## **Unique Features**

### **USB Direct Recording**

Records music to your USB device.

### Portable In

Listens to music from your portable device. (MP3, Notebook, etc)

### **Bluetooth**

Listens to music stored on your bluetoothe device.

### LG Bluetooth Remote

You can control this unit with your Android device via Bluetooth. This unit and your device must be paired for Bluetooth. Visit "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)" to search for "LG Bluetooth Remote" app. For detailed information, refer to page 22-23.

## Playable file Requirement

### Music file requirement

MP3/ WMA/FLAC file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows:

• Sampling frequency:

MP3: within 8 to 48 kHz WMA: within 8 to 48 kHz FLAC: within 8 to 96 kHz(USB), within 8 to 48 kHz(CD)

 Bit rate: within 8 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)

• Maximum files: Under 999

• File extensions : ".mp3"/ ".wma"/".flac"

CD-ROM file format : ISO9660/ JOLIET

• Support channel(FLAC): Up to 2 channel

• Support output bit/sample (FLAC): 16bit

• bps(FLAC): Up to 2.5Mbps

The DTS is not supported. In case of DTS audio format, audio is not output.

You have to set the disc format option to [Mastered] in order to make the discs compatible with the LG players when formatting rewritable discs. When setting the option to Live File System, you cannot use it on LG players. (Mastered/ Live File System: Disc format system for Windows Vista)


### Compatible USB Devices

- MP3 Player: Flash type MP3 player.
- USB Flash Drive: Devices that support USB2.0 or USB1.1.
- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.


### **USB** device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit is not supported when the total number of files is 1,000 or more.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC.
   The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- Some USB may not work with this unit.
- In power on state, you can charge your Android device via USB port. (This is available when you select USB function.)

### Replacement of battery

### PRESET FOLDER A/V:

 Searches for a folder of MP3/ WMA/FLAC files. When a CD/ USB containing MP3/WMA/FLAC files in several folders is being played, press PRESET-FOLDER

**\( \rangle V \)** to select the folder you want to play.

- Chooses a preset number for a radio station.

**FUNCTION**: Selects the function and input source.

**VOL** +/-: Adjusts speaker volume.

#### PROGRAM/MEMORY:

- Stores radio stations.
- Creates a playlist you want to listen to.

**SOUND EFFECT**: Chooses sound impressions.

**INFO**: Sees informations about your music. MP3 files often come with ID3 tags. The tag gives the Title, Artist, Album or Time information.

**USB REC**: Starts recording.

**CLOCK**: Sets a clock and checks a time

**ALARM**: Uses your player as an alarm clock.







# Connecting the speakers to the unit

## Attaching the speakers to the unit

To connect the cable to the unit, press each plastic finger pad to open the connection terminals on the unit. Insert the wire and release the finger pad.

Insert the black stripe of the wire to the terminals marked - (minus) and insert the the red one to the terminals marked + (plus).




### Caution

### **Antenna Connection**


Connect the Antenna to the antenna port on the back of the unit. Be sure to extend the FM wire antenna fully.



# Optional Equipment Connection

### **USB** Connection

Connect the USB device (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB port on the front of the unit.




### Note

Removing the USB Device from the unit:

- Choose a different function/mode or press ■ ENTER on the remote control or □ on the unit twice in a row.
- 2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

### **PORT. IN Connection**

Connect an output (earphone or line out) of portable device (MP3 or PMP etc) to the **PORT. IN** connector.



## Listening to music from your external device

This unit can be used to play the music from many types of external device.

- Connect the external device to the **PORT. IN** connector of the unit.
- 2. Turn the power on by pressing () on the remote control or (1) / 1 on the unit.
- Select the PORTABLE function by pressing FUNCTION on the remote contro or F on the unit.
- 4. Turn the external device and start playing music.

## **Basic Operations**

When you selects USB function, you can see messages as follows;

Message	Cause
CHARGE	Your device is not supported by AOA 2.0(Only charging)
Number of files	This unit recognizes your USB.
ANDROID	This unit recognizes your Android device supported by AOA 2.0 as known device.
NO USB	Any device is not connected to USB port. This unit recognizes your Android device as an unknown device.



### Note

Depending on the type of device, message will appear in other way.

### **CD/ USB Operations**

- 1. Insert the disc by pressing **≜**on the remote control or  $\triangle$  on the unit. Or connect the USB device to the USB port.
- 2. Select the CD or USB function by pressing **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit.
- 3. Select a track/file you want to play by pressing Idd/▶▶ on the remote control or Idd/>> on the unit.

Stop	Press ■ENTER on the remote control or □ on the unit.
Playback	Press ►/II on the remote control or ➤II on the unit.
Pause	During playback, press ►/II on the remote control or ►II on the unit.

	During playback, press ►►I on the remote control or ➤I on the unit to go to the next track/file.

Searching for a section within a track	Press and hold ► I on the remote control or ► I on the the unit during playback and release it at the point you want to listen to.
Playing repeatedly or randomly	Press <b>REPEAT(MENU)</b> on the remote control repeatedly, the display changes in the following order.  RPT1 -> RPT DIR (only MP3/WMA/FLAC) -> RPT ALL -> RANDOM -> OFF




If you play a scratched disc, there are some noise and the unit cannot read the disc.

### Selecting a folder

- 1. Press **PRESET-FOLDER**  $\Lambda/V$  on the remote control repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
- 2. Press ►/II on the remote control or >II on the unit to play it. The first file of folder will play.



• USB and CD Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- \*ROOT: the first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT"
- Folders will be presented as the following order;

FAT(USB), CD: FILE\_01 -> FILE\_02 -> FILE\_03 -> FILE\_04 -> FILE\_05 -> FILE\_06 ->

**FILE\_07** -> **FILE\_08** -> **FILE\_09** -> FILE\_10

### Deleting an MP3/WMA/FLAC file

You can delete file, folder or format by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control. This function is supported only in stop state. (USB only)

- 1. -Select the file you want to delete and press DELETE.
  - -Select the folder you want to delete by pressing **PRESET-FOLDER**  $\Lambda/V$  on the remote control. Then press **DELETE**.
  - -Press and hold **DELETE** to format the USB. device.

Or

Press **DELETE** repeatedly while searching a file.

The display window will be changed in the following order.

- DEL FILE: Deletes file
- DEL DIR? Deletes folder
- FORMAT?: Formats USB
- 2. To delete file/folder or format, press ►/II on the remote control or > 11 on the unit.
- 3. If you want to exit the current mode, press ■ ENTER on the remote control or □ on the unit

### **Android device Operation**

You can enjoy the sound from your Android device through USB port. For details about Android device, refer to the Android device User Guide.


To stream audio from your Android device through this unit, you need:

- With Android operation system: Ver 4.1(or later) and AOA 2.0 (or later)
- With a micro USB cable



- This unit may not compatible with the device that does not support the \*AOA (Android Open Accessory) 2.0 version. It is possible that certain devices may not support or be compliant with the AOA2.0 USB audio standard, resulting in the device freezing or rebooting after being connected and detached from the speaker system. If you experience this problem, please contact your device manufacturer. Your device may need to be updated with the latest Jellybean software and or the correct AOA2.0 USB audio standard.
  - \*About AOA (Android Open Accessory) 2.0 version :
  - Audio output from Android device to the Accessory and HID (Human Interface Device)
- You are recommended to remove the case for your Android device (Ver4.1 or later) before you connect your Android device to USB port using a cable.

1. Connect Android device to the USB port by using the Android device's cable.



- 2. Press **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit to select USB function.
- If your unit is connected firmly, 'ANDROID' will appear in the display window.
   You can operate your Android device through an Android device's display by using the remote control and controlling your Android device.

### Note

- If the connection has an error, check these problems as follows;
- Your Android device is not connected firmly.
- This unit recognizes your Android device as an unknown device.
- Your Android device is not booted.
- Check the setting of USB connection type on your Android device.
- In case of no sound from this unit, adjust the volume of your Android device.
- The charging time may vary depending on your Android device.
- Some Android devices may not be charged.
- You may not control your Android device from this unit due to malfunction of Android device
- Depending on your Android device's software version, it may not be possible to control your Android device from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.
- If your Android device does not support AOA (Android Open Accessory) 2.0 version, this unit can only charge your Android device even though Android device has OS 4.1 (or later).

## Radio Operations

### Listening to the radio

- Press FUNCTION on the remote control or F on the unit until TUNER appears on the display window.
  - The last received station is tuned in.
- Auto tuning: Press TUN.-/+ on the remote control or I≪/≫I on the unit for about 2 seconds until the existing frequency starts changing, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.
  - Manual tuning: Press **TUN.-/+** on the remote control or **I**≪/≫**I** on the unit repeatedly.
- Adjust the volume by pressing
   VOL +/- on the remote control or rotate the
   Volume Knob on the unit.

### Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM. Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

- Press FUNCTION on the remote control or F on the unit until TUNER appears on the display window.
- Select the desired frequency by pressing
   TUN. -/+ remote control or |≪/≫| on the
   unit.
- 3. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY**. A preset number will blink on the display window.
- 4. Press **PRESET-FOLDER**  $\Lambda/V$  to select the preset number you want.
- Press PROGRAM/MEMORY. The station is stored.
- 6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
- 7. To listen a preset station, press **PRESET-FOLDER** Λ/V.

