Precautions on handling a battery

- This unit has a built-in valve regulated lead-acid rechargeable battery. (12 V/7.0 Ah)
- Do not use the battery in a closed room or near fire.
- Charge the battery under the charging condition specified.
- If any corrosion of the terminals, leakage or deformation of the case of the battery is found, do not use the battery.
- If the battery leaks, while protecting your hands or clothing, remove the battery from the device and should be extremely careful not to infect the skin or eyes.
- If the battery leaks and the liquid inside spills on the skin or clothing, immediately wash it off with plenty of clean water.
 If the liquid splashes into eyes, immediately flush the eyes with plenty of clean water and consult a doctor.
- Avoid mixed usage of batteries differing in type, manufacturer or history of use.
- Do not throw the battery in fire nor heat the battery.
- · Do not short of battery terminals.
- Do not attempt to disassemble, remodel or destroy the battery.
- · Do not place the battery near a child.

BLUETOOTH

Listens to music stored on your **Bluetooth** device.

Carrying the unit

The unit has wheels and a handle so you can easily move the unit.

Playable file Requirement

Music file requirement

MP3/WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows

- Sampling frequency: within 32 to 48 kHz (MP3), within 32 to 48 kHz (WMA)
- Bit rate: within 32 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Maximum files: 999
- Maximum folders: 99
- File extensions : "mp3" / ".wma"
- Certain MP3/WMA files may not be played depending on the type or format of the file.


Compatible USB Devices

- MP3 Player: Flash type MP3 player.
- USB Flash Drive: Devices that support USB2.0 or USB1.1.
- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.

USB device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 999 files.
- External HDD, SSD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC.
 The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- · Some USB may not work with this unit.

1 MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG

- Adjusts speaker volume.
- Selects vocal effects.
- 2 ((Standby)

Turns the power on or off.

MIC (Microphone) VOL. (Volume)
Adjusts microphone volume with MASTER
VOLUME / MULTI JOG.

VOCAL EFFECTS

Selects various vocal effects mode.

MIC ECHO / VOICE CANCELLER

- Selects ECHO mode.
- You can reduce the vocal tones during music playback from various input sources by pressing and holding.

KEY CHANGER

Changes the key to suit your vocal range with **MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG**.

LIGHTING

Selects the lighting mode.



Rear Panel



- 1 Power ON/OFF switch Switches the unit ON or OFF. (Battery can be charged even when this unit is in off (OFF) status.)
- 2 AC in socket



Fully charge the device before using.

Carrying the unit

The unit has wheels and a handle so you can easily move the unit.

1. Press the lock button on the handle.



2. Pull the handle up.



3. Release the lock button to lock the handle in place.



Note -

To retract the handle, press the button and push down.



Caution -

- Do not shake the handle to hard. Otherwise it may result in the unit will be damaged.
- Do not hang heavy things on the handle.
 Otherwise it may result in the unit will be damaged.
- Do not draw the unit on the unpaved road or the stair.
- Be careful it does not drop the unit when you carry it.
- Carry the unit, after then disconnect the connected cables.
- Do not step or sit on the unit. Otherwise this unit may fall down and causing personal injury.
- Do not place the unit on an unstable position and place the unit at a safe distance from the child's reach.
- Be careful that the unit should not fall down.
 Otherwise it may result in malfunction and causing personal injury and/ or property damage.
- Fix the handle when you use the unit.

Charging Battery

This unit has a built-in battery.

- By connecting AC power, battery will start charging.
- If Battery charging indicator is in red, this means that battery is charging now.
- If the battery charging indicator is in green, this means that battery charging is completed.
 For efficient performance of battery, it is recommended fully charging the device until the green LED goes off.
- Charge battery for about 9 hours before you start using this unit for the first time.




- Operating time is approx. 15 hours. (Based on fully charging the battery and continuous playback using 50 % volume level.) It may vary depending on the battery status and operational conditions.
- If you are listening to the music while charging, it will take longer to charge.
- Charge the battery fully during the recommended time after discharge.

Useful functions for using the unit



AC Power Cord Connection

- 1. Connect one end of the AC power cord (included) to the AC IN socket.
- 2 Plug the other end into the wall outlet.



3. Turn ON/OFF Switch on (ON).



Note –

- When you turn ON/OFF Switch on (ON), this unit turns on even if this unit has been turned off. If the battery level is very low, this unit does not turn on even if you turn ON/OFF switch on (ON).
- When the battery level is low, this unit displays LOW BATTERY frequently. And if the battery level becomes even lower, this unit turns off automatically.
- Previous setting may not be saved when you turn ON/OFF switch off (OFF).
- Previous setting may not be saved when the unit's power is shut off due to low battery.
- Unplug the AC power cord from the wall outlet if you do not to use for an extended period of time.

Optional Equipment Connection

AUX IN Connection

Connect an output (earphone or line out) of portable device (MP3 or PMP etc) to the AUX IN (3.5 mm) connector.



Listening to music from your portable player

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable player.


- 1. Connect the portable player to the AUX IN connector of the unit.
- 2. Turn the power on by pressing (1).
- 3. Press F to select AUX function.
- 4. Turn on the portable player and start it playing.



Automatically switches to the AUX function when you connect the portable device to the AUX IN connector.

USB Connection

Connect a USB device (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB ports on the unit.





Note -

Removing the USB device from the unit:

- 1. Choose a different function/mode.
- 2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

Basic Operations

USB Operations

- 1. Connect the USB device to the USB port.
- 2. Select USB function by pressing F.




Note

· Repeat/Shuffle playback operates as follows.

| On Display | Description |
|------------|--|
| OFF | Plays songs in order and stops the playback. |
| ONE | Plays a same song repeatedly. |
| ALL | Plays all the songs repeatedly. |
| SHUFFLE | Plays all the songs once randomly, and stops the playback. |

- Even after restarting the unit or switching one function to another, you can listen to music from the point where it's last been played.
- USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- File will be played from $\ \ \ \ \$ file No.1 to $\ \ \ \ \ \ \$ file No.14 one by one.
- Files will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.

*ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".

Using BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the **Bluetooth** in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth** wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth** wireless technology.

Available Devices: Smart phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.

Version : 4.0Codec : SBC

Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use **Bluetooth** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile. A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the **Bluetooth** feature is activated on your **Bluetooth** device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Turn on the unit.



Note

When **Bluetooth** connection lock is activated, you can search **Bluetooth** device in BT function.

 Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the **Bluetooth** device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of **Bluetooth** device. Your unit appears as "LG - RL2(XX)".



- XX means the last two digits of Bluetooth address. For example, if your unit has a Bluetooth address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG - RL2(08)" on your Bluetooth device.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device type, some devices have a different pairing way. For details about **Bluetooth** pairing, refer to your **Bluetooth** device manual.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3
 Bluetooth devices simultaneously using the same method as described above, only in the Bluetooth function.
- The multi phone pairing connection is only supported on Android devices. (Multi phone pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable Bluetooth devices (Ex: Dongle etc.) will not support multi phone pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with your **Bluetooth** device, "PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to **Bluetooth** device name soon. Then "BT" will appear on the display window.



Note

- "PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi phone pairing.
- If the device name is unavailable. " " will be displayed.
- 4 Listen to music To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide.



Note

• When using **Bluetooth** technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device as close as possible and keep the distance.

However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:

- There is a obstacle between the unit and the Bluetooth device.
- There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth** technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- If Bluetooth connection does not work well. try pairing it again.
- Even if this unit is connected to up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices in the **Bluetooth** mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.



- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the **Bluetooth** device gets too far from the unit.
- When **Bluetooth** connection is disconnected. connect the **Bluetooth** device to the unit again.
- When a Bluetooth device is not connected. "READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use the BT(Bluetooth) function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the Bluetooth device.
- When entering the Bluetooth function, this unit automatically connects to the last connected **Bluetooth** device or the device which played back last. (Auto connection may not be supported
 - depending on the connected device specifications.)

Controls connected Bluetooth device

You can control connected **Bluetooth** device by the unit; play, pause, skip.



Note

- Only Android OS and iOS is available to use this function.
- This function may not be supported depending on the **Bluetooth** device, or operated differently.

Bluetooth connection lock (BT LOCK)

You can limit **Bluetooth** connection to only BT (Bluetooth) function to prevent unintended Bluetooth connections.

To turn this function on, press and hold **NI PRESET** for about 5 seconds in BT (Bluetooth) function. "ON-BT LOCK" appears then you can limit **Bluetooth** connection.

To turn this function off, press and hold **DI PRESET** for about 5 seconds in BT (Bluetooth) function. "OFF-BT LOCK" appears.

Radio Operations

Pull the FM antenna out and adjust the angle and direction for better reception.

Listening to the radio

 Press F on the unit until FM appears in the display window.

The last received station is tuned in.

2. Auto tuning:

Press and hold KM / DN until the frequency indication starts to change, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Or

Manual tuning:

Press KA / DD repeatedly.

 Adjust the volume by rotating MASTER VOLUME / MULTIJOG knob repeatedly.

Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 10 stations for FM.

Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

- 1. Press ${\bf F}$ until FM appears in the display window.
- 2. Select the desired frequency by pressing KM/DM.
- 3. Press and hold **NI PRESET**. A preset number will blink in the display window.
- 4. Press Kd/DD to select the preset number you want
- Press **>I PRESET**.
 The station is stored.
- 6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
- 7. To listen a preset station, press **> PRESET**.

Deleting all the saved stations

- Press and hold DI PRESET for five seconds. "DEL", "ALL" will flash up alternately on the unit display.
 - If there is no saved radio stations, it displays NONE.
- Press > PRESET to erase all the saved radio stations.
 - "DELETED ALL" will scroll on the unit display.

Sound adjustment

Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set equalizers. The displayed items for the equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

You can select a desired sound mode by using SOUND EFFECT / REPEAT.

| On Display | Description |
|--|---|
| BASS (BASS BLAST) or BASS+ (BASS BLAST+) | Reinforces the bass and powerful sound. |
| POP CLASSIC ROCK JAZZ | This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual rock, pop, jazz or classic concert. |
| STANDARD | You can enjoy optimized sound. |

Other Operations

Using Microphone

- 1. Connect your microphone to the MIC jack.
- 2. Play the music you want.
- Sing along with the accompaniment. Adjust the microphone volume by pressing MIC VOL. and rotating MASTER VOLUME / MULTIJOG clockwise or counterclockwise.



Note

- When not using the microphone, set the MIC volume to minimum or turn off the MIC and remove the microphone from the MIC jack.
- If the microphone is set too near the speaker, a howling sound may be produced. In this case, move the microphone away from the speaker or decrease the sound level by pressing MIC VOL. and rotating

MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG.

 If sound through the microphone is extremely loud, it may be distorted. In this case, press MIC VOL. and rotate

MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG.

 You can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing
 MIC FCHO / VOICE CANCELLER

VOICE CANCELLER

You can reduce the vocal tones during music playback from various input sources.

Press and hold **MIC ECHO / VOICE CANCELLER** and "ON - VOICE CANCELLER" will appear in display window.

To cancel it, press and hold MIC ECHO / VOICE CANCELLER again.

The quality of the VOICE CANCELLER may be different depending on the recording conditions of music files.



- This function is available in the USB or BT (Bluetooth) Function.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- This function is available to use only when a microphone is connected.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" is scrolled in the display window.
- It is not available on the mono source.
- To initialize it, change the function or disconnect the microphone.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.

KEY CHANGER

You can adjust the key to 9 steps (4 steps higher, 4 steps lower and the original key).

To adjust the key much higher or lower, press **KEY CHANGER**.

- To make the key more sharp (#), one by one, rotate the MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG clockwise during playback.
- To make the key more flatten (b), one by one, rotate the MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG counterclockwise during playback.



Note

- This function is available in the USB or BT (Bluetooth) function.
- To initialize it, change the function, disconnect the microphone.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.

VOCAL EFFECTS

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can enjoy karaoke function by changing voice in the various source.

To select various vocal mode effects, pressing VOCAL EFFECTS repeatedly or pressing VOCAL EFFECTS and then turning MASTER VOLUME / MULTIJOG on the unit when vocal effects mode appears in the display window.

DUET MAN \rightarrow DUET WOMAN \rightarrow BASS ECHO1 \rightarrow SOPRANO ECHO1 \rightarrow HELIUM ECHO1 \rightarrow ROBOT ECHO1 \rightarrow DUET MAN1 \rightarrow DUET WOMAN1 \rightarrow BASS ECHO2 \rightarrow SOPRANO ECHO2 \rightarrow HELIUM ECHO2 \rightarrow ROBOT ECHO2 \rightarrow DUET MAN2 \rightarrow DUET WOMAN2 \rightarrow OFF

BASS → SOPRANO → HELIUM → ROBOT →



- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press KEY CHANGER or MIC ECHO
 / VOICE CANCELLER on VOCAL EFFECTS
 mode, after backing up current VOCAL
 EFFECTS, turn off VOCAL EFFECTS mode and
 operate KEY CHANGER or ECHO mode.
- To turn off VOCAL EFFECTS mode, press and hold VOCAL EFFECTS.

ECHO

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing MIC ECHO / VOICE CANCELLER.

 $FCHO 1 \rightarrow FCHO 2 \rightarrow OFF$



Note

- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press VOCAL EFFECTS button on ECHO mode, afters backing up current ECHO, turn off ECHO mode and operate VOCAL EFFECTS mode.

To operate ECHO mode, press MIC ECHO / VOICE CANCELLER again, after backing up current VOCAL EFFECTS.

LIGHTING

This function offers a party atmosphere by operating the lighting on the unit.

To select mode, pressing LIGHTING repeatedly.

PARTY → WATER → FOREST → OFF



Note _____

- · Lighting function is available in all functions.
- Lighting mode retains in its previous mode when you first press LIGHTING, press again to change modes.
- Do not look directly at the light emitting part when the LIGHTING is turned on.
- If the illumination brightness is glaring, switch on the room lights or turn off the LIGHTING.
- · To turn off LED lightning, press and hold LIGHTING for 3 seconds.

Auto power down

This unit will turn itself off to save electricity in the case were the main unit is not connected to an external device and is not used for 15 minutes. The unit will also turns itself off after six hours if the main unit has been connected to another device using the analog inputs.

Auto function change

This unit recognizes input signals such as BT(Bluetooth) and AUX then automatically changes to the suitable function.

When you try to connect Bluetooth

When shipping the unit
