2 by pressing AUTO SYNC.

To stop it, press AUTO SYNC twice.



Note -

- The tempo of music being played in USB1 is synchronized to that in USB2.
- A TEMPO doesn't work when AUTO SYNC is
- If USB2 fully stops or function is changed, AUTO SYNC function is cancelled.
- In case of below, AUTO SYNC error may occur depending on the sound source.
 - The silent section in the beginning of the track
 - Intro or bridge section in which few musical instruments appear.
 - In cases where playback speed or tempo of the song changes.
 - In case that the data for BPM is provided in real time, not the beginning of the
- If the song is being played too fast or slow, press and hold AUTO SYNC, 'AUTO SYNC/ RE-ANALYZING' is displayed.
- AUTO SYNC is available only when USB 1 is selected for side A and USB 2 is selected for side B in MIXER ON mode and both are being played.

Using BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth® is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the bluetooth in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth**® wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth**® wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth**® wireless technology. Available Devices: Mobile phone, MP3, Laptop, PDA

Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use *Bluetooth*° wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the **Bluetooth** feature is activated on your **Bluetooth** device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

- Select the Bluetooth function by using FUNCTION until BLUETOOTH function is selected or pressing @ Bluetooth on the unit. "BLUETOOTH READY" appears on the display window.
- Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the **Bluetooth** device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of **Bluetooth** device. Your unit appears as "LG CM9950(XX)".



- XX means the last two digits of Bluetooth address. For example, if your unit has a Bluetooth address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG CM9950(08)" on your Bluetooth device.
- Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some devices may have a different pairing process. Enter the PIN code (0000) as needed.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3
 Bluetooth devices simultaneously using the
 same method as described above, only in
 the Bluetooth function.
- The multi pairing connection is only supported on Android or iOS devices. (Multi pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable Bluetooth devices (Ex: Dongle etc.) will not support multi pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with vour **Bluetooth** device. "BLUETOOTH PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to Bluetooth device name soon.



Note

- "BLUETOOTH PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi pairing.
- If the device name is unavailable, " "will be displayed.
- 4. Listen to music. To play a music stored on your **Bluetooth** device, refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user auide.



- When using **Bluetooth**® technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the bluetooth device as close as possible and keep the distance. However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:
 - There is a obstacle between the unit and the bluetooth device.
 - There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth**® technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- You should connect your bluetooth device to this unit again when you restart it.
- Even if this unit connected up to 3 Bluetooth devices in the Bluetooth mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.



- When this unit connected with multiple Bluetooth devices, only one device which you are playing keeps Bluetooth connection when you change the function to the others.
- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices
- You may not control the Bluetooth device with this unit.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the bluetooth device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected. when the unit is turned off or the Bluetooth device gets far from the unit.
- When Bluetooth connection is disconnected, connect the bluetooth device to the unit again.
- When a Bluetooth device is not connected. "BLUETOOTH READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use the BLUETOOTH function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the Bluetooth device.
- If it is not in the BLUETOOTH function, only one device can be connected.
- If a Bluetooth device is connected when using LGTV, LGTV is disconnected and the Bluetooth device is connected.
- When you connect Bluetooth device (iOS device etc.) to this unit or operate the device, the volume level can be synchronized with each other.

- NFC Recognition area may be different depending on the type of Bluetooth device. Please check the position of NFC recognition area of the Bluetooth device before tagging.
- If the screen of the Bluetooth device is locked, the device may not recognize the NFC Tag.
- In some cases, the device may not recognize the NFC.
 - When the case of the Bluetooth devices is chrome-plated material.
 - According to the material and thickness of the case on the Bluetooth device.
- According to the performance of the NFC of the Bluetooth devices.
- Android O/S: Ver 4.1.2 (or later)
- You must activate the NFC feature of your NFC-enabled phone.

Radio Operations

Be sure that FM antenna is connected. (Refer to page 17)

Listening to the radio

1. Press **FUNCTION** until FM appears in the display

The last received station is tuned in.

2. Auto tuning:

Press and hold TUNING-/+ on the remote control or **I≪/≫I** on the unit for about two seconds until the frequency indication starts to change, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Or

Manual tuning:

Press TUNING-/+ on the remote control or $|\langle\langle\rangle\rangle$ on the unit repeatedly.

