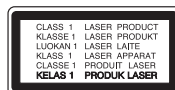

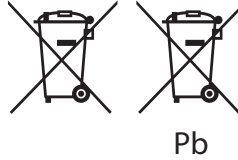

Unique Features

Smart Awake Lighting

The light of unit is gradually brighter on 30 seconds before the set alarm time.

USB Direct Recording

Records music to your USB device.

Radio

Listens to the radio.

Portable In

Listens to music from your portable device. (mp3/wma, Notebook, etc)

Made for iPhone/iPod or Android device

Enjoys music from iPhone/iPod or Android device with simple connection.

LG Bluetooth Remote

You can control this unit with your iPod touch/iPhone or Android device via Bluetooth. This unit and your device must be paired for Bluetooth. Visit "Apple App Store" or "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)" For detailed information, refer to page 26-27.

Playable file Requirement

Music file requirement

MP3/ WMA/FLAC file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows :

- Sampling frequency :
MP3 : within 8 to 48 kHz
WMA : within 8 to 48 kHz
FLAC : within 8 to 96 kHz(USB),
within 8 to 48 kHz(CD)
- Bit rate : within 8 to 320 kbps (MP3),
40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Maximum files : Under 999
- File extensions : ".mp3"/".wma"/".flac"
- CD-ROM file format : ISO9660/ JOLIET
- Support channel(FLAC) : Up to 2 channel
- Support output bit/sample (FLAC) : 16bit
- bps(FLAC) : Up to 2.5Mbps

The DTS is not supported. In case of DTS audio format, audio is not output.

You have to set the disc format option to [Mastered] in order to make the discs compatible with the LG players when formatting rewritable discs. When setting the option to Live File System, you cannot use it on LG players. (Mastered/ Live File System : Disc format system for Windows Vista)

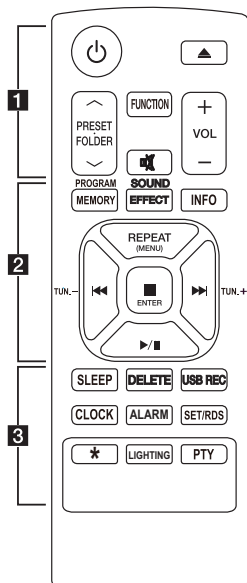
Compatible USB Devices

- MP3 Player : Flash type MP3 player.
- USB Flash Drive :
Devices that support USB2.0 or USB1.1.
- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.

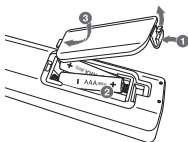
USB device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minutes to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/ 32) file system is supported.)
- This unit is not supported when the total number of files is 1000 or more.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices, mobile phone are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- Some USB may not work with this unit.
- In power on state, you can charge your iPhone/ iPod/Android device via USB port. (This is available when you selects USB function.)

Replacement of battery



Remove the battery cover on the rear of the Remote Control, and insert two (size AAA) batteries with $+$ and $-$ matched correctly

⏻ (POWER): Switches the unit ON or OFF.

⬆ (OPEN/CLOSE): Ejects the disc from slot loader.

PRESET FOLDER \wedge/\vee :

- Searches for a folder of mp3/wma files. When a CD/USB containing mp3/wma files in several folders is being played, press **PRESET FOLDER \wedge/\vee** to select the folder you want to play.

- Chooses a preset number for a radio station.

FUNCTION: Selects the function and input source.

⏻: Mutes the sound.

VOL ($+$ / $-$): Adjusts speaker volume.

PROGRAM/MEMORY:

- Stores radio stations.
- Creates a playlist you want to listen to.

SOUND EFFECT: Chooses sound impressions.

INFO: Sees information about your music. mp3/wma files often come with ID3 tags. The tag gives the Title, Artist, Album or Time information.

REPEAT (MENU):

- Listens to your tracks/files repeatedly or randomly.
- Move to the previous menu on iPod mode.

