# Introduction

## Playable Discs

This unit plays DVD±R/RW and CD-R/RW that contains audio titles, MP3, WMA and/or JPEG files. Some DVD±RW/DVD±R or CD-RW/CD-R cannot be played on this unit due to the recording quality or physical condition of the disc, or the characteristics of the recording device and authoring software.



DVD-VIDEO (8 cm/12 cm disc)  
Discs such as movies that can be purchased or rented.

DVD±R (8 cm/12 cm disc)  
Video mode and finalized only.

DVD-RW (8 cm/12 cm disc)  
Video mode and finalized only.

## Regional Codes

This unit has a regional code printed on the rear of the unit. This unit can play only DVD discs labeled same as the rear of the unit or “ALL”

- Most DVD discs have a globe with one or more numbers in it clearly visible on the cover. This number must match your unit’s regional code or the disc cannot play.
- If you try to play a DVD with a different regional code from your unit, the message “Check Regional Code” appears on the TV screen.

## Playable file Requirement

### Music file requirement

MP3/WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows.

- Sampling frequency: within 32 to 48 kHz (MP3), within 32 to 48 kHz (WMA)
- Bit rate: within 32 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Support Version: v2, v7, v8, v9
- Maximum files: Disc: 999 / USB: 2,000
- Maximum folders: Disc: 99 / USB: 200
- File extensions: ".mp3"/ ".wma"
- Certain MP3/WMA files may not be played depending on the type or format of the file.
- CD-ROM file format: ISO 9660/ JOLJET
- We recommend that you use Easy-CD Creator, which creates an ISO 9660 file system.
- The DTS disc is not supported.

You have to set the disc format option to [Mastered] in order to make the discs compatible with the LG players when formatting rewritable discs. When setting the option to Live File System, you cannot use it on LG players.

(Mastered/Live File System: Disc format system for Windows Vista)

### Photo file requirement

Photo file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows:

- Max pixel in width: 2760 x 2048 pixel
- Maximum files: Under 999
- Some discs may not operate due to a different recording format or the condition of disc.
- File extensions: ".jpg"
- CD-ROM file format: ISO9660/ JOLJET



## Video file requirement

Video file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows:

- Available resolution: within 720 x 576 (W x H) pixels.
- The file name of the Video subtitle should be entered within 45 characters.
- If there is impossible code to express in the Video file, it may be displayed as " \_ " mark on the display.
- Frame rate: less than 30 fps.
- If the video and audio structure of recorded files is not interleaved, either video or audio is outputted.
- Playable Video file: ".avi", ".mpg", ".mpeg"
- Playable Subtitle format: SubRip (\*.srt/ \*.txt), SAMI (\*.smi), SubStation Alpha (\*.ssa/ \*.txt), MicroDVD (\*.sub/ \*.txt), SubViewer 2.0 (\*.sub/ \*.txt), Vobsub (\*.sub)
- Playable Codec format: "Xvid", "MPEG-1", "MPEG-2"

- For Discs formatted in Live file system, you can not it on this unit.
- If the name of movie file is different from that of the subtitle file, during playback of a Video file, subtitle may not be display.
- If you play a Xvid file differ from Xvid spec, it may not operate normally.
- If you play GMC video file which is more than 1-warp point, video playback screen will not smooth

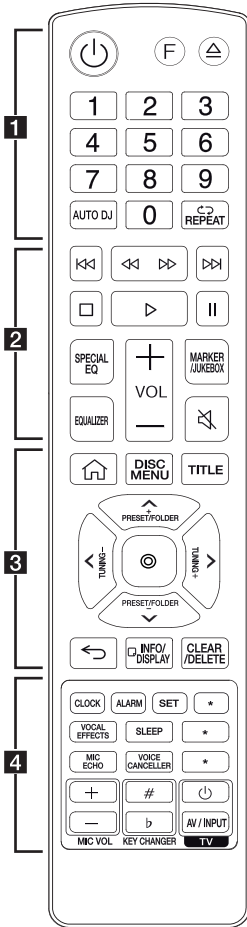

## USB device requirement

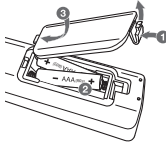
- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/ 32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 2,000 files.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- Some USB may not work with this unit.

