






Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template

## Remote control



#### **Battery Installation**

Remove the battery cover on the rear of the Remote Control, and insert (size AAA) battery with 
◆ and ◆ matched correctly.

(b) (Power): Switches the unit ON or OFF.

DOLBY DRC (ON/ OFF): Sets the Dobly DRC.

**♥**: Mutes the sound.

**VOL -/+:** Adjusts speaker volume.

**AV SYNC -/+:** Synchronizes the audio and video.



- When the volume reaches the highest/ lowest level and you push VOL+/- on the remote control again, red LED on the unit turns on for 2 seconds to signal on what the volume level is.
- When the unit turns on, volume of the unit will rise gradually to the volume level set at the unit turned off.





## Installing the sound bar

You can hear the sound by connecting the unit to the other device : TV, Blu-ray disc player, DVD player, etc

Place the unit in front of the TV and connect it to the device you want. (Refer to page 11)



## Installing the cover foot


You can extend the height of the unit.




- 1. Turn the unit upside down.
- 2. After detaching a release layer on the cover foot, Put it on the foot of the unit.
- 3. Make the cover foot attached firmly to the unit by pushing it strongly.

## Mounting the main unit on a wall


You can mount the main unit on a wall. Prepare screws and brackets.



1. Match the TV's BOTTOM EDGE of Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template with the bottom of TV and attach to the position.




2. When you mount it on a wall (concrete), use the wall plugs (Not supplied). You should drill some holes. A guide sheet (Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template) is supplied to drill. Use the sheet to check the point to drill.




#### Note

Screws and Wall Plugs are not supplied for mounting the unit. We recommend the Hilti (HUD-1 6 x 30) for the mounting. Please purchase it.

- 3. Remove the Wall Mount Bracket Installation Template.
- 4. Fix it with screws (not supplied) as shown in the illustration below.




Hang the main unit onto the bracket as shown below.



## ( Caution


- Do not hang onto the installed unit and avoid any impact to the unit.
- Secure the unit firmly to the wall so that it does not fall off. If the unit falls off, it may result in an injury or damage to the product.
- When the unit is installed on a wall, please make sure that a child does not pull any of connecting cables, as it may cause it to fall.



## Optional Equipment Connection

#### **OPTICAL In connection**

Connect an optical output of external devices to the OPTICAL IN connector.



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## **Operations**

## **DOLBY DRC (Dynamic Range** Control)

Make the sound clear when the volume is turned down (Dolby Digital only). Set to the DOLBY DRC by pressing **DOLBY DRC ON**.

To cancel the DOLBY DRC, press **DOLBY DRC OFF**.

#### AV Svnc

When receiving audio signals from TV, sound and images may not be matched. In the case, this function can adjust the delay time.

Use **AV SYNC -/+** to scroll up and down through the delay amount, which you can set at anything between 0 and 300ms.



#### Note

When the AV SYNC reaches the highest/lowest level and you push AV SYNC -/+ on remote control again, red LED on the unit turns on for 2 seconds to signal on what the AV SYNC level

#### **AUTO POWER DOWN**

This unit turns off automatically to save power consumption if no signal is transmitted to the unit for about 25 minutes.

But the unit can turns on automatically based on the [AUTO POWER] function you've set.

#### **AUTO POWER On/Off**

This function is automatically turns on/off the unit when you turn on/off the external device (TV, DVD player, Blu-ray player etc.) connected to the unit by optical cable. Turn on this function by pressing

#### AUTO POWER ON

To cancel it, press AUTO POWER OFF.



#### Note -

If you don't connect external device to the unit by optical cable or there is no digital input, the unit is turned off after 15 minutes when you turn on this function.

## Turn off the sound temporarily

Press of to mute your unit.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone.




#### Note -

Red LED on the unit blinks at intervals of 2 seconds to signal that the unit is in mute mode.

## Controlling a TV with the Supplied Remote Control

You can control your TV using the buttons below. (LGTV only.)



Button	Operation	
MUTE	Turn the TV's volume on or off	
INPUT	Switch the TV's input source between the TV and other input sources.	
(TV POWER)	Turn the TV on or off.	
VOL +/-	Adjust the volume of the TV.	
PR/CH ▲ / ▼	Scan up or down through memorized channels.	



- · Depending on your TV being connected, you may not be able to control your TV using some of the buttons.
- The remote control of the unit performs basic operation of your TV. Please use the TV's remote control to enjoy advanced operation of your TV.

### Maintenance

#### Handling the Unit

#### When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

- Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit.
- Wiping with strong pressure may damage the surface.
- Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time.

#### Cleaning the unit

To clean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the unit.