TUN.(-/+): Selects the radio stations.

⏮/⏭ (SKIP/SEARCH):

- Skips Fast backward or Forward.
- Searches for a section within a track/file.

■ ENTER:

- Stops playback or recording.
- Choose an item on iPod mode.

▶/⏸ (PLAY/PAUSE):

- Starts or pauses playback.
- Selects STEREO/MONO.

SLEEP : Sets the system to turn off automatically at a specified time. (Dimmer : The display window will be darkened by half.)

DELETE : Deletes MP3/WMA/FLAC files.

USB REC : USB direct recording.

CLOCK : Sets a clock and checks a time.

ALARM: Uses your player as an alarm clock.

SET/RDS :

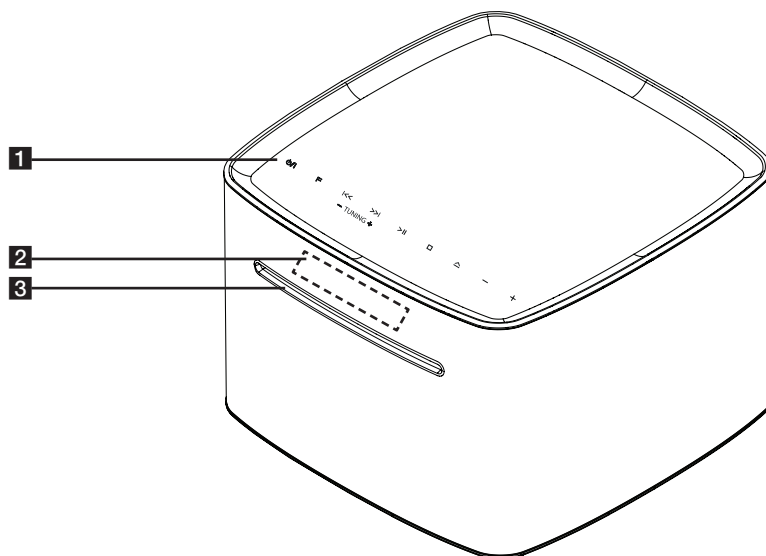
- RDS (Radio Data System).
- Confirms the clock and the alarm setting.

★ : The button is not available for any function.

LIGHTING : Selects a LIGHTING ON / OFF mode of unit.

PTY : Searches radio stations by radio type.

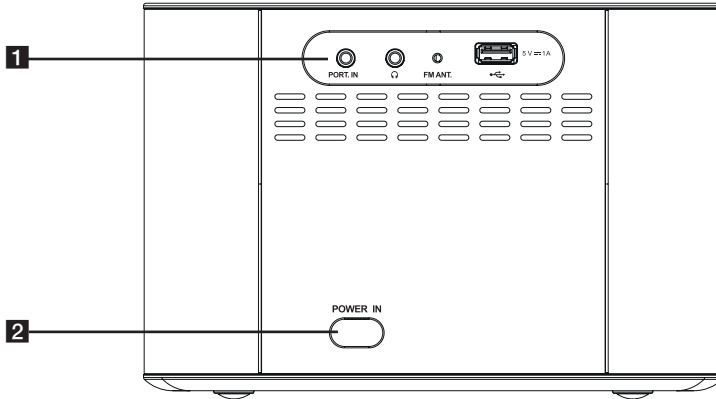


Caution

Precautions in using the touch buttons

- Use the touch buttons with clean and dry hands.
 - In a humid environment, wipe out any moisture on the touch buttons before using.
- Do not press the touch buttons hard to make it work.
 - If you apply too much strength, it can damage the sensor of the touch buttons.
- Touch the button that you want to work in order to operate the function correctly.
- Be careful not to have any conductive material such as metallic object on the touch buttons. It can cause malfunctions.

