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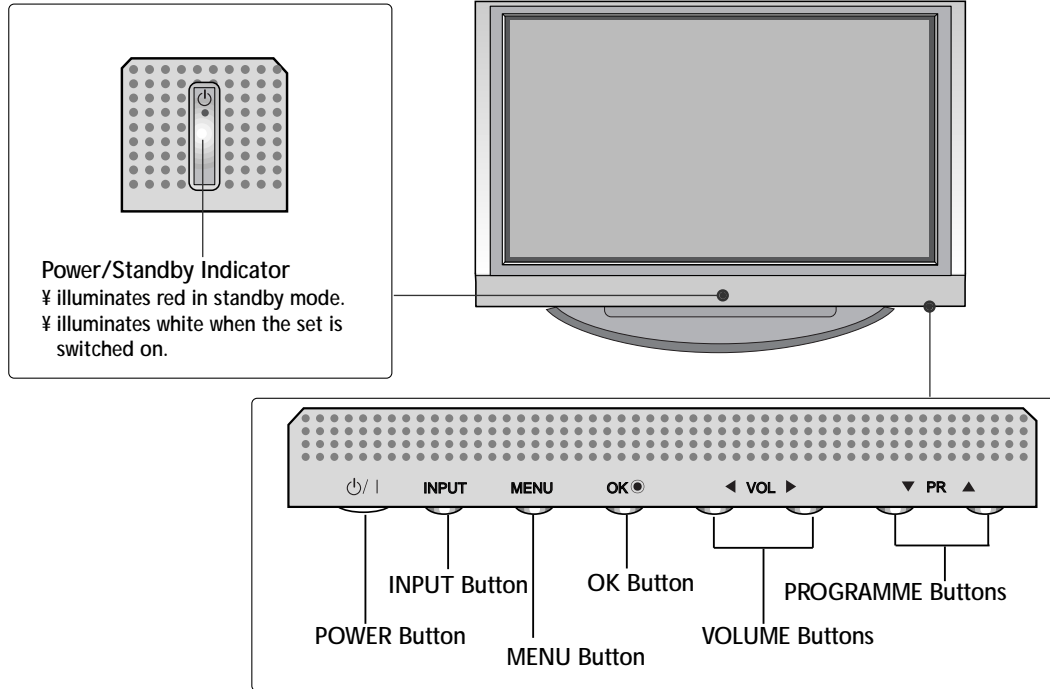