3. Adjust the volume by rotating volume knob on the unit or by pressing **VOL +/-** on the remote control repeatedly.

Improving poor FM reception

Press ►/II on the remote control. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM.

Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

- 1. Press **FUNCTION** until FM appears in the display
- 2. Select the desired frequency by pressing TUNING -/+ on the remote control or $|\langle\langle\rangle\rangle$ on the unit.
- 3 Press TUNER MEMORY on the remote control A preset number will blink in the display
- 4 Press **PRESET-FOLDER** Λ/V on the remote control to select the preset number you want.

Deleting all the saved stations

- 1. Press and hold TUNER MEMORY on the remote control for two seconds
 - "ERASE ALL?" will flash up on the unit display.
- 2. Press **TUNER MEMORY** on the remote control to erase all the saved radio stations.

Seeing information about a Radio station

The FM tuner is supplied with the RDS (Radio Data System) facility. This shows information about the radio station being listened to. Press **RDS/SET** on the remote control repeatedly to cycle through the various data types:

PS (Programme Service Name)

The name of the channel will appear in the display.

PTY (Programme Type Recognition)

The programme type (e.g. Jazz or News) will appear in the display.

RT (Radio Text)

A text message contains special information from the broadcast station.

This text may scroll across the display.

CT (Time controlled by the channel)

This shows the time as broadcast by the station.

You can search the radio stations by programme type by pressing **RDS/SET** on the remote control. The display will show the last PTY in use. Press **PTY** one or more times to select your preferred programme type. Press and hold **I I I I** The tuner will search automatically. When a station is found the search will stop.

Sound adjustment

Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set surround sound fields. You can select a sound mode you want by using **SOUND EFFECT** on the remote control.

The displayed items for the Equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

AUTO EQ	Realizes the sound equalizer that is the most similar to the genre of which is included in the MP3 ID3 tag of song files.
POP CLASSIC JAZZ ROCK	This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual rock, pop, jazz or classic concert.
BASS BLAST	Reinforces the treble, bass and surround sound effect.
FOOTBALL	You can enjoy the sound effect FOOTBALL STADIUM.
FLAT	Provides balanced sound.
BOOST	Boosts the mid-range for sound reinforcement.
TREBLE/BASS	Reinforces the treble and bass.
STANDARD	You can enjoy optimized sound.



Note

- On some speakers, sound may not be heard or heard in low sound depending on the sound mode.
- Maybe you need to reset the sound mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound track/file changed.
- By pressing **BASS BLAST** on the unit you can directly select STANDARD or BASS BLAST effect

Setting the USER EQ

You can adjust the sound level of Treble, Middle and Bass as your preference.

- 1. Press **USER EQ** on the unit. "USER EQ" is displayed.
- 2. Rotate MASTER EQ (BASS, MIDDLE, TREBLE) to adjust the sound level.
- 3. Press **USER EQ** to save the setting.

Advanced Operations

Recording to USB

You can record a various sound source to USB 1. (CD, AUX, PORTABLE, Tuner, USB)

- Connect a USB device to USB port (A) on the unit.
- Press FUNCTION to select a Function you want to record.
 - One track/file recording You can record to USB after playing a track/file you want.
 - All tracks/files recording You can record to USB in full stop status.
 - JUKE BOX list recording After showing the JUKE BOX list, you can record it to USB. (Refer to page 33)
- Start the recording by pressing USB REC on the remote control or USB REC on the unit.
 To stop recording, press and hold USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control

Recording in MIXER ON mode

Recording is available in MIXER ON mode. If you record in MIXER ON mode, the unit records the mixed sound from that point when you press **USB REC**.

- 1. Start mixing. Refer to page 22.
- Start the recording by pressing USB REC on the remote control or USB REC on the unit.
 To stop recording, press and hold USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control to stop recording. Otherwise, the recording continues.