### Deleting all the saved stations

- Press and hold **PROGRAM/MEMORY** for two seconds. "CLEAR" will flash up on the display window.
- Press PROGRAM/MEMORY to erase all saved radio stations.

### Improving poor FM reception

Press ▶/II on the remote control. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

## Seeing information about a Radio station(Optional)

The FM tuner is supplied with the RDS (Radio Data System) facility. This shows information about the radio station being listened to. Press **SET/RDS** repeatedly to cycle through the various data types:

PS	(Programme	Service	Name)
	(i rogrammic	JCI VICC	rvarric)

The name of the channel will appear in

the display.

**PTY** (Programme Type Recognition)

The programme type (e.g. Jazz or News)

will appear in the display.

RT (Radio Text)

A text message contains special information from the broadcast station.

This text may scroll across the display.

CT (Time controlled by the channel)

This shows the time as broadcast by the

This shows the time as broadcast by the

station.

You can search the radio stations by programme type by pressing **SET/RDS**. The display will show the last PTY in use. Press **PTY** one or more times to select your preferred programme type. Press and hold **TUN.-/+**. The tuner will search automatically. When a station is found, the search will stop.

### Other Operations

### Programmed Playback

The program function enables you to store your favorite files from any disc or USB device.

A program can contain 20 tracks/files.

- 1. Insert a CD or a USB and wait for it to be ordered.
- Press PROGRAM/MEMORY on the remote control in stop status.
- Press ◄◄/▶► on the remote control or
   I≪/≫I on the unit to select a track/file.
- Press PROGRAM/MEMORY on the remote control again to save and select a next track/file.
- Press ►/II on the remote control or ➤II on the unit to play the programmed music tracks/files.
- 6. To clear your selection, press ■ENTER on the remote control or □ on the unit twice.



The programs are also cleared when the disc or USB device is removed, the unit is powered off or the function is switched to others.

## Displaying file information (ID3 TAG)

While playing an MP3 file containing file information, you can display the information by pressing **INFO**.

### Turn off the sound temporarily

Press **\( \)** on the remote control to mute your unit. You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the mute symbol "\( \) is displayed in the display window.

To cancel it, press again  $\mathbf{W}$  on the remote control or change the volume level.

### **Auto Power Down**

This unit will be off itself to save electric consumption in the case main unit is not connected to external device and is not used for 20 minutes.

So does this unit after six hours since Main unit has been connected to other device using analog input.

## Sound adjustment

### Setting the surround mode

This system has a number of pre-set sound fields. You can select desired sound mode by using **SOUND EFFECT** on the remote control. The displayed items for the Equalizer may be

different depending on sound sources and effects.

On Display	Description	
AUTO EQ	Sets the sound equalizer on the mode that is the most similar to the genre which is included in the MP3 ID3 tag of song files	
POP CLASSIC ROCK JAZZ	This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual pop, classic or rock concert.	
MP3 OPT	This function is optimized for compressible MP3 file. It improves the treble sound.	
BASS BLAST (BASS)	Reinforces the treble, bass and surround sound effect.	
BYPASS	You can enjoy the sound without equalizer effect.	



### Note

Maybe you need reset the surround mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound track changed.

## Setting the Clock

- 1. Turn the unit on.
- 2. Press **CLOCK** for at least 2 seconds.
- 3. Choose time mode by pressing ◄◄/▶▶ on the remote control or ▮≪/≫ on the unit.
  - AM 12:00 (for an AM and PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
- 4. Press SET/RDS to confirm your selection.
- 5. Select the hours by pressing ► on the remote control or ► on the unit
- 6. Press SET/RDS to confirm your selection.
- 7. Select the minutes by pressing ► on the remote control or ► on the unit.
- 8. Press **SET/RDS** to confirm your selection.
- 9. If you want to reset the clock, press and hold **CLOCK**. Then repeat steps 3-8.

## Setting the clock through "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" app on your Android device. (refer to page 22-23)

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating Bluetooth connection through "LG Bluetooth Remote" app.

### Setting the alarm

You can use the unit as an alarm clock. You have to set the clock before setting the alarm.

- 1. Turn the unit on.
- 2. Press ALARM. Each of functions flashes.
- 3. Press **SET/RDS** when the function you want to be woken by is showing.
- "ON TIME" will be displayed. This is your desired time to the unit turns on. Press I◄◄/▶►I on the remote control or I≪/≫I on the unit to change the hours and minutes and press SET/RDS to save.
- Press I◄◄/▶►I on the remote control or I≪/≫I on the unit to change the volume and press SET/RDS to save.
- If you want to reset the alarm, press and hold ALARM. Then repeat steps 3-5.



### Note

- Alarm function only works when the unit is turned off after setting the alarm.
- If you set the clock time and alarm, you can check the time by pressing CLOCK or the alarm by pressing ALARM even when the unit is turned off.
- If the alarm is already set, press ALARM once to cancel the alarm. To activate the alarm, press ALARM once again.
- If the clock time or the alarm is already set, press and hold CLOCK or ALARM for at least 2 seconds to reset the clock or the alarm.

## **Sleep Timer Setting**

Press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select delay time sequence from 180 to 10 minutes. After the delay time, the unit will be turned off.

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until "SLEEP 10" appears, and then press **SLEEP** once again while "SLEEP 10" is displayed.



### Note -

- You can check the remaining time before the unit is turned off.
- Press **SLEEP**. The remaining time appears in the display window.

### Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** once. The display window will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until dim off.

## **Advanced Operations**

### Recording to USB

- 1. Connect the USB device to the unit.
- 2. Select a function by pressing **FUNCTION** on the remote control or F on the unit.

One track recording - You can record to USB after playing a file you want.

All tracks recording - You can record to USB after stop.

Program list recording - After making program list, you can record it on USB. (Refer to the page 17)

- 3. Start the recording by pressing **USB REC** on the remote control
- 4. To stop recording, press **ENTER** on the remote control or  $\square$  on the unit.

### Pausing recording

During recording, press **USB REC** on the remote control to pause recording. Press it again to restart recording. (Only Radio, Portable)

### To select recording bit rate and speed

- 1. Press **USB REC** on the remote control for longer than 3 seconds.
- 2. Use | **I** on the unit to select the bit rate: 96 kbps -> 128 kbps -> 192 kbps -> 256 kbps
- 3. Press **USB REC** on the remote control again to select the recording speed.
- 4. Press ► on the remote control or I on the unit to select a desired recording speed: (Only AUDIO CD)

#### X1 SPEED

- You can listen to music while recording it. (AUDIO CD Only)

#### X2 SPEED

- You can just record the music file.
- 5. Press **USB REC** on the remote control to finish the setting.



### Note

- It is not supported to record music stored on bluetooth device.
- You can check the recording percentage rate for the USB record on the display window during the recording. (MP3/WMA CD Only)
- During recording MP3/WMA/FLAC, there is no sound.
- When you stop recording during playback, the file that has been recorded at that time will be stored. (Except MP3/WMA/FLAC files)
- Do not remove the USB device or turn off the unit during USB recording. If not, an incomplete file may be made and not deleted on PC.
- If USB recording does not work, the message like "NO USB". "ERROR". "FULL" ."NO SUPPO" or "NO REC" is displayed on the display window.
- Multi card reader device or External HDD can not be used for USB recording.
- A file is recorded by about 512 Mbyte when you record for a long term.
- You may not store more than 999 files.

Available Devices : Mobile phone, MP3, Laptop, PDA etc.

### Bluetooth profiles

In order to use *Bluetooth*\* wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

## Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

## Pairing this unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is turned on in to your Bluetooth device. Refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

- Select the Bluetooth function by using FUNCTION on the remote control or F on the unit. Then "BT READY" will be on the display window.
- Operate the Bluetooth device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the Bluetooth device, a list of the devices found may appear in the Bluetooth device display depending on the type of Bluetooth

device. Your unit appears as "LG MICRO(XX:XX)"



XX:XX means the last four digits of Bluetooth address. For example, if your unit has a Bluetooth address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG MICRO(F7:08)" on your Bluetooth device.

### Note

Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some device have a different pairing way.

- When this unit successfully paired with your Bluetooth device, "BT PAIR" will be on the display window
- Listen to music.
   To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide.



### Note

- Sound from the main set can be distorted if you raise the volume of Bluetooth device up to two-thirds or more.
- When you use the bluetooth function, adjust the volume of a bluetooth device to a proper level to listen to.



- When using *Bluetooth*® technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the bluetooth device as close as possible and keep the distance. However it may not work well in the case below:
  - There is a obstacle between the unit and the bluetooth device
  - There is a device using same frequency with *Bluetooth*® technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless I AN device
- You should connect your Bluetooth device to this unit again when you restart it.
- When you select Bluetooth function again after changing to other functions, Bluetooth connection may be disconnected. You should reconnect the bluetooth device to use this function.
- The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave.
- You cannot control the Bluetooth device with this unit
- Pairing is limited one Bluetooth device per one unit and multi-pairing is not supported.
- Depending on the type of the device. you may not be able to use the Bluetooth function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.,
- The more distant between the unit and the bluetooth device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the bluetooth device gets far from the unit.

### Handling the Unit

### When shipping the unit