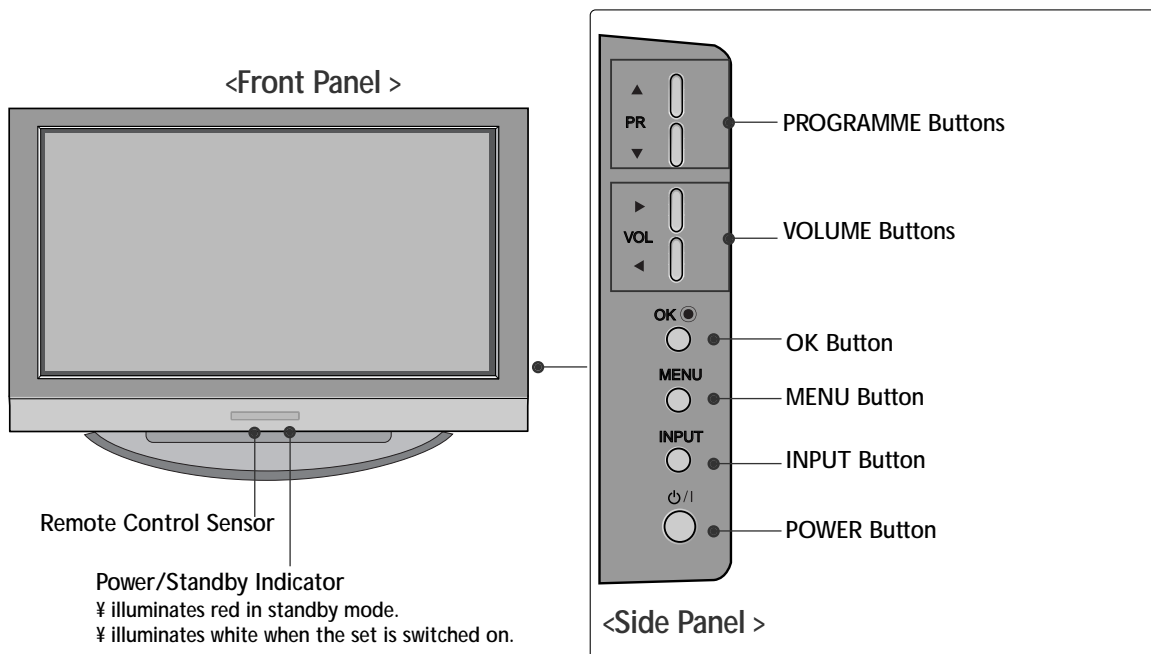

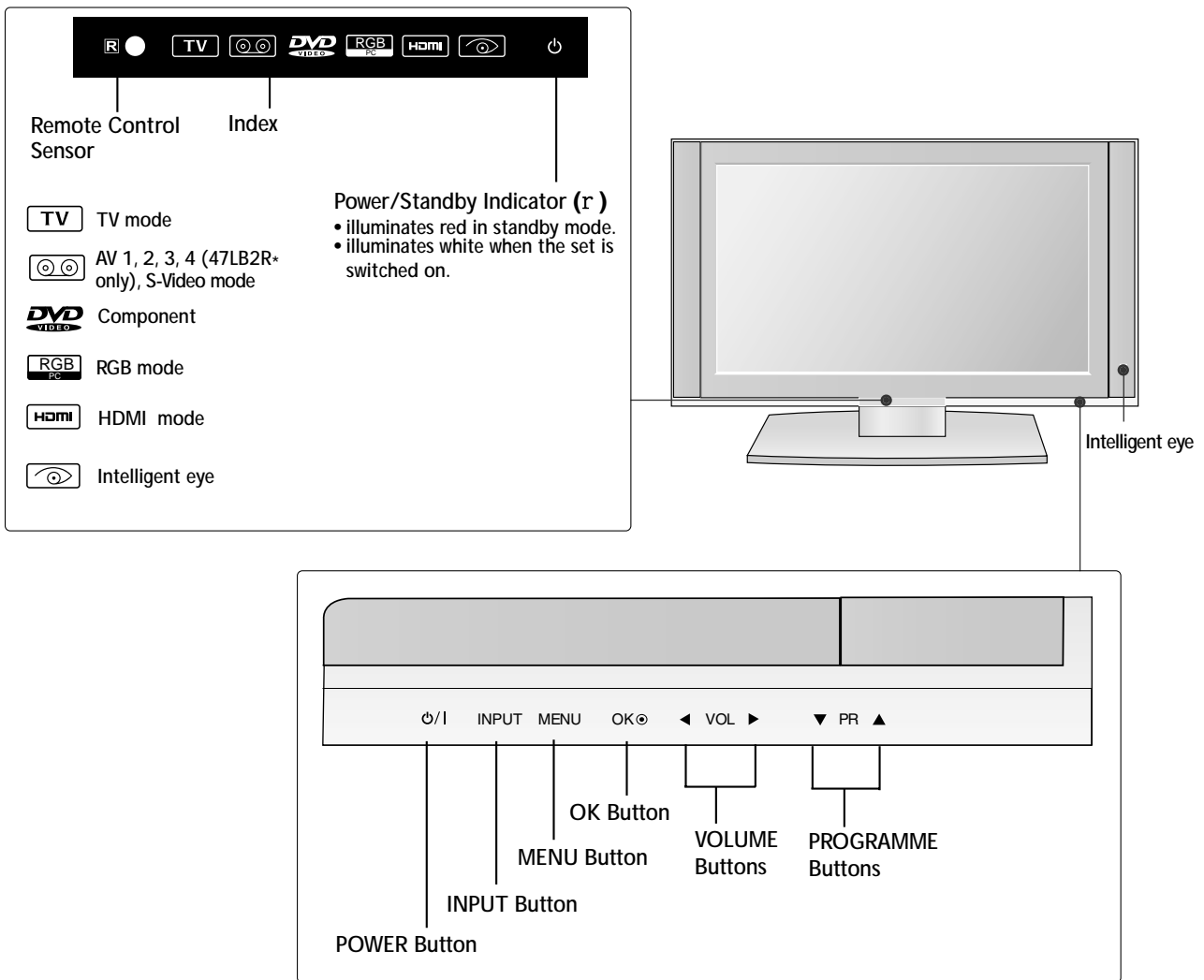

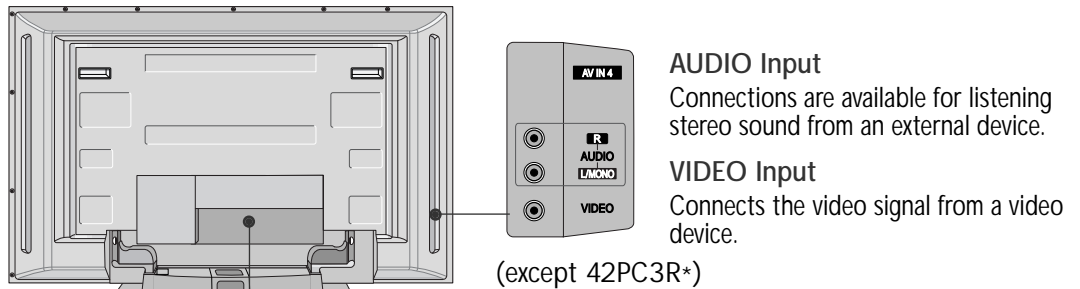

Back Connection Panel

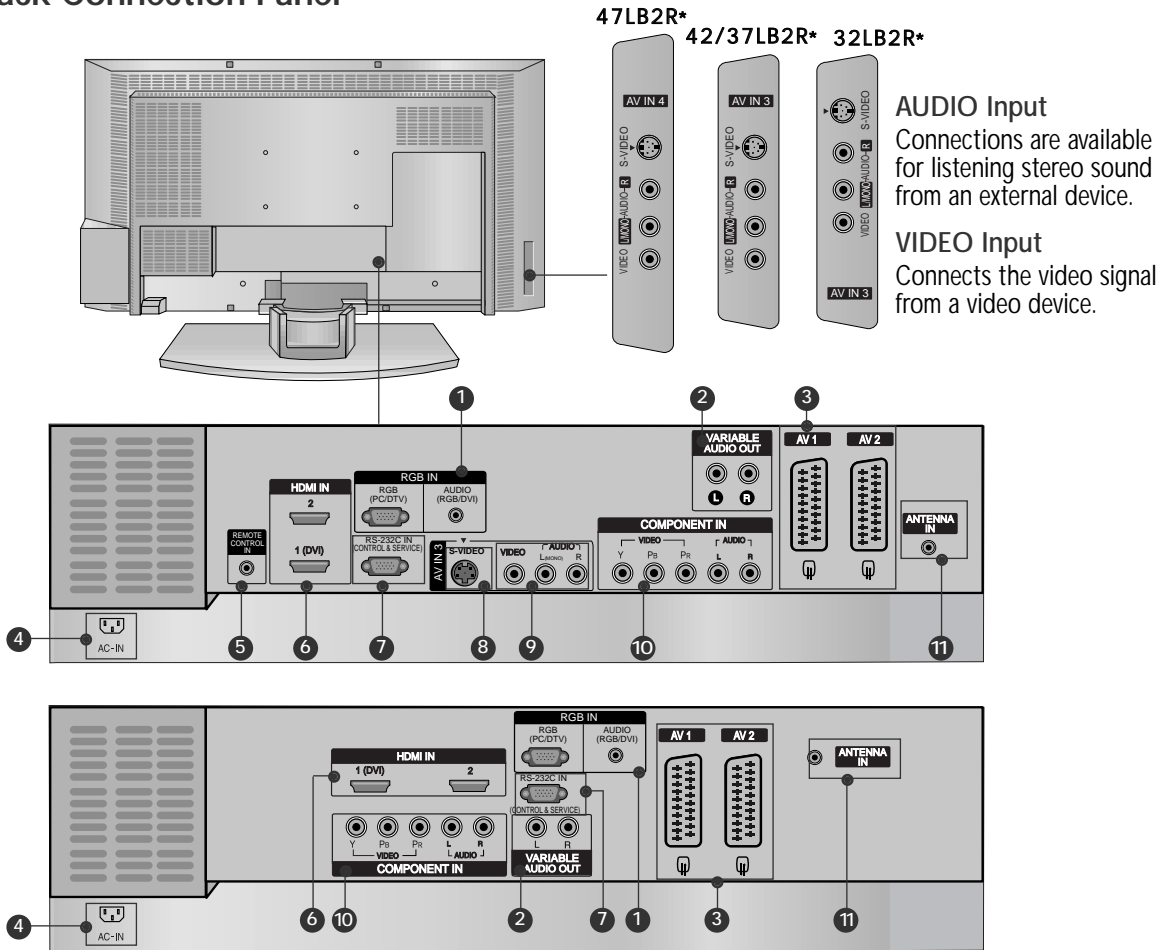


- 1** RGB/Audio Input
Connect the monitor output from a PC/DTV to the appropriate input port.
- 2** Variable Audio Output
Connect an external amplifier or add a sub-woofer to your surround sound system.
- 3** Euro Scart Socket (AV1/AV2)
Connect scart socket input or output from an external device to these jacks.
- 4** Power Cord Socket
This TV operates on an AC power. The voltage is indicated on the Specifications page. Never attempt to operate the TV on DC power.
- 5** Remote Control Port
- 6** HDMI Input
Connect a HDMI signal to HDMI IN.
Connect DVI(VIDEO) signal to HDMI/DVI port with DVI to HDMI cable.
- 7** RS-232C Input(CONTROL&SERVICE)Port
Connect the serial port of the control devices to the RS-232C jack.
- 8** S-Video Input
Connect S-Video out from an S-VIDEO device.
- 9** Audio/Video Input
Connect audio/video output from an external device to these jacks.
- 10** Component Input
Connect a component video/audio device to these jacks.
- 11** Antenna Input