Pausing recording

To select recording bit rate and speed

- 1. Press and hold USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control for 3 seconds.
- Press I◀/▶■ on the remote control or
 I≪/≫I on the side A of the unit to select a bit rate.
- 3. Press R USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control again to set.
- Press I◀✓/►►I on the remote control or
 I≪/>►I on the side A of the unit to select a desired recording speed. (AUDIO CD only)

X1 SPEED

- You can listen to music while recording it.

X2 SPEED

- You can just record the music file.
- 5. Press R USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control to finish the setting.

USB Copying

You can copy audio files in USB 2 to USB 1.

- Connect a USB device including desired audio files to USB port (B) and select USB 2 Function.
- 2. Connect another USB device to USB port (A).
- 3. Press R USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control.

To stop recording, press and hold R USB REC on the unit or USB REC on the remote control.

- You can only change volume level between MIN and 30 during recording. (Only CD function)
- · Do not remove the USB device or turn off the unit during USB recording. If dose not, an incomplete file may be made and not deleted on PC.
- · If USB recording does not work, the message like "NO USB","ERROR","USB FULL" or "NO REC" is displayed on the display window.
- Multi card reader device or External HDD can not be used for USB recording.
- A file is recorded by about 512Mbyte when you record for a long term.
- You may not store more than 2000 files.
- You can not record in AUTO DI mode
- In case of the unsupported MP3/WMA file, the file recording may be stopped.

Normal mode

- On CD function, sound of MIC, DJ Pro, Scratch, DJ Effect is recorded only during AUDIO CD X1 speed REC. It is recorded AUDIO CD source too.
- When you stop recording during playback, the file that has been recorded at that time will be stored.(Except MP3/WMA file)

MIXER ON mode

 When Function is set to BLUFTOOTH or LG TV, recording is available in MIXER ON mode.

DJ SHARING

DJ SHARING allows you to share a song stored in a USB device using Music Flow Bluetooth App.

- 1. Connect a USB device to USB port (A).
- 2. Activate the Bluetooth feature of your Bluetooth device. Make sure that "Music Flow Bluetooth" App on your Bluetooth device is connected with the unit.
- 3. Press DJ SHARING.
- 4. Press | <</>> on the side A of the unit to select a song to share.
- 5 Press DJ SHARING to share



Note -

- To cancel the DJ SHARING, press and hold DJ SHARING for 3 seconds.
- During transmission by the App,
 - Some functions may not work.
 - Key operation of the unit or remote control does not work. (Except turning the power off, canceling transmission, adjusting the volume.)
- Press and hold DJ SHARING to share the most recently recorded mix file. If there is no mix file, the first audio file in USB 1 Function will be shared
- If the unit turns off during sharing, the file transfer fails.
- The transfer speed and performance of Bluetooth function may differ due to the number or type of the connected **Bluetooth** device or useage environment.
- If you share the file when multiple devices are connected to the unit in **Bluetooth** mode, the file is transfered to the last operated App.
- You can transfer a file up to 512 Mbyte.
- Before starting DJ SHARING, you can play the file to check.
- The file made by DJ Sharing is saved in 'Bluetooth' folder
- The file may not be transferred or the unit may not work normally in below case during DJ sharing.
 - The unit is turned off.
 - The USB device is removed.
 - Bluetooth is disconnected

JUKE BOX Playback

JUKE BOX function enables you to make a playlist of vour favorite tracks/files from a disc or USB device (USB 1). A playlist of up to 100 tracks/files can be entered.

Making JUKE BOX list

It is supported only on stop status.

- 1. Press and hold RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO on the unit to enter the edit mode.
- Select a track/file by pressing ► I on the remote control or by turning SCRATCH/ **SEARCH** on the side **A** of the unit.
- Press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO to save the track/file.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 3 to store other tracks/files. (You can modify the list by pressing **PRESET**. **FOLDER** Λ/V on the remote control to select the JUKE BOX program number.)
- Press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO once again. To play the JUKE BOX list, press ▶/ **II** after you make the list.



Note

 When making or modifying the JUKE BOX list, REPEAT mode is off.

Enjoying JUKE BOX

Press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO twice on stop status, "JUKE BOX ON" appears on the display window. To play JUKE BOX list, press ►/ II on the remote control or > 11 on the unit.