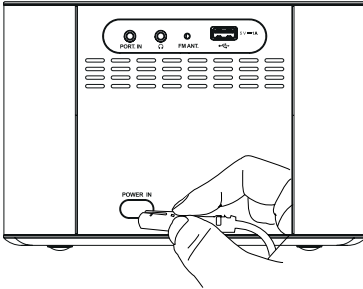

Unplug the AC power cord from the wall outlet if you do not to use for an extended period of time.

Basic Operations

When you selects USB function, you can see messages as follows;

Message	Cause
CHARGE	Your device is not supported by AOA 2.0(Only charging)
Number of files	This unit recognizes your USB.
IPOD	This unit recognizes your iOS device as an known device.
ANDROID	This unit recognizes your Android device supported by AOA 2.0 as known device.
NO USB	Any device is not connected to USB port. This unit recognizes your Android device as an unknown device.

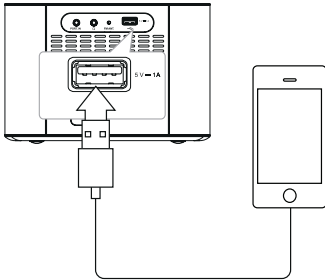

iPhone/iPod Operation

You can enjoy the sound with your iPhone/iPod.

For details about iPhone/iPod, refer to the iPhone/iPod User Guide.

1. Connect iPhone/iPod to the USB port by using the iPhone/iPod's cable.



2. Press **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit to select USB function.
3. If your unit is connected firmly, 'IPOD' will appear in the display window.
You can operate your iPod device through an iPod device's display by using the remote control and controlling your iPod device.

To	Do this
Pauses or restart	Press ▶/ on the remote control or > on the unit.
Skipping to the next/previous track/ file	Press ◀◀/▶▶ on the remote control or ◀◀/▶▶ on the unit to skip the track/file in stop status. During playback, press ▶▶ on the remote control or >> on the unit to go to the next track/file. Playing after 3 seconds, press ◀◀ on the remote control or twice ◀◀ on the unit to go to the beginning of the track/file.
Searching for a section within a track/ file	Press and hold ◀◀/▶▶ on the remote control or ◀◀/▶▶ on the unit during playback and release it at the point you want to listen to.
Move to the previous menu	Press REPEAT (MENU) on the remote control.
Move to the desired item	Press PRESET FOLDER ▲/▼ on the remote control.
Chooses a item	Press ■ ENTER on the remote control or □ on the unit.

! Note

- An Error can occur as per below conditions.
 - Your iPhone/iPod is not connected firmly.
 - This unit recognizes your iPhone/iPod as an unknown device.
 - Your iPhone/iPod is exceptionally low in power.
 - ▶ The battery needs to be charged.
 - ▶ If you charge the battery while iPhone/iPod is extremely low in power, it may take longer to be charged.
- When you disconnect your iPhone/iPod during playback, the playback pauses.
- When your iPhone/iPod is connected, you cannot control the volume button of your iPhone/iPod.
- You may not control your iPhone/iPod from this unit due to malfunction of iPhone/iPod.
- Depending on your iPhone/iPod's software version, it may not be possible to control your iPhone/iPod from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.

Android device Operation

You can enjoy the sound from your Android device through USB port. For details about Android device, refer to the Android device User Guide.

To stream audio from your Android device through this unit, you need :

- With Android operation system : Ver 4.1 (or later) and AOA 2.0 (or later)
- With a micro USB cable

! Note

It is possible that certain devices may not support or be compliant with the AOA2.0 USB audio standard, resulting in the device freezing or rebooting after being connected and detached from the speaker system.

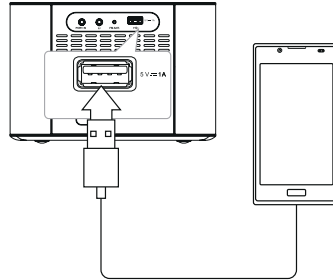
If you experience this problem, please contact your device manufacturer. Your device may need to be updated with the latest Jellybean software and or the correct AOA2.0 USB audio standard.

You can recommend to remove the case for your Android device (Ver 4.1 or later) before you connect your Android device to USB port using a cable.

*About AOA (Android Open Accessory) 2.0 version ;

Audio output from Android device to the Accessory and HID (Human Interface Device)

1. Connect Android device to the USB port by using the Android device's cable.



2. Press **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit to select USB function.
3. If your unit is connected firmly, 'ANDROID' will appear in the display window. You can operate your Android device through an Android device's display by using the remote control and controlling your Android device.

To	Do this
Play	Press > .
Pause	During playback, press > .
Skip	During playback, press I<<< / >>>I to go to the next file or to return to the beginning of the current file. During playback, press I<<< twice briefly to step back to the previous file.

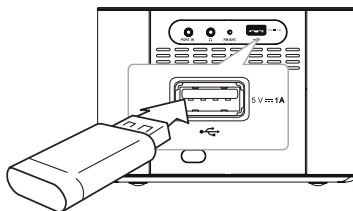
! Note

- If the connection has an error, check these problems as follows;
 - Your Android device is not connected firmly.
 - This unit recognizes your Android device as an unknown device.
 - Your Android device is not booted.
 - Check the setting of USB connection type on your Android device.
- In case of no sound from this unit, adjust the volume of your Android device.
- The charging time may vary depending on your Android device.
- Some Android devices may not be charged.
- You may not control your Android device from this unit due to malfunction of Android device.
- Depending on your Android device's software version, it may not be possible to control your Android device from this unit. We recommend installing the latest software version.
- If your Android device does not support AOA (Android Open Accessory) 2.0 version, this unit can only charge your Android device even though Android device has OS 4.1 (or later).

USB / CD Operation

USB Connection

Connect the USB port of USB Memory (or mp3/wma player, etc.) to the USB port on the unit.



! Note

Removing the USB Device from the unit.

1. Choose a different function/mode or press **ENTER** on the remote control or **ENTER** on the unit.
2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

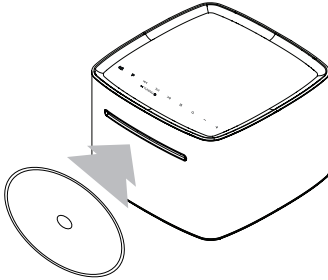


Caution

- Do not extract the USB device during operation. (play, delete, etc.)
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB state. (lock, etc.)

Insert CD

1. Insert a disc in the disc slot with the label side upward.
2. Select the CD function by pressing **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit.
3. Select a track/file you want to play by pressing **I◀◀/▶▶I** on the remote control.



! Note

Music CDs or CD-R/CD-RW in music CD format can be only played.(12 cm disc)

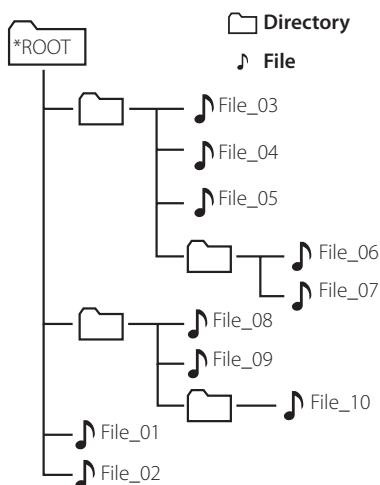

Selecting a folder

1. In stop status, press **PRESET FOLDER** \wedge/V on the remote control repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
2. Press **▶/||** to play it. The first file of folder will be played. (During playback, if you select a folder you want, this step is not necessary.)

Note

- CD / USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- *ROOT : the first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT"
- Folders will be presented as the following order;
FAT(USB) / CD : FILE_01 -> FILE_02 -> FILE_03 -> FILE_04 -> FILE_05 -> FILE_06 -> FILE_07 -> FILE_08 -> FILE_09 -> FILE_10

Deleting an MP3/WMA/FLAC file

You can delete file, folder or format by pressing **DELETE**. This function is supported only in stop status. (USB only)

1. -Select the file you want to delete and press **DELETE**.

