- Maximum files : 2,000
- Maximum folders : 200
- File extensions : ".mp3"/".wma"
- Certain MP3/WMA files may not be played depending on the type or format of the file.



- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.


USB device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 2,000 files.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- Some USB may not work with this unit.







Connecting to speakers

Attaching the speakers to the unit

To connect the cable to the unit, press each plastic finger pad to open the connection terminals on the unit. Insert the wire and release the finger pad.

Connect the black of each wire to the terminals marked - (minus) and the other end to the terminals marked + (plus).



⚠ Caution


- When you connect the speakers to the unit, make sure to connect the speaker's cable to the corresponding speaker terminals.
- Check the volume level before playing music to prevent infirm, child, and pregnant women from being shocked by the sudden and loud sound from the unit.
- Do not use the unit in a limited space. It may damage a person's hearing. It is recommended to use it in a wide space.
- Be careful to make sure children do not put their hands or any objects into the *speaker duct.
* speaker duct : A hole for plentiful bass sound on speaker cabinet (enclosure)
- Use the speaker supplied with this unit only. Using any other speaker may cause malfunction.
- The speakers contain magnet parts, so color irregularity may occur on the TV screen or PC monitor screen. Please use the speakers far away from either TV screen or PC monitor.

Optional Equipment Connection

AUX IN Connection


Connect an output of auxiliary device (Camcorder, TV, Player, etc) to the **AUX IN** (L/R) connector.

If your device has only one output for audio (mono), connect it to the left (white) audio jack on the unit.



PORT.IN Connection

Connect an output (earphone or line out) of portable device (MP3 or PMP etc.) to the **PORT.IN** (3.5 mm) connector.





Listening to music from your portable player or external device

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable player or external device.

1. Connect the portable player to the **PORT.IN** connector of the unit.

Or

Connect the external device to the **AUX IN** connector of the unit.


2. Turn the power on by pressing .
3. Press  on the remote control or **F** on the unit to select AUX or PORTABLE function.
4. Turn on the portable player or external device and start it playing.

Note

Automatically switches to the PORTABLE function when you connect the portable device to the **PORT.IN** connector.

USB Connection

Connect a USB device (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB ports on the unit.



! Note

Removing the USB Device from the unit :


1. Choose a different function/mode or press  twice in a row.
2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

Antenna Connection

Connect the supplied FM antenna for listening to the radio.

Connect the FM wire antenna to the FM antenna connector.

Basic Operations

USB Operations

1. Connect the USB device to the USB port.
2. Select USB function by pressing  on the remote control or **F** on the unit.

To	Do this
Stop	Press  .
Playback	Press  on the remote control or  on the unit.
Pause	Press  on the remote control or  on the unit during playback.
Searching for a section within a file	Press and hold  /  on the remote control or  /  on the unit during playback and release it at the point you want to listen to.
Selecting a file directly	Press 0 to 9 numerical buttons on the remote control to go to the desired file directly.
Skipping to the next/previous file	<div>- In stop status, Press /  on the remote control or /  on the unit to go to the next/previous file.</div> <div>- During playback, press  on the remote control or  on the unit to go to the next file.</div> <div>Playing less than 3 seconds, press  on the remote control or  on the unit to go to the previous file.</div> <div>Playing after 3 seconds, press  on the remote control or  on the unit to go to the beginning of the file.</div>
Playing repeatedly or randomly	Press REPEAT on the remote control repeatedly. Refer to the note for details about the display change.

- The display changes in the following order.

USB
*RPT 1
RPT**DIR
RPT ALL
RANDOM
OFF

*RPT : Repeat

**DIR : Directory

- When you play the programmed list, only RPT 1 and RPT ALL are available.
- Even after restarting the unit or switching one function to another, you can listen to music from the point where it's last been played.

Selecting a folder and an MP3/WMA file

On the unit


1. Press **SEARCH** and rotate **SEARCH** until a desired file appears. You can also search a folder if you press **SEARCH** again.
2. Press **OK** or **>||** to play the selected file. When you search a folder, press **OK** to select a file in the folder, then press **OK** or **>||** again. The selected file is played.

On the remote control

1. Press **PRESET-FOLDER** **^**/**v** repeatedly until a desired folder appears.
2. Press **▶||** to play it. The first file of the folder will be played.