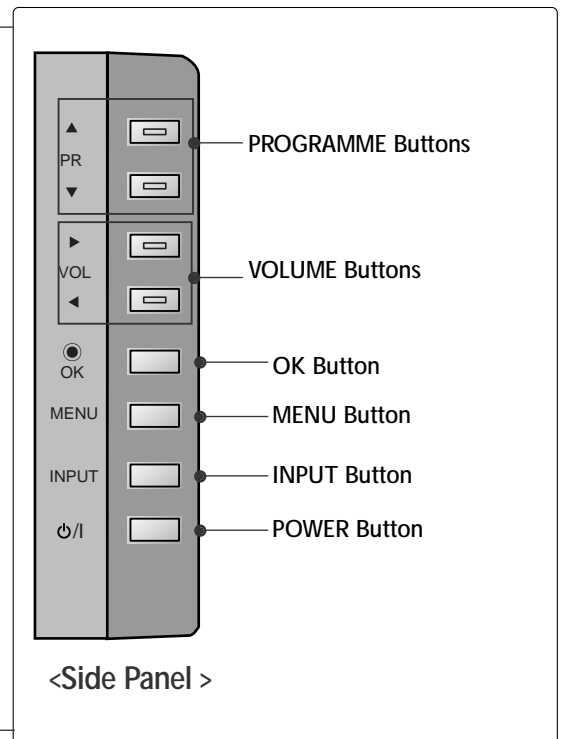

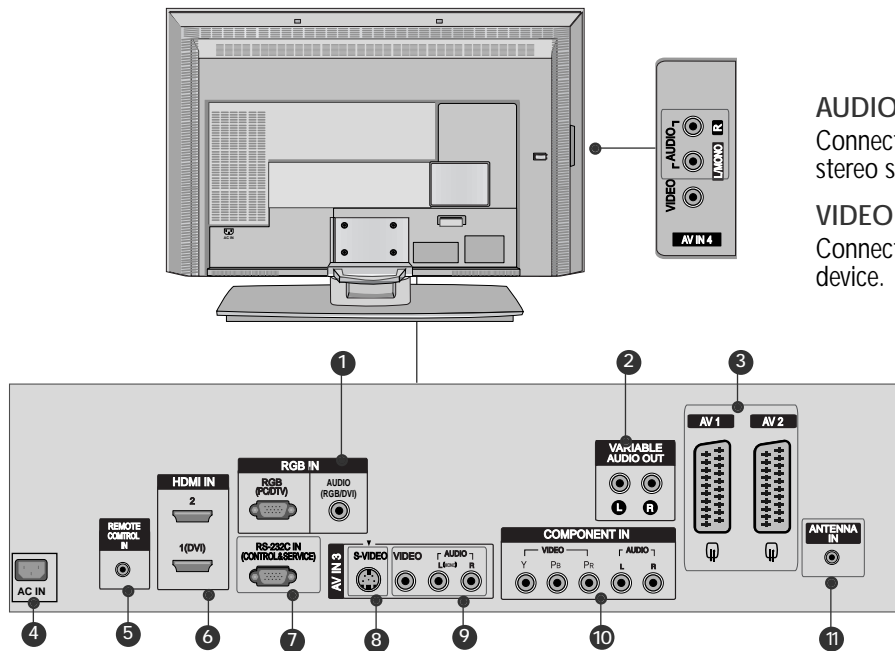

AUDIO Input

Connections are available for listening stereo sound from an external device.

VIDEO Input

Connects the video signal from a video device.

Connect an external amplifier or add a subwoofer to your surround sound system.
- 3** Euro Scart Socket (AV1/AV2)
Connect scart socket input or output from an external device to these jacks.
- 4** Power Cord Socket

REMOTE CONTROL KEY FUNCTIONS

POWER Switches the set on from standby or off to standby.

TV INPUT Returns from **AV1, AV2, S-Video2** (except 32/37/42LB2R*), **AV3, AV4**(except 42PC3R*, 32/37/42LB2R*), **Component, RGB, HDMI1/DVI** or **HDMI 2** to the TV mode. Switches the set on from standby.

INPUT If you press the button once, the input source OSD will appear on screen as shown. Press the **D / E** button and then **OK** button to select the desired input source (**TV, AV1, AV2, S-Video2**(except 32/37/42LB2R*), **AV3, AV4**(except 42PC3R*, 32/37/42LB2R*), **Component, RGB, HDMI1/DVI** or **HDMI 2**).

ARC Selects your desired picture format.

Brightness adjustment Adjusts screen brightness. It returns to the default settings brightness by changing mode source.

PIP Switches the sub picture PIP, DW, POP(except 47LB2R*) or off mode.

SIZE Adjusts the sub picture size.

POSITION Moves the sub picture.

PIP PR - / + Selects a programme for the sub picture.

SWAP Exchanges the main/sub images in PIP/Double window/POP mode.

PIP INPUT Selects the input source for the sub picture in PIP/Double window mode.

Coloured buttons These buttons are used for teletext (only **TELETEXT** models) or **Programme edit**.

VCR/DVD control buttons Controls some video cassette recorders or DVD players when you have already selected DVD or VCR mode button.

EXIT Clears all on-screen displays and returns to TV viewing from any menu.

LIST Displays the programme table.

MENU Selects a menu.

I/II Selects the sound output.

SLEEP Sets the sleep timer.



- MODE** Selects the remote operating modes.
- 1 TELETEXT BUTTONS** These buttons are used for teletext. For further details, see the **Teletext** section.
- THUMBSTICK (Up/Down/Left Right)** Allows you to navigate the on-screen menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.

OK Accepts your selection or displays the current mode.
- VOLUME UP /DOWN** Adjusts the volume.

Q.VIEW Returns to the previously viewed programme.