**TUNING +/-:** Tunes in the desired radio station.

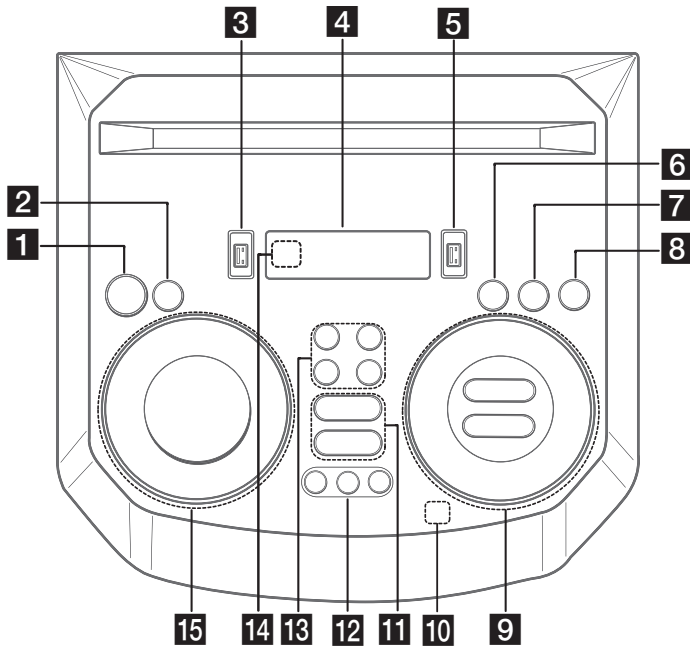

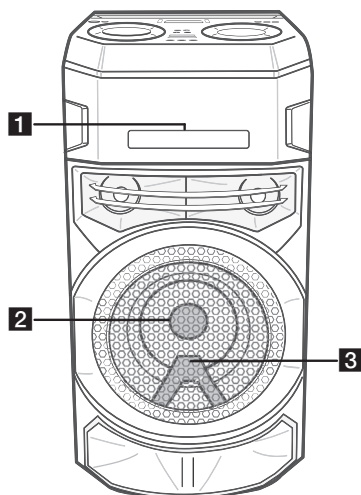

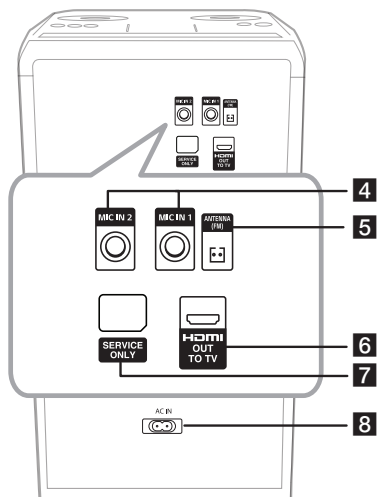

### Caution

- Connect the power cord to wall outlet directly if possible. Or when you use an extension cable, it is highly recommended to use an extension cable of 110 V / 15 A or 230 V / 15 A, otherwise the unit may not operate properly because of the lack of power supply.
- Do not overload the extension cord with excessive electrical load.

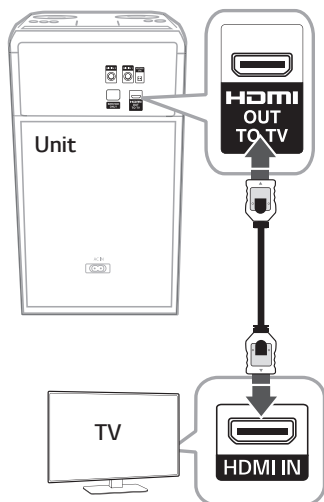
## Connections to Your TV

### HDMI Out Connection

If you have a HDMI TV or monitor, you can connect it to this unit using a HDMI cable (Type A, High Speed HDMI™ Cable).

Connect the HDMI OUT jack on the unit to the HDMI IN jack on a HDMI compatible TV or monitor.

Set the TV's source to HDMI (refer to TV's Owner's manual).



### Caution

- Changing the resolution when the connection has already been established may result in malfunctions. To solve the problem, turn off the unit and then turn it on again.
- When the HDMI connection with HDCP is not verified, TV screen is changed to black or green screen or the snow noise may occur on the screen. In this case, check the HDMI connection, or disconnect the HDMI cable.
- Make sure the unit is connected directly to the TV. Tune the TV to the correct video input channel.

### Note

- You can fully enjoy digital audio and video signals together with this HDMI connection.
- When you use HDMI connection, you can change the resolution for the HDMI output. (Page 17)









### ! Note

- If a connected HDMI device does not accept the audio output of the unit, the HDMI device's audio sound may be distorted or may not output.
- When you connect a HDMI or DVI compatible device make sure of the following:
  - Try switching off the HDMI/DVI device and this unit. Next, switch on the HDMI/DVI device and leave it for around 30 seconds, then switch on this unit.
  - The connected device's video input is set correctly for this unit.
  - The connected device is compatible with 720 x 480i (or 576i), 720 x 480p (or 576p), 1280 x 720p, 1920 x 1080i or 1920 x 1080p video input.
- Not all HDCP-compatible HDMI or DVI devices will work with this unit.
  - The picture will not be displayed properly with non-HDCP device.
  - This unit does not playback and TV screen is changed to black or green screen or the snow noise may occur on the screen.
- If there is noise or lines on the screen, please check the HDMI cable and use a higher version cable than High Speed HDMI™ Cable.
- The HDMI sounds output only DVD/CD function (Except playback effect).

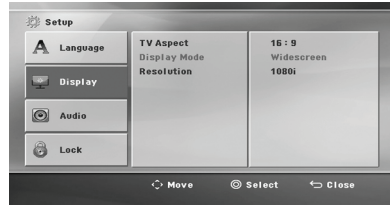
## Resolution Setting










The unit provides several output resolutions for HDMI.

You can change the resolution using [Setup] menu.


1. Press  on the remote control.
2. Use  /  /  /  on the remote control to select the [Setup] and press  on the remote control.

The [Setup] menu appears.



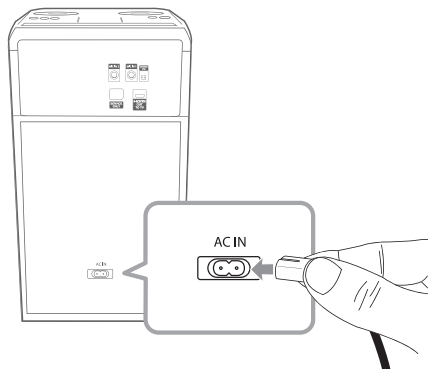
3. Use  /  on the remote control to select [Display] option then press  on the remote control to move to the second level.
4. Use  /  on the remote control to select the [Resolution] option then press  on the remote control to move to the third level.
5. Use  /  on the remote control to select the desired resolution then press  on the remote control to confirm your selection.

### ! Note

- If your TV does not accept the resolution you have set on the player, you can set resolution to 480p (or 576p) as follows: Press  for more than 5 seconds.
- [Home Menu] appears only on DVD/CD function.

## AC Power Cord Connection

1. Connect one end of the AC power cord (included) to the **AC IN** socket.



2. Plug the other end into the wall outlet.

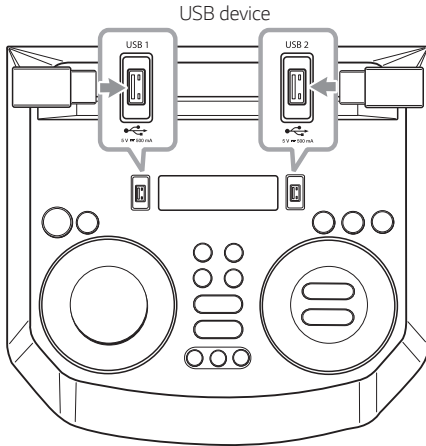

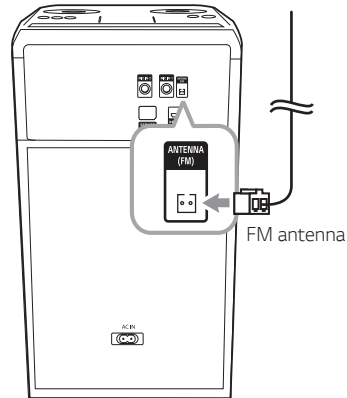

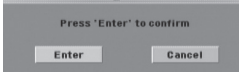
# Adjust the setup settings




By using the Setup menu, you can make various adjustments to items such as picture and sound. You can also set a language for the subtitles and the Setup menu, among other things. For details on each Setup menu item, see pages 20 to 23.