-Select the folder you want to delete by pressing **PRESET FOLDER** \wedge/V . Then press **DELETE**.

-Press and hold **DELETE** to format the USB device.

Or

Press **DELETE** repeatedly during selecting the MP3/WMA file.

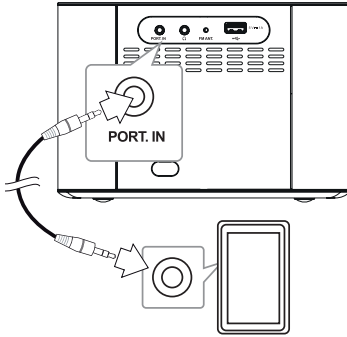
The display changes in the following order.

- DEL FILE : Deletes file
- DEL DIR? : Deletes folder
- FORMAT? : Formats USB

2. To delete file/folder or format, press **▶/||** on the remote control or press **>||** on the unit.
3. If you want to exit the current mode, press **■ ENTER** on the remote control or press **□** on the unit.


Listening to music from your portable device

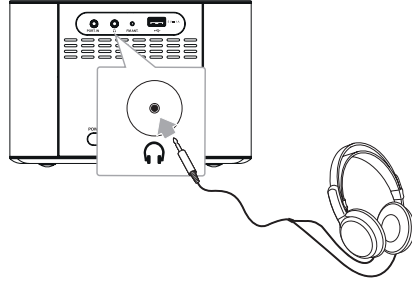
The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable device.




1. Connect the portable device to the **PORT. IN** connector of the unit.
2. Turn the power on by pressing **⏻/⏮**.
3. Select the **PORTABLE** function by pressing **FUNCTION** on the remote control.
4. Turn the portable device on and start playing it.

Listening to music with your headphones

Connect a pair of stereo headphones (Ø 3.5 mm phone plug) to  on the unit for private listening.



Note

You can't hear any sound from speakers, while the headphones plug is inserted in the .

Radio Operations

Listening to the radio

1. Press **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit, until Tuner in the display window. The last received station is tuned in.
2. Auto tuning : Press and hold **TUN.(-/+)** on the remote control or **I<</>>I** on the unit for about 2 seconds until the existing frequency starts changing, then hands off. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.
Manual tuning : Press **TUN.(-/+)** on the remote control or **I<</>>I** on the unit repeatedly.
3. Adjust the volume by pressing **-/+**.

Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM . Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

1. Press **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit, until Tuner in the display window. The last received station is tuned in.
2. Select the desired frequency by pressing **TUN.(-/+)** on the remote control or **I<</>>I** on the unit.
3. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY**. A preset number will blink in the display window.
4. Press **PRESET FOLDER ^/V** to select the preset number you want.
5. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY**. The station is stored.
6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
7. To listen a preset station, press **PRESET FOLDER ^/V**.

Deleting all the saved stations

1. Press and hold **PROGRAM/MEMORY** for two seconds. "CLEAR" will blink on the display window.
2. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** to erase all saved radio stations.

Improving poor FM reception

Press **▶/II** on the remote control. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono. Then the reception will be better than before.

! Note

Be sure to fully extend the FM wire antenna.

Seeing information about a Radio station

The FM tuner is supplied with the RDS (Radio Data System) facility. This shows information about the radio station being listened to. Press **SET/RDS** repeatedly to cycle through the various data types. :

PS	(Programme Service Name) The name of the channel will appear in the display
PTY	(Programme Type Recognition) The programme type (e.g. Jazz or News) will appear in the display.
RT	(Radio Text) A text message contains special information from the broadcast station. This text may scroll across the display.
CT	(Time controlled by the channel) This shows the time and date as broadcast by the station.