To cancel it, press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO twice. "JUKE BOX OFF" appears on the display window.

Editing JUKE BOX

It is supported only on stop status.

- 1. Press and hold RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO on the unit to enter the edit mode.
- 2. Press **PRESET·FOLDER** Λ/V on the remote control to select a track/file to edit.
- 3 Press | to save the track/file
- Press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO.
- 5. Repeat 2 to 3 to store the other tracks/files.
- 6. Press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO once again.

To play the JUKE BOX list, press ►/ II after you edit the list.

Deleting JUKE BOX list

Deleting function only works in the edit mode.

- 1. Press and hold **JUKE BOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.
- 2. Select a song by pressing **PRESET·FOLDER** Λ / **V** on the remote control repeatedly.
- 3. Press **DELETE** while a song is selected.



- To check the status of JUKE BOX, press **JUKE** BOX once. You can also check it by the word "PROG." on the display window.
- If there is no JUKE BOX list, "JUKE BOX NONE" appears on the display window when you press JUKE BOX.
- JUKE BOX is switched off in the case below.
 - Changing to a different function.
 - Turning off and on the unit.
 - Operating the numerical buttons on the remote control.
 - Playing a file by using **FOLDER** and SCRATCH/SEARCH.
- JUKE BOX list is cleared in the case below.
 - Removing the disc or the USB device.
- Deleting or recording music files in the USB device.

Other Operations

Turn off the sound temporarily

Press **MUTE** on the remote control to mute your unit.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the mute icon "X" is blinked in the display window.

To cancel it, press **MUTE** again or change the volume level.

CHILDSAFE Mode

This function helps to prevent you from being surprised when you turn on the unit in case that the volume of the unit is set at a high level.

To turn on CHILDSAFE mode, press and hold ENTER on the unit when the volume of the unit is "MIN".

In CHILDSAFE mode, the volume increase gradually. To turn off CHILDSAFE mode, press and hold ENTER on the unit when the volume of the unit is "MIN" and this mode is turned on.



Note

In case of CD. USB or BLUETOOTH function. CHILDSAFE mode does not work after about 2 minutes from power on the unit even if this mode is enabled

Displaying file information (ID3 TAG)

While playing an MP3 file containing file information, you can display the information by pressing **INFO**.

DEMO

In the power off state, press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO on the unit once. The unit will power on and display the each of functions with demo sound in the display window. To cancel the DEMO function, press RDS / JUKE BOX / DEMO once more.



Note

- While in DEMO, this unit will keep DEMO status even if you unplug the power cord connection.
- You can enjoy other functions during the DEMO, the DEMO will temporarily pause.
 - Without input key in 10 sec, the DEMO will play back automatically.

Using Microphone

- 1. Connect your microphone to the MIC jack.
- 2. Play the music you want.
- Sing along with the accompaniment. Adjust the microphone volume by rotating MIC VOL. clockwise or counterclockwise on the unit.



Note

- When not using the microphone, set the MIC VOL. to minimum or turn off the MIC and remove the microphone from the MIC jack.
- If the microphone is set too near the speaker, a howling sound may be produced.
 In this case, move the microphone away from the speaker or decrease the sound level by using the MIC VOL..
- If sound through the microphone is extremely loud, it may be distorted. In this case, rotate MIC VOL, to minimum.

Using H/P MODE

Headphone monitoring is available.

Press **H/P MODE** to listen to music using Headphone. Rotate **H/P VOL. / SYNC SET** to adjust the volume.

When mixing, press **H/P MODE** to select a monitoring mode. You can listen to the music being mixed or playing in Source A or Source B.



Note

• It is not compatible with a 4 pole jack.





- If you select one source output in MIXER ON mode, the playback effects (Except TEMPO) are not applied to the output through the headphone.
- If you power off or switch to MIXER OFF, the selected H/P MODE is cancelled.

LIGHTING (X-FLASH) MODE

The function is to create a Club like atmosphere by operating speaker lighting.

1. Press LIGHTING MODE on the unit.

The mode changes each time you press it : OFF \rightarrow VOLCANO \rightarrow POLICE \rightarrow THUNDER \rightarrow PSYCHE \rightarrow CAOS \rightarrow OFF



- Lighting function is available in all functions.
- Lighting mode retains its previous mode when you first press LIGHTING MODE, press again to change modes.

Setting the Clock

- 1. Turn the unit on.
- Press and hold CLOCK.
- 3. Select time mode by pressing ► on the remote control.
 - AM 12:00 (for an AM and PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
- 4. Press **RDS/SET** to confirm your selection.
- 5. Select the hours by pressing ► on the remote control.
- Press RDS/SET.
- 7. Select the minutes by pressing ► on the remote control.
- 8 Press RDS/SET

Setting the Clock through "Music Flow Bluetooth" App

Install "Music Flow Bluetooth" app on your Android device. (Refer to page 26)

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating Bluetooth connection through "Music Flow Bluetooth" app.

Using your player as an alarm clock

- 1. Turn the unit on.
- Press and hold ALARM.
- 3. Press ► on the remote control to change the hours and minutes and press RDS/SET to save.
- 4. Press ► on the remote control to select function and press RDS/SET to save.
 - Press | I on the remote control to select a memory No. when you select Tuner and then, press RDS/SET. If there is no memory No., this step is skipped.
- 5. Press ► on the remote control to change the volume and press RDS/SET to save.



- If you set the clock time, you can check the time by pressing **CLOCK** even when the player is turned off.
- You can set alarm after you set the clock
- If you set the clock time and alarm, you can check the alarm icon "()" by pressing **CLOCK** even when the unit is turned off.
- If you set the clock time and alarm, you can check the alarm icon "O" and setting information by pressing **ALARM** even when the unit is turned off.
- You can select ALARM ON/OFF mode by pressing ALARM.

Sleep Timer Setting

Press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After the delay time, the unit will be turned off.

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until "SLEEP 10" appears, and then press **SLEEP** once again while "SLEEP 10" is displayed.



Note -

- You can check the remaining time before the unit is turned off.
- Press **SLEEP**. The remaining time appears in the display window.

Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** once. The display window will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until dim off.



Note -

• All the LED turns off when Dimmer is being operated.

Auto power down

This unit will turn itself off to save electricity in the case were the main unit is not connected to an external device and is not used for 20 minutes

The unit will also turn itself off after six hours if the Main unit has been connected to another device using the analog inputs.

How to disconnect the wireless network connection or the wireless device.

Turn off the unit by pressing the power button for more than 5 seconds.

AUTO POWER On

This unit automatically turns on by an input source: LG TV or Bluetooth

If you try to connect your Bluetooth device, this unit turns on and connects your Bluetooth device. You can play your music.



Note

- Depending on the connected device, this function may not operate.
- Depending on the connected device, the unit turns on but Bluetooth function may not be connected.
- If you disconnect Bluetooth connection by this unit, some Bluetooth devices try to connect to the unit continually. Therefore it is recommended to disconnect the connection before turning off the unit.

Auto function change

This unit recognizes input signals such as Bluetooth and LGTV and then changes suitable function automatically.

When you try to connect Bluetooth

When you try to connect your Bluetooth device to this unit, Bluetooth function is selected. Play your music on the Bluetooth device.

When LG TV is connected

When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync, this unit changes the function to LG TV. You can hear the sound from your TV.



Note .

- This function is not available during recording or deleting.

LG Sound Sync



You can control some functions of this unit by your TV's remote control with LG Sound Sync. It is compatible with LG TV that supports LG Sound Sync. Make sure your TV has the LG Sound Sync logo.

Controllable function by LGTV's remote control: Volume up/down, mute

Refer to the TV's instruction manual for the details of LG Sound Sync.

Notes on Discs

Handling Discs

Never stick paper or tape on the disc.

Storing Discs

After playing, store the disc in its case. Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat and never leave it in a parked car exposed to direct sunlight.

Cleaning Discs

Fingerprints and dust on the disc can cause poor picture quality and sound distortion. Before playing, clean the disc with a clean cloth. Wipe the disc from the center to out.

Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol. benzine, thinner, commercially available cleaners, or anti-static spray intended for old vinyl records.

Handling the Unit

When shipping the unit

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean
