Playable Discs

This unit plays DVD±R/RW and CD-R/RW that contains audio titles, MP3, WMA and/or JPEG files. Some DVD±RW/DVD±R or CD-RW/CD-R cannot be played on this unit due to the recording quality or physical condition of the disc, or the characteristics of the recording device and authoring software.

DVD-VIDEO (8 cm/12 cm disc)

Discs such as movies that can be purchased or rented.

DVD±R (8 cm/12 cm disc)

Video mode and finalized only.



DVD-RW (8 cm/12 cm disc)

Video mode and finalized only.

Regional Codes

This unit has a regional code printed on the rear of the unit. This unit can play only DVD discs labeled same as the rear of the unit or "ALL"

- Most DVD discs have a globe with one or more numbers in it clearly visible on the cover. This number must match your unit's regional code or the disc cannot play.
- If you try to play a DVD with a different regional code from your unit, the message "Check Regional Code" appears on the TV screen.

- We recommend that you use Easy-CD Creator, which creates an ISO 9660 file system.
- A protected file by DRM (Digital rights management) cannot be played on the unit.
- The DTS disc is not supported.

You have to set the disc format option to [Mastered] in order to make the discs compatible with the LG players when formatting rewritable discs. When setting the option to Live File System, you cannot use it on LG players.



- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT(16/32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 2,000 files.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.







Connections to Your TV

HDMI Out Connection

If you have a HDMITV or monitor, you can connect it to this unit using a HDMI cable (Type A, High Speed HDMI™ Cable).

Connect the HDMI OUT jack on the unit to the HDMI IN jack on a HDMI compatible TV or monitor. Set the TV's source to HDMI (refer to TV's Owner's manual).





- · You can fully enjoy digital audio and video signals together with this HDMI connection.
- When you use HDMI connection, you can change the resolution for the HDMI output. (Page 17)



Caution

- Changing the resolution when the connection has already been established may result in malfunctions. To solve the problem, turn off the unit and then turn it on again.
- When the HDMI connection with HDCP is not verified, TV screen is changed to black or green screen or the snow noise may occur on the screen. In this case, check the HDMI connection, or disconnect the HDMI cable.
- Make sure the unit is connected directly to the TV. Tune the TV to the correct video input channel.



Note -

- If a connected HDMI device does not accept the audio output of the unit, the HDMI device's audio sound may be distorted or may not output.
- When you connect a HDMI or DVI compatible device make sure of the following:
 - Try switching off the HDMI/DVI device and this unit. Next, switch on the HDMI/DVI device and leave it for around 30 seconds, then switch on this unit.
 - The connected device's video input is set correctly for this unit.
 - The connected device is compatible with 720 x 480i (or 576i), 720 x 480p (or 576p), 1280 x 720p, 1920 x 1080i or 1920 x 1080p video input.
- Not all HDCP-compatible HDMI or DVI devices will work with this unit.
 - The picture will not be displayed properly with non-HDCP device.
 - This unit does not playback and TV screen is changed to black or green screen or the snow noise may occur on the screen.
- If there is noise or lines on the screen, please check the HDMI cable and use a higher version cable than High Speed HDMI™ Cable.
- The HDMI sounds output only DVD/CD function.

Resolution Setting

The unit provides several output resolutions for HDMI.

You can change the resolution using [Setup] menu.

- 1. Press 🕝 on the remote control.

The [Setup] menu appears.



- Use ∧ / V on the remote control to select [Display] option then press > on the remote control to move to the second level.
- Use ∧ / V on the remote control to select the [Resolution] option then press > on the remote control to move to the third level.
- Use ∧ / V on the remote control to select the desired resolution then press ② on the remote control to confirm your selection.



Note

- If your TV does not accept the resolution you have set on the player, you can set resolution to 480p (or 576p) as follows: Press



Connecting to speakers

Attaching the speakers to the unit


To connect the cable to the unit, press each plastic finger pad to open the connection terminals on the unit. Insert the wire and release the finger pad.

Connect the black of each wire to the terminals marked - (minus) and the other end to the terminals marked + (plus).



Attaching the speaker light cables to the unit

To connect the speaker light cable to the unit, insert the cable to **SPEAKER LIGHTING SYSTEM** connectors on the unit.





Caution

- Make sure that the jacks and the speakers are matched correctly.
- Make sure to connect the cables to connectors tightly on the unit.





- When you connect the speakers to the unit, make sure to connect the speaker's cable and plug to the corresponding speaker connector.
- Check the volume level before playing music to prevent infirm, child, and pregnant women from being shocked by the sudden and loud sound from the unit.
- Do not use the unit in a limited space. It may damage a person's hearing. It is recommended to use it in a wide space.
- Use the speaker supplied with this unit only. Using any other speaker may cause malfunction.
- The speakers contain magnet parts, so color irregularity may occur on the TV screen or PC monitor screen. Please use the speakers far away from either TV screen or PC monitor.
- Avoid looking at the speaker lights for a long time. It may cause damage to eyesight.

Optional Equipment Connection

AUX IN 1 Connection


Connect an output (earphone or line out) of portable device (MP3 or PMP etc) to the **AUX IN 1** (3.5 mm) connector.



AUX IN 2 Connection

Connect an output of auxiliary device (Camcorder, TV, Player, etc.) to the **AUX IN 2** (L/R) connector.

If your device has only one output for audio(mono), connect it to the left(white) audio jack on the unit.



DVD, Blu-ray player etc.

Listening to music from your portable player or external device

The unit can be used to play the music from many types of portable player or external device.

1. Connect the portable player to the **AUX IN 1** connector of the unit.

Or

Connect the external device to the **AUX IN 2** connector of the unit.

- 2. Turn the power on by pressing \bigcirc .
- 3. Press F to select AUX 1 or AUX 2 function.
- 4. Turn on the portable player or external device and start it playing.




Note -

Automatically switches to the AUX 1 function when you connect the portable device to the AUX IN 1 connector.

USB Connection

Connect a USB device (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB ports on the unit.






Removing the USB device from the unit:

Antenna Connection

Connect the supplied FM antenna for listening to the radio.

You can also set a language for the subtitles and the Setup menu, among other things. For details on each Setup menu item, see pages 21 to 24.

OSD Initial language settings - Optional

During the first use of this unit, the initial language setup menu appears on your TV screen. You must complete initial language selection before using the unit. English will be selected as the initial language.

The Display Mode setting works only when the TV Aspect mode is set to 4:3.

[Letterbox]

Displays a wide picture with bands on the upper and lower portions of the screen.

[Panscan]

Automatically displays the wide picture on the entire screen and cuts off the portions that do not fit. (If the disc/file is not compatible with Pan Scan, the picture is displayed at Letterbox ratio.)

Resolution

Sets the output resolution of HDMI video signal. Refer to "Resolution Setting" for details about the resolution (page 17).

[Auto]

If the HDMI jack is connected to TVs providing display information (EDID), automatically selects the resolution best suited to the connected TV.

[1080p]

Outputs 1080 lines of progressive video.

[1080i]

Outputs 1080 lines of interlaced video.

[720p]

Outputs 720 lines of progressive video.

[480p (or 576p)]

Outputs 480 (or 576) lines of progressive video.

[480i (or 576i)]

Outputs 480 (or 576) lines of interlaced video.

Audio

DRC (Dynamic Range Control)

Make the sound clear when the volume is turned down and prevent a sudden sound increase (Dolby Digital only). Set to [On] for this effect.

HD AV Sync

Sometimes Digital TV encounters a delay between picture and sound. If this happens you can compensate by setting a delay on the sound so that it effectively 'waits' for the picture to arrive: this is called HD AV Sync. Use Λ/V on the remote control to scroll up and down through the delay amount, which you can set at anything between 0 and 300ms.

Semi Karaoke

When a chapter/title/track is fully finished, this function shows the score in the screen with a fanfare sound.

[On]

When you finished singing a score will appear on the screen.

[Off]

Fanfare and score do not appear on the screen.

- DVD, DVD Karaoke discs with more than 2 tracks are available discs for the this function.





Using BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

About Bluetooth

Bluetooth is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the **Bluetooth** in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under Bluetooth wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via Bluetooth wireless technology.

- Available Devices: Smart phone, MP3, Notebook,
- Version: 4.0
- Codec: SBC, AAC

Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use **Bluetooth** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile. A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the Bluetooth feature is activated on your Bluetooth device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Turn on the unit.



Note

When Bluetooth connection lock is activated. you can search Bluetooth device in BT function.

2. Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the Bluetooth device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of Bluetooth device. Your unit appears as "LG CL65DK (XX)".



Note

- · XX means the last two digits of Bluetooth address. For example, if your unit has a Bluetooth address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG CL65DK (08)" on your Bluetooth device.
- Depending on the Bluetooth device type, some devices have a different pairing way. For details about **Bluetooth** pairing, refer to your Bluetooth device manual.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3 Bluetooth devices simultaneously using the same method as described above, only in the Bluetooth function.
- The multi phone pairing connection is only supported on Android devices. (Multi phone pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable Bluetooth devices (Ex: Dongle etc.) will not support multi phone pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with your Bluetooth device, "PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to Bluetooth device name soon. Then "BT" will appear on the display window.



Note

- "PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi phone pairing.
- If the device name is unavailable. " " will be displayed.
- 4 Listen to music To play a music stored on your Bluetooth device, refer to your Bluetooth device's user guide.



Note

- When using **Bluetooth** technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device as close as possible and keep the distance.
 - However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:
 - There is an obstacle between the unit and the Bluetooth device.
 - There is a device using same frequency with Bluetooth technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- If Bluetooth connection does not work well. try pairing it again.
- Even if this unit is connected to up to 3 Bluetooth devices in the Bluetooth mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.



Note

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the **Bluetooth** function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected. when the unit is turned off or the **Bluetooth** device gets too far from the unit.
- When Bluetooth connection is disconnected, connect the Bluetooth device to the unit again.
- When a Bluetooth device is not connected, "BT READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use the **Bluetooth** function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the **Bluetooth** device.
- When you connect **Bluetooth** device (iOS device etc.) to this unit or operate the device, the volume level can be synchronized with each other.
- Bluetooth connection will be disconnected when you change the **Bluetooth** function to some other function. In "LG XBOOM" app connection, only one device which you are playing keeps **Bluetooth** connection. You can control the Bluetooth device with this unit but you cannot use sound output.
- When entering the **Bluetooth** function, this unit automatically connects to the last connected **Bluetooth** device or the device which played back last. (Auto connection may not be supported depending on the connected device

specifications.)

Controls connected Bluetooth device

You can control connected Bluetooth device by the unit; play, pause, stop, skip.



Note -

- Only Android OS and iOS is available to use this function.
- This function may not be supported depending on the Bluetooth device, or operated differently.

Bluetooth connection lock (BT LOCK)

You can limit Bluetooth connection to only BT (Bluetooth) and LG TV function to prevent unintended Bluetooth connection.

To turn this function on, press and hold ▶ on the remote control or >1 on the unit for 5 seconds in BT (Bluetooth) function.

"ON-BT LOCK" appears then you can limit Bluetooth connection.

To turn this function off, press and hold ▶ on the remote control or **>I** on the unit for 5 seconds in BT (Bluetooth) function.

"OFF-BT LOCK" appears.



Note -

Even if you set up **Bluetooth** connection lock to On, this unit turns on by Auto Power function. Turn off Auto Power function to prevent it. (Page 48)

Using the LG XBOOM App

- Only Android OS is available to use "LG XBOOM" app with this unit.
- It is recommended to use the latest version of app.

About "LG XBOOM" App

"LG XBOOM" app brings a suite of new features to this unit.

To enjoy more features, you are recommended to download and install free "LG XBOOM" app.

Below introduces you to a feature of "LG XBOOM" app.

Multi Juke box: Your entertainment increases three fold when you connect up to 3 **Bluetooth** phones at the same time. Play music from three phones and create a customized playlist from all phones.

Install "LG XBOOM" App onto Your Bluetooth Device

There are two ways to install "LG XBOOM" App onto Your **Bluetooth** Device.

Install "LG XBOOM" App through QR code

Press and hold **TUNING-/+** on the remote control or **K4/D>** on the unit until the frequency indication starts to change, then release. Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.

Or

Manual tuning:

Press **TUNING-/+** on the remote control or **KM/DM** on the unit repeatedly.

 Adjust the volume by pressing VOL +/- on the remote control or rotating VOLUME knob on the unit repeatedly.

Improving poor FM reception

Press > on the remote control or > I on the unit. This will change the tuner from stereo to mono and usually improve the reception.

Presetting the Radio Stations

Other Operations

Turn off the sound temporarily

Press & on the remote control to mute your sound.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the "MUTE" will appear in the display window.

To cancel it, press X on the remote control again or change the volume level.

DEMO

In the power off state, press **DEMO** on the unit once. The unit will power on and display the each of functions in the display window.

To cancel the DEMO function, press **DEMO** on the unit once more.

Resume stop

The unit records the point where you pressed depending on the disc or USB.

If you press $\ \square$ twice, the unit will clear the stopped point.

CHILDSAFE Mode