## OSD Initial language settings - Optional


During the first use of this unit, the initial language setup menu appears on your TV screen. You must complete initial language selection before using the unit. English will be selected as the initial language.

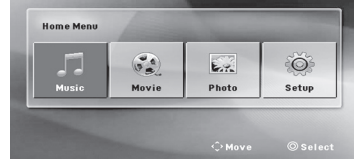
1. Press  to turn the unit on. The language setup menu will appear on the screen.
2. Use  /  /  /  on the remote control to select a language then press  on the remote control. The confirm menu will appear.








3. Use  /  on the remote control to select the [Enter] then  on the remote control to finish the language setup.













## To display and exit the Setup menu

1. Press  on the remote control. Displays the [Home Menu].



2. Select an [Setup] by using  /  on the remote control.

4. Press  on the remote control or  on the remote control to exit in the [Setup] Menu.

## Language

### Menu Language

Select a language for the Setup menu and on screen display.

### Disc Audio / Disc Subtitle / Disc Menu

Select the language you prefer for the audio track (disc audio), subtitles, and the disc menu.

#### [Original]

Refers to the original language in which the disc was recorded.

#### [Other]

To select another language, press numeric buttons and then **OK** on the remote control to enter the corresponding 4-digit number according to the language code list on the page 56.

If you enter the wrong language code, press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control.

#### [Off (for Disc Subtitle)]

Turns off Subtitle.

## Display

### TV Aspect

Select the screen aspect to use based on the shape of your TV screen.

#### [4:3]

Select when a standard 4:3 TV is connected.

#### [16:9]

Select when a 16:9 wide TV is connected.

### Display Mode

The Display Mode setting works only when the TV Aspect mode is set to 4:3.

#### [Letterbox]

Displays a wide picture with bands on the upper and lower portions of the screen.

#### [Panscan]

Automatically displays the wide picture on the entire screen and cuts off the portions that do not fit. (If the disc/file is not compatible with Pan Scan, the picture is displayed at Letterbox ratio.)

### Resolution

Sets the output resolution of HDMI video signal. Refer to "Resolution Setting" for details about the resolution (page 17).

#### [Auto]

If the HDMI jack is connected to TVs providing display information (EDID), automatically selects the resolution best suited to the connected TV.

#### [1080p]

Outputs 1080 lines of progressive video.

#### [1080i]

Outputs 1080 lines of interlaced video.

#### [720p]

Outputs 720 lines of progressive video.

#### [480p (or 576p)]

Outputs 480 (or 576) lines of progressive video.

#### [480i (or 576i)]

Outputs 480 (or 576) lines of interlaced video.

## Audio

### DRC (Dynamic Range Control)

Make the sound clear when the volume is turned down and prevent a sudden sound increase (Dolby Digital only). Set to [On] for this effect.

### HD AV Sync

Sometimes Digital TV encounters a delay between picture and sound. If this happens you can compensate by setting a delay on the sound so that it effectively 'waits' for the picture to arrive: this is called HD AV Sync. Use **▲ / ▼** on the remote control to scroll up and down through the delay amount, which you can set at anything between 0 and 300ms.

### Semi Karaoke

When a chapter/ title/ track is fully finished, this function shows the score in the screen with a fanfare sound.

#### [On]

When you finished singing a score will appear on the screen.

#### [Off]

Fanfare and score do not appear on the screen.

#### Note

- DVD, DVD Karaoke discs with more than 2 tracks are available discs for the this function.
- When you watch movies, "off" the Semi Karaoke at the SETUP menu or enjoy it without connecting the MIC if the fanfare or score appears during changing a chapter.
- This function operate on the DVD/CD mode.
- The Semi Karaoke function is available only when a microphone is connected.
- If you do not use the microphone, turn down the volume and disconnect the microphone.

## Lock (Parental Control)

### Initial Setting the Area Code

When you use this unit for the first time, you have to set the Area Code.

1. Select the [Lock] menu and then press **>** on the remote control.
2. Press **>** on the remote control.  
To access the [Lock] options, you must input the password you have created.  
Input a password and press **OK** on the remote control. Enter it again and press **OK** on the remote control to verify.  
If you make a mistake before pressing **OK** on the remote control, press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control.
3. Select the first character using **▲/▼** on the remote control.
4. Press **OK** on the remote control and select the second character using **▲/▼** on the remote control.
5. Press **OK** on the remote control to confirm your Area code selection.

### Rating

Blocks playback of rated DVDs based on their contents. Not all discs are rated.

1. Select [Rating] on the [Lock] menu then press **>** on the remote control.
2. Input a password and press **OK** on the remote control.
3. Select a rating from 1 to 8 using the **▲/▼** on the remote control.

#### [Rating 1-8]

Rating one (1) has the most restrictions and rating eight (8) is the least restrictive.

#### [Unlock]

If you select unlock, parental control is not active and the disc plays in full.

4. Press **OK** on the remote control to confirm your rating selection.

## Password

You can enter or change password.

1. Select [Password] on the [Lock] menu and then press **>** on the remote control.
2. Press **OK** on the remote control.
3. Input a password and press **OK** on the remote control.  
To change the password, press **OK** on the remote control when the [Change] option is highlighted.  
Input a password and press **OK** on the remote control.  
Enter it again and press **OK** on the remote control to verify.
4. Press **EXIT** on the remote control to exit the menu.



#### Note

If you forget your password, you can clear it using the following steps:


1. Select the [Setup] menu on the [Home Menu].
2. Input the 6-digit number "210499" and press **OK** on the remote control.  
The password is cleared.

## Area Code




Enter the code of the area whose standards were used to rate the DVD video disc, based on the list on page 55.

1. Select [Area Code] on the [Lock] menu then press **>** on the remote control.
2. Input a password and press **OK** on the remote control.
3. Select the first character using **▲/▼** on the remote control.
4. Press **OK** on the remote control and select the second character using **▲/▼** on the remote control.