You can search the radio stations by programme type by pressing **SET/RDS**. The display will show the last PTY in use. Press **PTY** on the remote control one or more times to select your preferred programme type. Press and hold **TUN.(-/+)** on the remote control or **I<</>>I** on the unit. The tuner will search automatically. When a station is found, the search will stop.

Other Operation

Programmed Playback

The program function enables you to store your favourite tracks/files from any disc or USB device.

A program can contain 20 tracks/files.

1. Insert a CD or connect USB and wait for it to be loaded.
2. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control in stop state.
3. Press **◀◀/▶▶** on the remote control to select a next track/file.
4. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** again to save and select a next track/file.
5. Press **▶/||** to play the programmed music tracks/files.
6. To clear your selection, press twice **■ ENTER** on the remote control and **□(stop)** on the unit.

! Note

The programs are also cleared when the disc or USB device is removed, the unit is powered off or the function is switched to others.

Displaying file information (ID3 TAG)

While playing an mp3/wma file containing file information, you can display the information by pressing **INFO** on the remote control.

Resume playback

During playback, if you change to another function, then return to the USB/CD function, and then press, you can listen to music from last point you played.

Turn off the sound temporarily

Press **⏸** on the remote control to mute your sound. You can mute the sound in order, for example, to answer the telephone. And "MUTE" will blink in the display window. To cancel mute function, press **⏸** again or press **VOL(+/-)** on the remote control or **—/+** on the unit

Sound adjustment

Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set sound fields. You can select a desired sound mode by using **SOUND EFFECT** on the remote control.

The displayed items for the Equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

On Display	Description
NATURAL	You can enjoy comfortable and natural sound.
AUTO EQ	Sets the sound equalizer on the mode that is the most similar to the genre which is included in the MP3 ID3 tag of song files.
POP CLASSIC JAZZ ROCK	This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual rock, pop, jazz or classic concert.
MP3 -- OPT	This function is optimized for compressible MP3 file. It improves the treble sound.
BASS (BASS BLAST)	Reinforces the treble, bass and surround sound effect.
BYPASS	You can enjoy the sound without equalizer effect.

! Note

Maybe you need to reset the sound mode, after switching the input, sometimes even after the sound track/file is changed.

Setting the Clock

You have three ways to set the clock.

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press **CLOCK** for at least 2 seconds.
3. Choose time mode by pressing **◀▶** on the remote control or **◀▶** on the unit.
- 12:00 (for an AM and PM display) or 0:00 (for a 24 hour display)
4. Press **SET/RDS** to confirm your selection.
5. Select the hours by pressing **◀▶** on the remote control or **◀▶** on the unit.
6. Press **SET/RDS** to confirm your selection.
7. Select the minutes by pressing **◀▶** on the remote control or **◀▶** on the unit.
8. Press **SET/RDS** to confirm your selection.
9. If you want to reset the clock, press and hold **CLOCK**. Then repeat steps 3-8.

Setting the Clock through "LG Bluetooth Remote" App

Install "LG Bluetooth Remote" app on your Android device. (see page 26 - 27)

Your unit's clock will be automatically synchronized with your device by activating Bluetooth connection through "LG Bluetooth Remote" app.

Setting the clock by synchronizing your iPhone/iPod

Connect iPhone/iPod to the USB port using the iPhone/iPod's cable and select USB function. Then the clock setting in the display window will be synchronized with your iPhone/iPod.

After the unit synchronized with your iPhone/iPod for clock setting, there will be a time difference between the iPhone/iPod and the unit. In power off state, the clock won't be synchronized with your iPhone/iPod.

Setting the alarm

You can use the unit as an alarm clock.

You have to set the clock before setting the alarm.

1. Turn the unit on.
2. Press **ALARM**. Each of functions flashes.
3. Press **SET/RDS** when the function you want to be woken by is showing.
4. "ON TIME" will be displayed. This is your desired time to turns unit on. Press **◀▶** on the remote control or **◀▶** on the unit to change the hours and minutes and press **SET/RDS** to save.
5. Press **◀▶** on the remote control or **◀▶** on the unit to change the volume and press **SET/RDS** to save.
6. If you want to reset the alarm, press and hold **ALARM**. Then repeat steps 3-5

! Note

- Alarm function only works when the unit is turned off after setting the alarm.
- If you set the clock time and alarm, you can check the time by pressing **CLOCK** or the alarm by pressing **ALARM** even when the unit is turned off.
- If the alarm is already set, press **ALARM** once to cancel the alarm. To activate the alarm, press **ALARM** once again.
- If the clock time or the alarm is already set, press and hold **CLOCK** or **ALARM** for at least 2 seconds to reset the clock or the alarm.

Smart Awake Lighting

The light of unit is gradually brighter on 30 seconds before the set alarm time that user used to the alarm function of the unit or the alarm function of LG Bluetooth app.

- The light off automatically after 30 minutes if you have set the alarm time between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- The light is still on until you press **LIGHTING** on the remote control if you have set the alarm time between 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Sleep Timer Setting

Press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select delay time sequence from 180 to 10 minutes. After the delay time, the unit will be turned off.

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until "SLEEP 10" appears, and then press **SLEEP** once again while "SLEEP 10" is displayed.



Note

- You can check the remaining time before the unit is turned off.
- Press **SLEEP**. The remaining time appears in the display window.

Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** once. The display window will be darkened by half. To cancel it, press **SLEEP** repeatedly until the display window get bright.

Auto Power Down

This unit will be off itself to save electric consumption in the case the main unit is not connected to the external device and is not used for 20 minutes.

So does this unit after 6 hours since Main unit has been connected to other device using analog input.

Advanced Operation

Recording on USB

1. Connect the USB device to the unit.
2. Select a function by pressing **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit.

One track/file recording - You can record a track/ a file on USB while playing the file you want.

All tracks/files recording - You can record tracks/ files on USB in stop state.

Program list recording - After making program list, you can record it on USB.
(Refer to the page 21)

3. Start the recording by pressing **USB REC** on the remote control.
4. To stop recording, press **■ ENTER**.

Pausing recording

During recording, press **USB REC** to pause recording. Press it again to restart recording. (Only FM/ Portable function)

To select recording bit rate and speed

1. Press **USB REC** for longer than 3 seconds.
2. Use **|<</>>|** to select the bit rate.
3. Press **USB REC** again to select the recording speed.
4. Press **|<</>>|** to select a desired recording speed. (CD Function Only)

X1 SPEED

- You can listen to music while recording it.
(Audio CD Only)




X2 SPEED

- You can just record the music file.

5. Press **USB REC** to finish the setting.

Note

- You can check the recording percentage rate for the USB record on the display window during the recording. (AUDIO CD, MP3/ WMA/ FLAC CD Only)
- During recording MP3/ WMA/ FLAC, there is no sound.
- When you stop recording during playback, the file that has been recorded at that time will be stored. (Except for MP3/ WMA/ FLAC files)
- Do not remove the USB device or turn off the unit during USB recording. If not, an incomplete file may be made and not deleted on PC.
- If USB recording does not work, the message like "NO USB", "ERROR(USB ERR)", "FULL(USB FULL)", "NO SUPPO" or "NO REC" is displayed on the display window.
- Multi card reader device, External HDD, mobile phone can not be used for USB recording.
- A file is recorded by about 512 Mbyte when you record for a long term.
- You may not store more than 999 files.

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is turned on in to your Bluetooth device. Refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Select the Bluetooth function by using the **FUNCTION** on the remote control or **F** on the unit.
"BT READY" appears on the display window.

Notes on Discs

Handling Discs

Never stick paper or tape on the disc.

Storing Discs

After playing, store the disc in its case. Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat and never leave it in a parked car exposed to direct sunlight.

Cleaning Discs

Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, thinner, commercially available cleaners, or anti-static spray intended for older vinyl records.