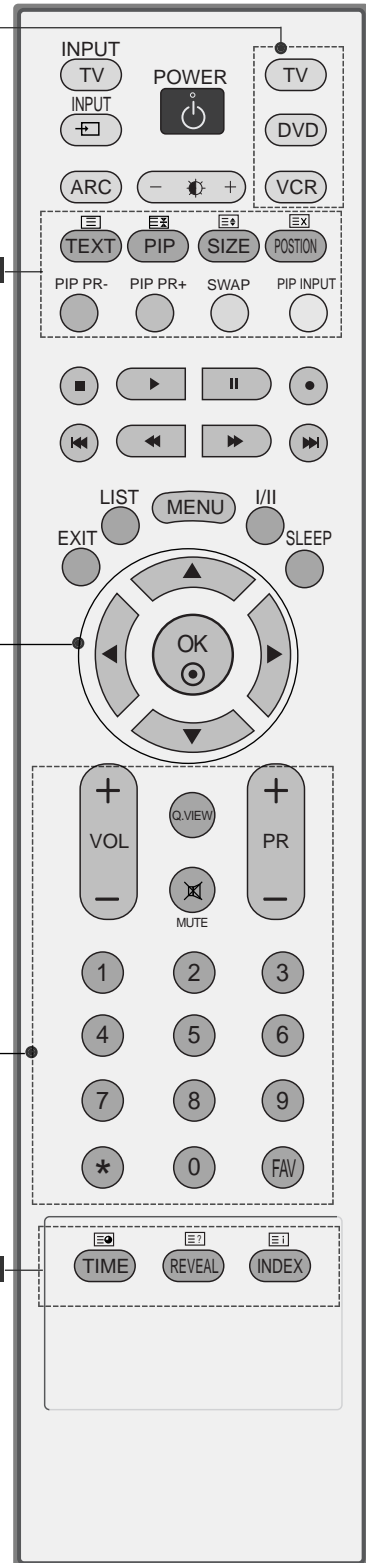
MUTE Switches the sound on or off.

Programme UP/DOWN Selects available programmes.

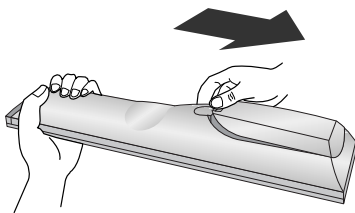
0~9 number button Selects a programme. Selects numbered items in a menu.

FAV Displays the selected favourite programme.

INSTALLING BATTERIES



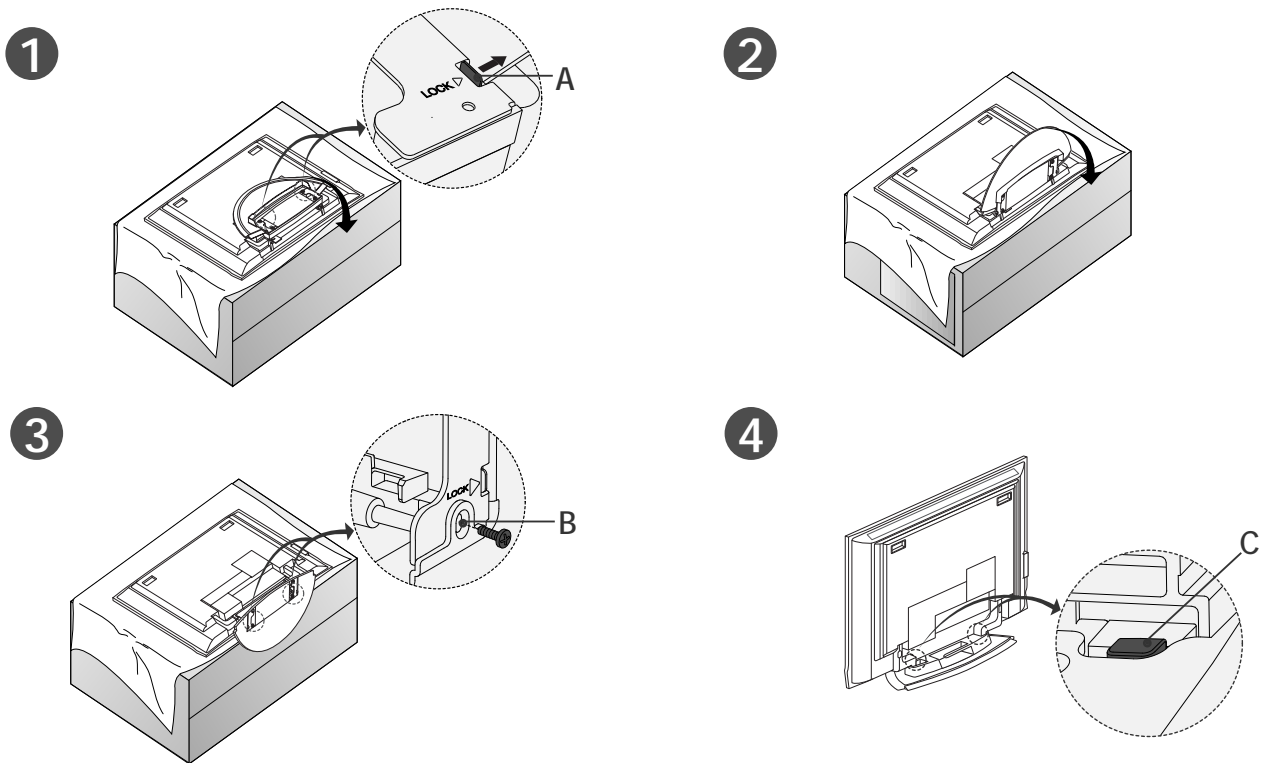
- ¥ Open the battery compartment cover on the back side and insert the batteries with correct polarity.
- ¥ Install two 1.5V alkaline batteries of AA type. Don't mix used batteries with new batteries.

INSTALLATION

UNFOLDING THE BASE STAND (42PC1R*, 42PC3R*)

- This feature is not available for all models.

INSTALLATION



- Place the set with the screen facing down on a cushion or soft cloth as shown in Figure 1. Before unfolding the stand, please make sure two locks (A) on the bottom of the stand push outward.
- Pull the stand out as shown above in Figures 2 ~ 3. After unfolding the stand, please insert and tighten the screws in the holes (B) on the bottom of the stand.
- When connecting cables to the set, do not disengage the lock (C). This may cause the set to fall, causing serious bodily injury and serious damage to the set.

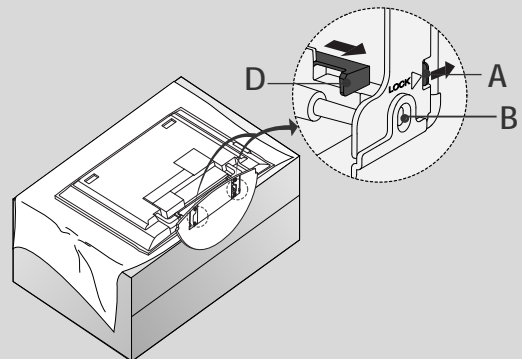
NOTE

Figures shown here may be slightly different from your set.

When closing the stand for storage

First remove the screws in the holes (B) on the bottom of the stand. And then pull two Hooks (D) of the stand bottom and fold the stand into the back of the set.

After folding, push two Locks (A) of the stand bottom outward.

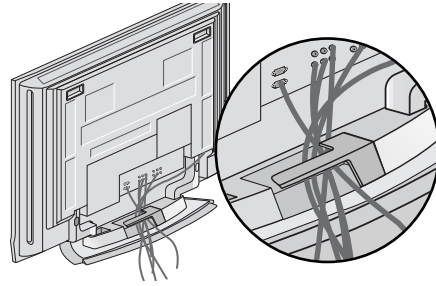


BASIC CONNECTION (PLASMA TV MODELS)

- These models have two cable arrangement methods according to the stand type.

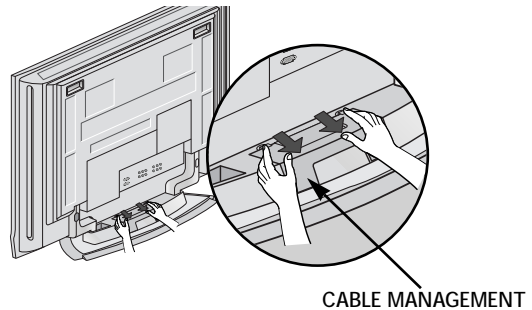
Stand type 1

Arrange the cables as shown picture.

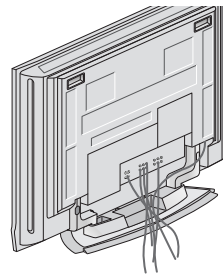


Stand type 2

- 1 Hold the **CABLE MANAGEMENT** with both hands and push it as shown.



- 2 Connect the cables as necessary.

- 3 Reinstall the **CABLE MANAGEMENT** as shown.