Time – Elapsed playing time.

Audio – Selected audio language or channel.

Subtitle – Selected subtitle.

Angle – Selected angle/ total number of angles.




#### Note

If any button is not pressed for a few seconds, the on-screen display disappears.

### To display the DVD Menu

#### DVD


When you play a DVD which contains several menu, you can select the menu you want using the Menu.

1. Press **DISC MENU** on the remote control. The disc's menu appears.
2. Select the menu by using **Λ/V/</>** on the remote control.
3. Press  on the remote control to confirm.

### To display the DVD title

#### DVD

When you play a DVD which contains several title, you can select the title you want using the Menu.

1. Press **TITLE** on the remote control. The disc's title appears.
2. Select the menu by pressing **Λ/V/</>** on the remote control.
3. Press  on the remote control to confirm.

### 1.5 times speed playback

#### DVD

The 1.5 speed allows you to watch the pictures and listen to the sound quicker than playing at a normal speed.

1. During playback, press **▷** on the remote control to play at 1.5 times speed. "▶X1.5" appears on the screen.
2. Press **▷** on the remote control again to exit.

### Screen Saver

The screen saver appears when you leave the unit in Stop mode for about five minutes.

## Starting play from selected time

### DVD MOVIE

To start playing at any chosen time on the file or title.

1. Press **INFO/DISPLAY** on the remote control during playback.
2. Press **▲/▼** on the remote control to select the time clock icon and “--:--:--” appears.
3. Input the required start time in hours, minutes, and seconds from left to right.  
If you enter the wrong numbers, press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control to remove the numbers you entered.  
Then input the correct numbers.  
For example, to find a scene at 1 hour, 10 minutes, and 20 seconds, enter “11020” by using numerical buttons on the remote control.
4. Press on the remote control to confirm.  
Playback starts from the selected time.

## Resume playback

### DVD MOVIE MUSIC ACD

The unit records the point where you pressed the depending on the disc.

If “ (Resume Stop)” appears on the screen briefly, press **▶** on the remote control or **▶|** on the unit to resume playback (from the scene point).

If you press twice or unload the disc, “ (Complete Stop)” appears on the screen.

The unit will clear the stopped point.



### Note

- The resume point may be cleared when a button is pressed (for example; , , etc).
- This function may not work on some disc or title/track.

## Changing subtitle code page

### MOVIE

If the subtitle is not displayed properly, you can change the subtitle code page to view the subtitle file properly.

1. During playback, press **INFO/DISPLAY** on the remote control to display the On-Screen display.
2. Use **▲/▼** on the remote control to select the [Code Page] option.
3. Use **</>** on the remote control to select desired code option.
4. Press **↵** on the remote control to exit the On-Screen display.

## Marked Playback

### MUSIC ACD

The mark function enables you to store your favourite files from any disc in the unit memory.

1. Select [Music] on the [Home Menu].

Returning to the upper folder.  
(MP3/ WMA only)

File information will be displayed according to the ID3 TAG information on the appropriate music file. (MP3 only)



Selecting all tracks/files.

Marked playback.

#### [Current Play]

Normal playback.

## To delete a Marker

1. Use  $\wedge / \vee$  on the remote control to select the track that you wish to erase from the marked file.
2. Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control.

## To delete all Markers

Use  $\wedge / \vee / < / >$  on the remote control to select [Deselect All] then press  $\odot$  on the remote control in program edit mode.

### ! Note

The markers are also cleared when the disc is removed, the unit is switched to power off or the function is switched to others.

This unit can play discs with photo files.



- Repeat/Shuffle playback operates as follows.

- When you play JUKEBOX list, only ONE and ALL are available.
- Even after restarting the unit or switching one function to another, you can listen to music from the point where it's last been played.
- USB function is only available on music playback.

## Selecting a folder and an MP3/WMA file

### On the unit

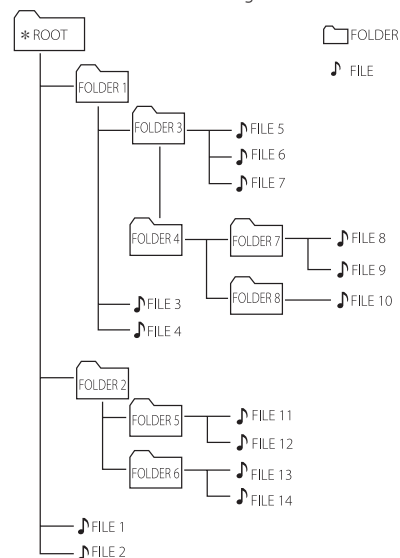
1. Press **SEARCH** and rotate Multi Jog or **⏮/⏭** until a desired file appears. You can also search a folder if you press **SEARCH** again.
2. Press **OK** or **⏮** to play the selected file. When you search a folder, press **OK** to select a file in the folder, then press **OK** or **⏮** again. The selected file is played.

### On the remote control

1. Press **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** on the remote control repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
2. Select the file you want by using **⏮/⏭**.
3. Press **▶** on the remote control.

### ! Note

- USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear.
- Folders will be presented as the following order;  
ROOT → FOLDER 1 → FOLDER 3 → FOLDER 7 → FOLDER 8 → FOLDER 5 → FOLDER 6
- File will be played from **FILE 1** to **FILE 14** one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.

\*ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".

## Deleting a file/folder or format

You can delete file, folder on your USB or format the USB.

1. Select USB function by pressing **F**.
2. Press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control repeatedly, the display changes as followings.  
DEL FILE → DEL DIR → FORMAT

On Display	Description
DEL FILE	Select the file you want to delete
DEL DIR	Select the folder you want to delete
FORMAT	Select to format the USB device.

If you want to exit the current mode, press **□**.

3. To delete file/folder or format, press and hold **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control.



### Caution

- Do not extract the USB device during operation. (play, delete, etc.)
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB status. (lock, etc.)



# Advanced Operations on USB

## JUKEBOX Playback

JUKEBOX function enables you to make a playlist of your favorite files from a USB. A playlist of up to 100 files can be entered.

### Making JUKEBOX list

1. Press and hold **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.  
(Playing will be stopped when you press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control.)
2. Select a file by pressing **KK/▷▷** on the remote control.
3. Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control to save the file.
4. Repeat steps 2 - 3 to store other files.  
(You can modify the list by pressing **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** on the remote control to select the JUKEBOX program number.)
5. Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control once again.

To play the JUKEBOX list, press **▷** on the remote control after you make the list.



#### Note

When making or modifying the JUKEBOX list, REPEAT mode is off.

### Enjoying JUKEBOX

Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control once. "ON-JUKEBOX" appears on the display window.

To play JUKEBOX list, press **▷** on the remote control.

To cancel it, press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control once.

"OFF-JUKEBOX" appears on the display window.

### Editing JUKEBOX

1. Press and hold **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.  
(Playing will be stopped when you press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control.)
2. Press **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** on the remote control to select a file to edit.
3. Press **KK/▷▷** on the remote control.
4. Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control.
5. Repeat 2 to 4 to store the other files.
6. Press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control once again.

To play the JUKEBOX list, press **▷** on the remote control after you edit the list.

### Deleting JUKEBOX list

Deleting function only works in the edit mode.

1. Press and hold **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.  
Or  
Press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control while JUKEBOX is played to enter the edit mode.
2. Select a song by pressing **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** on the remote control repeatedly.
3. Press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control while a song is selected.



#### Note

- If there is no JUKEBOX list, "NO PROG" appears on the display window when you press **MARKER/JUKEBOX** on the remote control.
- JUKEBOX is switched off in the case below.
  - Changing to a different function.
  - Turning off and on the unit.
  - Operating the numerical buttons on the remote control.
  - Playing a file by using **SEARCH** and Multi jog on the unit.
- JUKEBOX list is cleared in the case below.
  - Removing the USB device.
  - Deleting music files in the USB device.

# Playback Effect

The unit supports various sound and playback effects: AUTO DJ, DJ PAD.

## AUTO DJ

Auto DJ blends the end of one song into the beginning of another for seamless playback. It equalizes volume across tracks/files for uninterrupted playback.

Press **AUTO DJ** on the remote control repeatedly, the display changes as followings.

RANDOM (SHUFFLE) → SEQUENTIAL → OFF

On Display	Description
OFF	-
RANDOM (SHUFFLE)	The music is played randomly on this mode.
SEQUENTIAL	The music is played repeatedly on this mode.



### Note

- AUTO DJ mode does not support searching for a section within a track/file or to play repeatedly or randomly.
- If you move to other functions or stop the music using on AUTO DJ mode, AUTO DJ will be disabled.
- AUTO DJ is not supported in the music file whose length is less than 60 seconds.
- Only SEQUENTIAL is selected when played JUKEBOX list.
- In USB function, SHUFFLE displays instead of RANDOM.

## DJ PAD

It allows you to mix CLUB, DRUM or USER sound effect. Each mode has up to 3 sounds effect.

1. Press and hold **DJ PAD (CLUB, DRUM or USER)** on the unit to select a desired DJ PAD sound effect.
2. Press a **DJ PAD (1, 2, 3)** of desired sound on the unit.



### Note

- If you want to use USER, you have to register a source with "LG XBOOM" app (Android Only). If the source is not register to USER, "EMPTY" or "NO SOUND" appears on the display window.
- Initial DJ PAD mode is CLUB sound effect.
- DJ PAD mode is displayed for 3 seconds when you press **DJ PAD (CLUB, DRUM or USER)** on the unit.
- The DJ PAD sound is mixed when you press a **DJ PAD (1, 2, 3)** on the unit.
- The currently playing DJ PAD sound is stopped and the selected DJ PAD sound outputs if you press a different **DJ PAD (1, 2, 3)** on the unit while DJ PAD sound is playing.

## Using BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

### About Bluetooth

**Bluetooth** is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the **Bluetooth** in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth** wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth** wireless technology.

- Available Devices: Smart phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- Version: 4.0
- Codec: SBC, AAC

### Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use **Bluetooth** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

## Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

### Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the **Bluetooth** feature is activated on your **Bluetooth** device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Turn on the unit.



#### Note

When Bluetooth connection lock is activated, you can search **Bluetooth** device in BT function.

2. Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the **Bluetooth** device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of **Bluetooth** device. Your unit appears as "LG ON77DK (XX)":"



#### Note

- XX means the last two digits of **Bluetooth** address. For example, if your unit has a **Bluetooth** address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG ON77DK (08)" on your **Bluetooth** device.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device type, some devices have a different pairing way. For details about **Bluetooth** pairing, refer to your **Bluetooth** device manual.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices simultaneously using the same method as described above, only in the **Bluetooth** function.
- The multi phone pairing connection is only supported on Android devices. (Multi phone pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable **Bluetooth** devices (Ex: Dongle etc.) will not support multi phone pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with your **Bluetooth** device, "PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to **Bluetooth** device name soon. Then "BT" will appear on the display window.

### ! Note

- "PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi phone pairing.
- If the device name is unavailable, " \_ " will be displayed.

4. Listen to music.

To play a music stored on your **Bluetooth** device, refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide.

### ! Note

- When using **Bluetooth** technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device as close as possible and keep the distance.  
However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:
  - There is an obstacle between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device.
  - There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth** technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- If **Bluetooth** connection does not work well, try pairing it again.
- Even if this unit is connected to up to 3 Bluetooth devices in the **Bluetooth** mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.

### ! Note

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the **Bluetooth** function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the **Bluetooth** device gets too far from the unit.
- When **Bluetooth** connection is disconnected, connect the **Bluetooth** device to the unit again.
- When a **Bluetooth** device is not connected, "BT READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use the **Bluetooth** function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the **Bluetooth** device.
- When you connect **Bluetooth** device (iOS device etc.) to this unit or operate the device, the volume level can be synchronized with each other.
- **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when you change the Bluetooth function to some other function. In "LG XBOOM" app connection, only one device which you are playing keeps **Bluetooth** connection. You can control the **Bluetooth** device with this unit but you cannot use sound output.
- When entering the **Bluetooth** function, this unit automatically connects to the last connected **Bluetooth** device or the device which played back last.  
(Auto connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)

## Controls connected Bluetooth device

You can control connected Bluetooth device by the unit; play, pause, stop, skip.



### Note

- Only Android OS and iOS is available to use this function.
- This function may not be supported depending on the **Bluetooth** device, or operated differently.

## Bluetooth connection lock (BT LOCK)

You can limit **Bluetooth** connection to only BT (**Bluetooth**) and LG TV function to prevent unintended **Bluetooth** connections.

To turn this function on, press and hold ► on the remote control or **DI** on the unit for 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function.

"ON-BT LOCK" appears then you can limit **Bluetooth** connection.

To turn this function on, press and hold ► on the remote control or **DI** on the unit for 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function.

"OFF-BT LOCK" appears.



### Note

- Even if you set up **Bluetooth** connection lock to On, this unit turns on by Auto Power function. Turn off Auto Power function to prevent it. (Page 46)
- When you turn on or off the Bluetooth connection lock, search and connect again using Bluetooth after deleting the paired list of your Bluetooth device.
- When you turn on the Bluetooth connection lock, multi phone pairing is not supported.

- If you use “LG XBOOM” app for operation, there would be some differences between “LG XBOOM” app and the supplied remote control. Use the supplied remote control as necessary.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device, “LG XBOOM” app may not work.
- After connection of “LG XBOOM” app, music may be output from your **Bluetooth** device. In this case, try connecting procedure again.
- If you operate the other applications or change the settings on your **Bluetooth** device while using “LG XBOOM” app, “LG XBOOM” app may operate abnormally.
- When “LG XBOOM” app operates abnormally, check your **Bluetooth** device and the connection of “LG XBOOM” app and then try to connect again.
- Depending on the smart phone's operating system, you have some differences for “LG XBOOM” operation.
- Check **Bluetooth** setting on your **Bluetooth** device if “LG XBOOM” app connection does not work well.

## Radio Operations

Be sure that FM antenna is connected. (Page 19)

### Listening to the radio

1. Press **F** until FM appears in the display window.  
The last received station is tuned in.
2. Auto tuning:  
Press and hold **TUNING-/+** on the remote control or **KK/▷▷** on the unit until the frequency indication starts to change, then release.  
Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Or

Manual tuning:

Press **TUNING-/+** on the remote control or **KK/▷▷** on the unit repeatedly.

3. Adjust the volume by pressing **VOL +/-** repeatedly.

### Improving poor FM reception

Press **▷** on the remote control or **▷▷** on the unit.  
This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

## Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM.

Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

1. Press **F** until FM appears in the display window.
2. Select the desired frequency by pressing **TUNING -/+** on the remote control or **KK/▷▷** on the unit.
3. Press **⦿** on the remote control. A preset number will blink in the display window.
4. Press **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** on the remote control to select the preset number you want.
5. Press **⦿** on the remote control.  
The station is stored.
6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
7. To listen a preset station, press **PRESET/FOLDER +/-** or **0** to **9** numerical buttons on the remote control.

## Deleting all the saved stations

1. Press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control.  
"DEL ALL" will flash up on the display window
2. Press **CLEAR/DELETE** on the remote control to erase all the saved radio stations.  
"DELETED ALL" will scroll on the display window.



# Sound adjustment

## Setting the sound mode


This system has a number of pre-set equalizers. The displayed items for the equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

You can select a desired sound mode by using **EQUALIZER** on the remote control.

BASS (BASS BLAST) or BASS+ (BASS BLAST+)	Reinforces the bass and powerful sound.

STANDARD	You can enjoy optimized sound.

You can select a desired sound mode by using **SPECIAL EQ** on the remote control or **SPECIAL EQ / BASS BLAST** (or **BASS BLAST+**) on the unit.

**Note**

By pressing and holding **SPECIAL EQ / BASS BLAST** (or **BASS BLAST+**) on the unit for 3 seconds, you can directly select BASS (BASS BLAST) or BASS+ (BASS BLAST+) effect.

## Setting the USER EQ

You can adjust the sound level of Bass, Middle and Treble as your preference.


1. Press **USER EQ** on the unit. "USER EQ" is displayed.
2. Press **USER EQ** on the unit repeatedly until desired setting appears in the display window.
3. Rotate Multi Jog on the unit to adjust the value.

## Other Operations

### Turn off the sound temporarily

Press  on the remote control to mute your sound.


You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the "MUTE" will appear in the display window.


To cancel it, press  on the remote control again or change the volume level.

### DEMO

In the power off state, press **DEMO** on the unit once. The unit will power on and display the each of functions with demo sound in the display window. To cancel the DEMO function, press **DEMO** on the unit once more.

### Resume stop

The unit records the point where you pressed  depending on the disc or USB.

If you press  twice, the unit will clear the stopped point.

## CHILDSAFE Mode

This function helps to prevent you from being surprised when you turn on the unit in case that the volume of the unit is set at a high level.

To turn on CHILDSAFE mode, press and hold **OK** on the unit when the volume of the unit is "MIN".

In CHILDSAFE mode, the volume increase gradually.

To turn off CHILDSAFE mode, press and hold **OK** on the unit when the volume of the unit is "MIN" and this mode is turned on.

#### Note

In case of USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) function, CHILDSAFE mode does not work after about 2 minutes from power on the unit even if this mode is enabled.

## Last Scene Memory

### DVD


This unit memorizes last scene from the last disc that is viewed. The last scene remains in memory even if you remove the disc from the unit or switch off the unit. If you load a disc that has the scene memorized, the scene is automatically recalled.

## Power Resume - Optional

### DVD

Even if the power suddenly goes out, turn on the unit and then it plays a position where the contents is being played. System will periodically save current playback status.

## System Select - Optional

You must select the appropriate system mode for your TV system. Press and hold  on the remote control for more than five seconds to be able to select a system in the [Home Menu]. (NTSC ↔ PAL)

#### Note

If the USB device is connected or a disc is inserted, this function is not operated.

## Using Microphone

1. Connect your microphone to the **MIC IN** jack.
2. Play the music you want.
3. Sing along with the accompaniment. Adjust the microphone volume by pressing **MIC VOL -/+** on the remote control or **MIC -/+** on the unit.

### Note

- When not using the microphone, set the MIC volume to minimum or turn off the MIC and remove the microphone from the **MIC IN** jack.
- If the microphone is set too near the speaker, a howling sound may be produced. In this case, move the microphone away from the speaker or decrease the sound level by using the **MIC VOL -** on the remote control or **MIC -** on the unit.
- If sound through the microphone is extremely loud, it may be distorted. In this case, set the microphone volume by pressing **MIC VOL -** on the remote control or **MIC -** on the unit.
- You can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **MIC ECHO**.

## VOICE CANCELLER

You can reduce the vocal tones during music playback from various input sources.

Press the **VOICE CANCELLER** and "ON-VOICE CANCELLER" will appear in display window.

To cancel it, press **VOICE CANCELLER** again.

The quality of the VOICE CANCELLER may be different depending on the recording conditions of music files.

### Note

- This function is available in the DVD/CD, USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) Function.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- This function is available to use only when a microphone is connected.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- It is not available on the mono source.
- To initialize it, change the function or disconnect the microphone.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.

## KEY CHANGER

You can adjust the key to 9 steps (4 steps higher, 4 steps lower and the original key).

- To make key more sharp, one by one, press the **KEY CHANGER(#)** repeatedly during playback.
- To make the key more flatten, one by one, press the **KEY CHANGER(b)** repeatedly during playback.

### ! Note

- This function is available in the DVD/CD, USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) Function.
- To initialize it, change the function, disconnect the microphone or change the music.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.

## VOCAL EFFECTS

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can enjoy karaoke function by changing voice in the various source.

To select various vocal effects mode, pressing **VOCAL EFFECTS** repeatedly when vocal effects mode appears in the display window.

BASS → SOPRANO → HELIUM → ROBOT →  
DUET MAN → DUET WOMAN → BASS ECHO1  
→ SOPRANO ECHO1 → HELIUM ECHO1  
→ ROBOT ECHO1 → DUET MAN1 → DUET  
WOMAN1 → BASS ECHO2 → SOPRANO  
ECHO2 → HELIUM ECHO2 → ROBOT ECHO2  
→ DUET MAN2 → DUET WOMAN2 → OFF

### ! Note

- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press **KEY CHANGER** or **MIC ECHO** on VOCAL EFFECTS mode, after backing up current VOCAL EFFECTS, turn off VOCAL EFFECTS mode and operate KEY CHANGER, or ECHO mode.
- To turn off VOCAL EFFECTS mode, press and hold **VOCAL EFFECTS**.

## ECHO

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **MIC ECHO**.

ECHO 1 → ECHO 2 → OFF



### Note

- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press **VOCAL EFFECTS** button on ECHO mode, after backing up current ECHO, turn off ECHO mode and operate VOCAL EFFECTS mode.  
Press **MIC ECHO** again, after backing up current VOCAL EFFECTS, operate ECHO mode.

## LIGHTING

This function offers a party atmosphere by operating the lighting on the unit.

Press **LIGHTING** on the unit repeatedly.

PARTY → WATER → FOREST → (MY STYLE) → OFF



### Note

- Lighting function is available in all functions.
- Lighting mode retains in its previous mode when you first press **LIGHTING** on the unit, press again to change modes.
- If you want to use MY STYLE, you have to register a source with "LG XBOOM" app.
- Do not look directly at the light emitting part when the **LIGHTING** is turned on.
- Operation may be different depending on the played music, connected device or setting status.
- If the illumination brightness is glaring, switch on the room lights or turn off the **LIGHTING** of the unit.
- You can also turn off the light by pressing and holding **LIGHTING** on the unit.

## Sleep Timer Setting

Press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After the delay time, the unit will be turned off.

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly until "OFF" appears.



### Note

- You can check the remaining time before the unit is turned off. Press **SLEEP** on the remote control to check or change the remaining time.
- You can edit the remain time when the remaining time or "DIMMER" is displayed.

## Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** on the remote control once. The display window will be darkened by half.

To cancel it, press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly until "OFF" appears.



### Note

All the lighting turns off when Dimmer is being operated.

## Auto power down

This unit will turn itself off to save electricity in the case where the main unit is not connected to an external device and is not used for 15 minutes. The unit will also turn itself off after six hours if the main unit has been connected to another device using the analog inputs.

Auto power down function is applied to only MAIN unit in case of WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection. In case of OTHER unit, Auto power down is available after disconnection OTHER unit and MAIN unit.

## How to disconnect the wireless network


Connection or the wireless device Turn off the unit by pressing the power button for more than 5 seconds

## AUTO POWER On

This unit automatically turns on by an input source: LG TV or **Bluetooth**.

When you turn on your TV connected to this unit, this unit recognizes the input signal and selects the suitable function. You can hear the sound from the unit.

If you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device, this unit turns on and connects your **Bluetooth** device. You can play your music.

When you turn off this unit by pressing  on the unit for 5 seconds each time, you can turn on or off the AUTO POWER function.

On Display	Description
ON-AUTO POWER	AUTO POWER function is turned on.
OFF-AUTO POWER	AUTO POWER function is turned off.

### ! Note

- Depending on the connected device, this function may not operate.
- Depending on the connected device, the unit turns on but **Bluetooth** function may not be connected.
- If you disconnect **Bluetooth** connection by this unit, some **Bluetooth** devices try to connect to the unit continually. Therefore it is recommended to disconnect the connection before turning off the unit.
- If you try to connect to the "LG XBOOM" app, **Bluetooth** function of this unit is turned on. (Android Only)
- If you turn on the unit using LG TV or **Bluetooth** function, proper function of this unit is turned on.
- If you have already paired with this unit, this unit can automatically turn on by an input source when this unit is turned off.

## Auto function change

This unit recognizes input signals such as **Bluetooth** and LG TV and then automatically changes to the suitable function.

### When you try to connect Bluetooth device

When you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit, **Bluetooth** function is selected. Play your music on the **Bluetooth** device.

### When LG TV is connected

When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync, this unit changes the function to LG TV. You can hear the sound from your TV.

### ! Note

- This function is not available during deleting.
- If the **Bluetooth** connection lock function is set, **Bluetooth** and LG TV connection will be only available on **Bluetooth** and LG TV function. (Page 37)

## Setting the Clock

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press and hold **CLOCK** on the remote control.
3. Select time mode by pressing **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control.  
- AM 12:00 (for an AM and PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
4. Press **SET** on the remote control to confirm your selection.
5. Select the hours by pressing **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control.
6. Press **SET** on the remote control.
7. Select the minutes by pressing **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control.
8. Press **SET** on the remote control.

## Setting the Clock through “LG XBOOM” App

Install “LG XBOOM” app on your Android device.  
(Page 38 -39)

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating **Bluetooth** connection through “LG XBOOM” app.

## Using your player as an alarm clock

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press and hold **ALARM** on the remote control.
3. Press **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control to change the hours and minutes and press **SET** on the remote control to save.
4. Press **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control to select function and press **SET** on the remote control to save.  
- Press **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control to select a preset number when you select tuner and then, press **SET** on the remote control.  
If there is no preset number, this step is skipped.
5. Press **⏮** / **⏭** on the remote control to change the volume and press **SET** on the remote control to save.



### Note

- If you set the clock time, you can check the time by pressing **CLOCK** on the remote control even when the player is turned off.
- You can set alarm after you set the clock time.
- If you set the clock time and alarm, you can check the alarm setting information by pressing **ALARM** on the remote control even when the unit is turned off.
- You can select ALARM ON/OFF mode by pressing **ALARM** on the remote control.
- In case of DVD/CD or USB, this function is available when you have music file. If you do not have music file, the function is changed to Tuner.




## LG Sound Sync




You can control some functions of this unit by your TV's remote control with LG Sound Sync. It is compatible with LG TV that supports LG Sound Sync. Make sure your TV has the LG Sound Sync logo.

Controllable function by LG TV's remote control :  
Volume up/down, mute

1. Turn on the unit by pressing .
2. Press **F** until LG TV function is selected.
3. Set up the sound output of TV to listen to the sound through this unit :  
"PAIRED" appears on the display window for about 3 seconds and then you can see "LG TV" on the display window if the TV and this unit are connected normally.  
(Refer to the TV's instruction manual for the details of LG Sound Sync.)

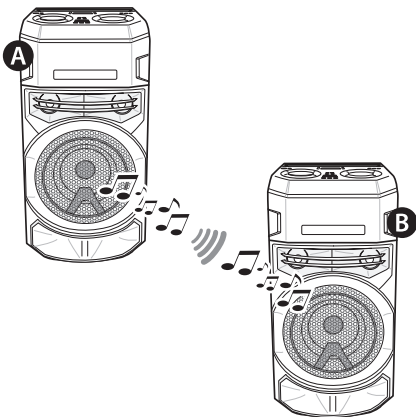
### Note

- You can also use the remote control of this unit while using LG Sound Sync. If you use TV's remote control again, the unit synchronizes with the TV. (According to TV Specifications, the volume and mute of this unit synchronize with TV.)
- If the connection fails, check the conditions of this unit and your TV : power, function.
- Make sure of the condition of this unit and the connection in the cases below when using LG Sound Sync.
  - The unit is turned off.
  - Changing to a different function.
  - Disconnecting the wireless connection caused by interference or a distance.
- The amount of time to turn off this unit is different depending on your TV.
- If you try to change the function on using the LG TV function, volume will be change according to the LG TV volume level.
- If you turned off the unit directly by pressing , LG Sound Sync will be disconnected. To use this function again, you should reconnect the TV and the unit.
- The volume may be increased when the TV and this unit is connected by LG Sound Sync. Decrease the TV volume and then connect with this unit.
- When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync or enter LG TV function, this unit changes the function to LG TV automatically.
- You should set the TV Sound output manually depending on the TV version.
- If you control TV volume when this unit and TV are connected by LG Sound Sync, this unit may louder the volume due to synchronizing volume with TV's.

## WIRELESS PARTY LINK Connection

You can enjoy the sound by using two speakers. For enjoying WIRELESS PARTY LINK, you need to purchase another speaker.

It is compatible with unit that supports WIRELESS PARTY LINK.



1. Press **TWIN** on the unit.  
ROLE SELECT appears in the display window.
2. Press **TWIN** on the unit to select MAIN or OTHER.

- **A** unit: Selects MAIN.

- **B** unit: Selects OTHER.

Two units try to connect with each other.

3. When these units are successfully connected to each other, each of connected device names appears in the each unit.

### ! Note

- If you using the LG Sound Sync, this function is not available. If you connect the LG TV Function, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- You can use microphone in the OTHER unit only. In case of OTHER unit, some functions are supported only.
- When WIRELESS PARTY LINK is disconnected, OTHER unit is changed to BT (**Bluetooth**) function.
- If the connection is failed, "FAILED" appears in the display window.
- Mute function is synchronized with each other.
- WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection will be disconnected when you turn off the unit or press **TWIN** on the unit.
- Sound of MAIN unit and OTHER unit may be different depending on playback status or source.

### ! Note

- Check the following information when connecting to **Bluetooth**.
  - You can connect only one **Bluetooth** device in the MAIN unit. You cannot connect **Bluetooth** device to the OTHER unit.
  - WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection is only supported on Android devices. (WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications or OS.)
  - Removable/detachable **Bluetooth** devices (ex. Dongle etc.) will not support WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection.
  - When WIRELESS PARTY LINK is connected, Bluetooth connection is not available in status of deleting.
  - If you connect WIRELESS PARTY LINK while you are playing connected **Bluetooth** device, it may be reconnected again, depending on phone specification.

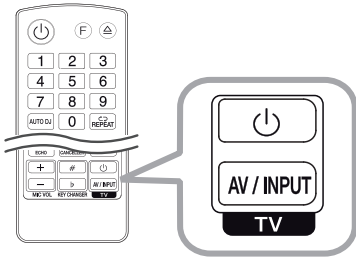

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## Maintenance

### Notes on Discs

#### Handling Discs

Never stick paper or tape on the disc.

#### Storing Discs

After playing, store the disc in its case. Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat and never leave it in a parked car exposed to direct sunlight.

#### Cleaning Discs

Fingerprints and dust on the disc can cause poor picture quality and sound distortion. Before playing, clean the disc with a clean cloth. Wipe the disc from the center to out.

Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzene, thinner, commercially available cleaners, or anti-static spray intended for old vinyl records.

## Handling the Unit

### When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

### Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit. Wiping with strong pressure may damage the surface. Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time.

### Cleaning the unit

To clean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzene, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the unit.