Note

- USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.





- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear.
- Folders will be presented as the following order:
ROOT → FOLDER 1 → FOLDER 3 → FOLDER 7 → FOLDER 8 → FOLDER 5 → FOLDER 6
- File will be played from FILE No.1 to FILE No.14 one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.

*ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognizes the USB is "ROOT".

Deleting a file/folder or format

You can delete file, folder on your USB or format the USB.

1. Select USB function by pressing  on the remote control or **F** on the unit.
2. -Deletes file : Select the file you want to delete and select "DEL FILE" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control.
-Deletes folder : Select the folder you want to delete and select "DEL DIR" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control.
-Formats USB : Select "FORMAT" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control to format the USB device.
If you want to exit the current mode, press .
3. To delete file/folder or format, press and hold **DELETE** on the remote control.

Caution

- Do not extract the USB device during operation. (play, delete, etc.)
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB status. (lock, etc.)

AUTO DJ


Auto DJ blends the end of one song into the beginning of another for seamless playback. It equalizes volume across files for uninterrupted playback.

Press **AUTO DJ** repeatedly, the display changes as followings.

AUTO DJ RANDOM → AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL → AUTO DJ OFF

Mode	Display Window	Description
OFF	AUTO DJ OFF	-
RANDOM	AUTO DJ RANDOM	The music is played randomly on this mode.
REPEAT	AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL	The music is played repeatedly on this mode.

Note

- AUTO DJ mode does not support searching for a section within a file or to play repeatedly or randomly.
- If you move to other functions or stop the music using  on AUTO DJ mode, AUTO DJ will be disabled.
- AUTO DJ is not supported in the music file whose length is less than 60 seconds.
- Only AUTO DJ SEQUENTIAL is selected when played the programmed list.

Using a BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the **Bluetooth** in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth** wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth** wireless technology.

- Available Devices : Smart phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- Version : 4.0
- Codec : SBC

Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use **Bluetooth** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.

A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the **Bluetooth** feature is activated on your **Bluetooth** device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Turn on the unit.



Note

When Bluetooth connection lock is activated, you can search **Bluetooth** device in BT function.

2. Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the **Bluetooth** device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of **Bluetooth** device. Your unit appears as "LG CJ44 (XX)":



Note

- XX means the last two digits of **Bluetooth** address. For example, if your unit has a **Bluetooth** address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG CJ44 (08)" on your **Bluetooth** device.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device type, some devices may have a different pairing process. Enter the PIN code (0000) as needed.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices simultaneously using the same method as described above, only in the **Bluetooth** function.
- The multi pairing connection is only supported on Android devices. (Multi pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable **Bluetooth** devices (Ex : Dongle etc.) will not support multi pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with your **Bluetooth** device, "PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to **Bluetooth** device name soon. Then "BT" will appear on the display window.

! Note

- "PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi pairing
- If the device name is unavailable, " _ " will be displayed.

4. Listen to music.

To play a music stored on your **Bluetooth** device, refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide.

! Note

- When using **Bluetooth** technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device as close as possible and keep the distance.
However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:
 - There is an obstacle between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device.
 - There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth** technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- You should connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit again when you restart it.
- Even if this unit connected up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices in the **Bluetooth** mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.

Controls connected Bluetooth device

You can control connected **Bluetooth** device by the unit; play, pause, stop, skip.

! Note

- Only Android OS and iOS is available to use this function.
- This function may not be supported depending on the **Bluetooth** device, or operated differently.

Bluetooth connection lock (BT LOCK)

You can limit **Bluetooth** connection to only BT (**Bluetooth**) and LG TV function to prevent unintended **Bluetooth** connection.

To turn on this function, press and hold **⏮** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit for about 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function.

"BT LOCK" appears then you can limit **Bluetooth** connection.

To turn off this function, press and hold **⏮** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit for about 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function.

"BT UNLOCK" appears.

! Note

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the **Bluetooth** function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the **Bluetooth** device gets far from the unit.
- When **Bluetooth** connection is disconnected, connect the **Bluetooth** device to the unit again.
- When a **Bluetooth** device is not connected, "BT READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use **Bluetooth** function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the **Bluetooth** device.
- If a **Bluetooth** device is connected when using LG TV, LG TV is disconnected and the **Bluetooth** device is connected.
- When you connect **Bluetooth** device (iOS device etc.) to this unit or operate the device, the volume level can be synchronized with each other.
- **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when you change the **Bluetooth** function to the others. In "LG XBOOM" app connection, only one device which you are playing keeps **Bluetooth** connection. You can control the **Bluetooth** device with this unit but you cannot use sound output.
- When entering **Bluetooth** function, this unit automatically connect to **Bluetooth** device which is connected the last.
(Auto connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)

Using the LG XBOOM App

! Note

- Only Android OS is available to use "LG XBOOM" app with this unit.
- It is recommended to use the latest version of app.

About "LG XBOOM" App

"LG XBOOM" app brings a suite of new features to this unit.

To enjoy more features, you are recommended to download and install free "LG XBOOM" app.

Here is introduce a few of the many features of "LG XBOOM" app.

Multi Juke box : Your entertainment increases three fold when you connect up to 3 **Bluetooth** phones at the same time. Play music from all three phone and create a customized playlist from all the phones.

Install "LG XBOOM" App onto Your Bluetooth Device

There are two ways to install "LG XBOOM" app onto your **Bluetooth** device.

Install "LG XBOOM" App through QR code

1. Install "LG XBOOM" app through QR code. Use the scanning software to scan the QR code.



2. Tap an icon for installation.

! Note

- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is connected to the Internet.
- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device has a scanning software application. If you don't have one, download one from "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)".
- Depending on the area, QR code may not work.

Install “LG XBOOM” App through “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)”

1. Tap the “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)” icon.
2. In the search bar; type in the “LG XBOOM” and search it.
3. In the search result list, find and tap “LG XBOOM” to start downloading **Bluetooth** app.
4. Tap an icon for installation.

! Note

- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is connected to the Internet.
- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is equipped with “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)”.

Activate Bluetooth with “LG XBOOM” App

“LG XBOOM” app helps to connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit.

1. Tap “LG XBOOM” app icon on the home screen to open “LG XBOOM” app, and go to the main menu.
2. If you want to get more information to operate, tap [Setting] and tap [Help] menu.

! Note

- “LG XBOOM” app will be available in the software version as follow;
 - Android O/S : Version 6.0 or higher
 - Minimum supported versions for each OS may change later.
- If you use “LG XBOOM” app for operation, there would be some differences between “LG XBOOM” app and the supplied remote control. Use the supplied remote control as necessary.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device, “LG XBOOM” app may not work.
- After connection of “LG XBOOM” app, music may be output from your device. In this case, try connecting procedure again.
- If you operate the other applications or change the settings on your **Bluetooth** device while using “LG XBOOM” app, “LG XBOOM” app may operate abnormally.
- When “LG XBOOM” app operates abnormally, check your **Bluetooth** device and the connection of “LG XBOOM” app and then try to connect again.
- Depending on the smart phone's operating system, you have some differences for “LG XBOOM” operation.
- Check **Bluetooth** setting on your **Bluetooth** device if “LG XBOOM” app connection does not work well.

Radio Operations

Be sure that both FM aerials are connected.
(Page 15)

Listening to the radio

1. Press **☞** on the remote control or **F** on the unit until FM appears in the display window.
The last received station is tuned in.
2. Auto tuning :
Press and hold **TUNING -/+** on the remote control or **|<</>>|** on the unit for about two seconds until the frequency indication starts to change, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Or

Manual tuning :
Press **TUNING -/+** on the remote control or **|<</>>|** on the unit repeatedly.
3. Adjust the volume by pressing **VOL +/-** on the remote control or rotating volume knob on the unit repeatedly.

Improving poor FM reception

Press **⏻** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

Presetting the Radio Stations

You can preset 50 stations for FM.
Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume.

1. Press **☞** on the remote control or **F** on the unit until FM appears in the display window.
2. Select the desired frequency by pressing **TUNING -/+** on the remote control or **|<</>>|** on the unit.
3. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control. A preset number will blink in the display window.
4. Press **PRESET-FOLDER ^ / V** on the remote control to select the preset number you want.
5. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control. The station is stored.
6. Repeat steps 2 to 5 to store other stations.
7. To listen a preset station, press **PRESET-FOLDER ^ / V** or **0** to **9** numerical buttons on the remote control.

Deleting all the saved stations

1. Press and hold **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control for two seconds.
"ERASEALL" will flash up on the unit display.
2. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control to erase all the saved radio stations.

Sound adjustment

Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set surround sound fields. The displayed items for the Equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects. You can select a desired sound mode by using **EQ**.

Advanced Operations

Recording to USB

You can record a various sound source to USB.
(USB1, AUX, PORTABLE, FM)

1. Connect the USB device to the unit.
2. Press **⏮** on the remote control or **F** on the unit to select a function you want to record.
3. Start the recording by pressing **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit.

- If you connect both USB1 and USB2, press **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit when USB1 or USB2 which you want to record blinks in the display window.

4. To stop recording, press and hold **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit for 3 seconds. Otherwise, the recording continues.

Pausing recording

During USB playback or pause, or external sound source recording, press **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit to pause recording. Press it again to restart recording.

! Note

- VOICE CANCELLER or KEY CHANGER will be reset, if you use recording function during operating VOICE CANCELLER or KEY CHANGER.
- VOICE CANCELLER or KEY CHANGER can not be operated during recording.

To select recording bit rate

1. Press and hold **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit for 3 seconds.
2. Press **⏮/⏭** on the remote control or **⏮/⏭** on the unit to select a bit rate.
3. Press **USB REC** on the remote control or **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit to finish the setting.

- If USB recording does not work, the message like “NO USB”, “ERROR”, “USB FULL”, “NOT SUPPORT” or “FILE MAX” is displayed on the display window.

- A file is recorded by about 512 Mbyte when you record for a long term.

- You can record MIC. (Except when recording USB that are in stop status.)
- You can control recorded microphone sound according to microphone volume.

Programmed Playback

The program function enables you to make a playlist of your favorite files from a USB device. A program can contain 20 files for each media. Possible to save a total of 40 files.

Making Programmed list

1. Press **PROGRAM / MEMORY** on the remote control in stop status.
2. Select a file by pressing **⏮/⏭** on the remote control.
3. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control to save the file.
4. Repeat steps 2 - 3 to store other files. (You can modify the list by pressing **PRESET-FOLDER ^/V** on the remote control to select the program number.)
5. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control once again.

To play the programmed list, press **▶** on the remote control after you make the list.



Note

When making or modifying the programmed list, REPEAT mode is off.

Deleting Programmed list

Deleting function only works in the edit mode.

1. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control in stop status.
2. Select a song by pressing **PRESET-FOLDER ^/V** or **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control repeatedly.
3. Press **DELETE** on the remote control while a song is selected.



Note

- Programmed list is switched off in the case below.
 - Changing to a different function.
 - Turning off and on the unit.
 - Operating the numeric buttons on the remote control.
 - Playing a file by using **SEARCH** and **↖SEARCH↗** on the unit.
- Programmed list is cleared in the case below.
 - Removing the USB device.
 - Deleting or recording music files in the USB device.
 - Unplugging the Power Cord.

Editing Programmed list

1. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control in stop status.
2. Press **PRESET-FOLDER ^/V** or **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control to select a file to edit.
3. Press **⏮/⏭** on the remote control.
4. Press **PROGRAM/MEMORY** on the remote control once again.
5. Repeat 2 to 4 to store the other files.


To play the programmed list, press **▶** on the remote control after you edit the list.

Other Operations

Turn off the sound temporarily

Press  on the remote control to mute your sound.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the "MUTE" will appear in the display window.

To cancel it, press  on the remote control again or change the volume level.

DEMO

In the power off state, press **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit once. The unit will power on and display the each of functions in the display window.

To cancel the DEMO function, press **USB REC / DEMO** on the unit once more.





Note

You can enjoy other functions during the DEMO, the DEMO will temporarily pause.

- Without input key in 10 sec, the DEMO will playback automatically.

Resume stop

The unit records the point where you pressed  depending on the USB.

If you press  twice, the unit will clear the stopped point.

Using Microphone

1. Connect your microphone to the MIC jack.
2. Play the music you want.
3. Sing along with the accompaniment.
Adjusts the microphone volume by pressing **MIC +/-** on the unit.



Note

- When not using the microphone, set the MIC volume to minimum or turn off the MIC and remove the microphone from the MIC jack.
- If the microphone is set too near the speaker, a howling sound may be produced. In this case, move the microphone away from the speaker or decrease the sound level. by using the **MIC -** on the unit.
- If sound through the microphone is extremely loud, it may be distorted. In this case, press **MIC -** on the unit to minimum.
- You can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **ECHO**.

VOICE CANCELLER

You can enjoy the function while playing the music, by reducing singer vocal of music in the various source.

Press the **VOICE CANCELLER** and "ON" will appear in display window.

To cancel it, press **VOICE CANCELLER** again.

The quality of the VOICE CANCELLER may be different depending on the recording conditions of music files.

! Note

- This function is available in the USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) function.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- This function is available to use only when a microphone is connected.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- It is not available on the mono source.
- To initialize it, change the function or disconnect the microphone.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.

ECHO

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **ECHO**.

ECHO 1 → ECHO 2 → ECHO OFF

! Note

If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.

KEY CHANGER

You can adjust the key to 9 steps (4 steps higher, 4 steps lower and the original key).

- To sharp the key one by one, press **KEY CHANGER (#)** repeatedly during playback.
- To flatten the key one by one, press **KEY CHANGER (b)** repeatedly during playback.

! Note

- This function is available USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) function.
- To initialize it, change the function, disconnect the microphone or change the music.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.

Sleep Timer Setting

Press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly to select delay time between 10 and 180 minutes. After the delay time, the unit will be turned off.

To cancel the sleep function, press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly until "SLEEP 10" appears, and then press **SLEEP** on the remote control once again while "SLEEP 10" is displayed.

Note

- You can check the remaining time before the unit is turned off. Press **SLEEP** on the remote control to check or change the remaining time.
- You can edit the remain time when displays the remaining time or "DIMMER."

Dimmer

Press **SLEEP** on the remote control once. The display window will be darkened by half.

To cancel it, press **SLEEP** on the remote control repeatedly until dim off.

AUTO POWER On

This unit automatically turns on by an input source : LG TV or **Bluetooth**

When you turn on your TV connected to this unit, this unit recognizes the input signal and selects the suitable function. You can hear the sound from the unit.

If you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device, this unit turns on and connect your **Bluetooth** device.

You can play your music.

! Note

- Depending on the connected device, this function may not operate.
- Depending on the connected device, the unit turns on but **Bluetooth** function may not be connected.
- If you disconnect **Bluetooth** connection by this unit, some **Bluetooth** devices try to connect to the unit continually. Therefore it is recommended to disconnect the connection before turning off the unit.
- If you try to connect to the "LG XBOOM" app, **Bluetooth** function of this unit is turned on.
- If you turn on the unit using LG TV or **Bluetooth** function, proper function of this unit is turned on.
- If you have already paired with this unit, automatically this unit can turn on by an input source when this unit is turned off.
- If you turn off the unit by pressing the power button for more than 5 seconds, Auto Power On function is disabled.
To activate it, turn on the unit.

Auto function change

This unit recognizes input signals such as **Bluetooth** and LG TV or connected portable device, and then changes suitable function automatically.

When you try to connect Bluetooth device

When you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit, **Bluetooth** function is selected.

Play your music on the **Bluetooth** device.

When PORT.IN connection is connected

When you connect the portable device to the **PORT.IN** connector, **PORTABLE** function is selected. Play your music on the portable device.

When LG TV is connected

When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync, this unit changes the function to LG TV. You can hear the sound from your TV.

- This function is not available during recording or deleting.



1. Press **WIRELESS LINK** on the unit. PARTY LINK MODE SELECT appears in the display window.
2. Press **WIRELESS LINK** on the unit to select MAIN or OTHER.
 - **A** unit : Selects MAIN.
 - **B** unit : Selects OTHER.

Two units try to connect with each other.
3. When these units are successfully connected each other, each of connected device names appears in the each unit.

! Note

- MAIN / OTHER are may be displayed to MASTER (Primary) / SLAVE (Secondary) in the existing products.
- If you using the LG Sound Sync, this function is not available. If you connect the LG TV function, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- You can use microphone in the OTHER unit only. In case of OTHER unit, some functions are supported only.
- When WIRELESS PARTY LINK is disconnected, OTHER unit is changed to BT (Bluetooth) function.
- If the connection is failed, "FAILED" appears in the display window.

Handling the Unit

When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean
